Every week I watch my son's anxiety and frustration melt away while working with the horses. He confidently gives commands and praise while being in tune and aware, with the horses' emotions and needs. Starlight instructors are knowledgeable, patient and kind while working with the students.

The practice of both the horse and her taking a breath together, has been used in the most overwhelming parts of her week. She literally stops, imagines she's in that safe space on the horse, and takes a breath with him. The touch, sound, and feeling of this experience can be recreated without her physically being there. 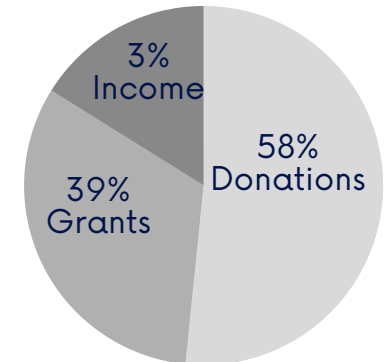
