CODE OF CONDUCT

Every organisation needs a set of guidelines and rules to protect its members and the organisation itself. Please read the below Code of Conduct and sign and date in the appropriate place, and return it with your application form.

Failure to do so may delay or even decline your membership.

- 1. Only PC-UK officials, as listed in the magazine are entitled to use the organisations logo, letter heading in communication with any person or organisation outside of PC-UK.
- 2. No other member shall purport verbally, or in writing or by any other means to represent PC-UK.
- 3. Members shall, at all times, conduct themselves in a manner that does not reflect badly on PC-UK or its membership.
- 4. Members will not attempt to photograph police vehicles on police or private premises without first seeking proper permission to do so. An exemption to this rule is where the general public are admitted to police premises for a specific occasion; for example, police open day.
- 5. Where police vehicles are in public places, permission to photograph them should be obtained where practicable and members must not act in anyway that might interfere with or otherwise prejudice the work of the emergency services.
- 6. Preserved police vehicle owners must abide by the law at all times when their vehicles are being used on the road, no matter what era they are from. All items of police emergency equipment must be fully covered, removed or rendered inoperable when on the road. If you require further guidance on this matter, please contact any club officer for assistance before you travel. You are liable to arrest and prosecution if you fail to abide by the law.
- 7. Any member found to have contravened the Code of Conduct is liable to have his/her membership terminated without refund of membership fees.
