Exam and his practical assessments. This now has SISA in the enviable position where we have twenty-four currently accredited Referees.

Planning is still underway to conduct the SISA Invitational in lieu of the Brophy Swim Meet at the Oasis Aquatic Centre, Wagga Wagga on Saturday 19th March. As can be appreciated with, and many clubs would be aware the costs to hold a meet of this nature can be excessive. I have been fortunate enough to secure a grant of \$2,000 to help offset the cost of the meet.

Saturday 12th February attended the Narrandera LC meet. Again, a well-run meet but numbers down as the meet coincided with a swim meet in the Ovens and Murray area as well as the Temora meet being held the following day. I am aware that this is a regular occurrence, however, I believe that for the benefit of these two clubs SISA must look at attempting, for the benefit of these two clubs to make these meets stand alone on a weekend.

Sunday 13th February attended the Temora LC meet. Numbers were down on previous years with COVID cases amongst families having an impact. Nevertheless, a very enjoyable country swim meet.

Friday 18th to Sunday 19th February saw SISA send a large contingent of swimmers to the Swimming NSW Country Championships. Many SISA swimmers achieved PBs and won medals in their races. Country Records were set with some swimmers achieving times to qualify for higher level meets. I am enormously proud of our Multi-Class swimmers who continue to excel and push themselves. It was most unfortunate that the meet was cancelled early, and to those swimmers that missed out, keep the chin up – SISA is so proud of you.

The NSW Government – Office of Sport is again this year offering swimming clubs and areas that are affiliated with Swimming NSW Grassroots Funding. The Grassroots Sport Fund is part of the NSW Government's Community Sport Recovery Package, providing a one-off grant of up to \$1,000 for clubs and associations to help the sporting sector and club communities recoup funds lost to COVID-19.

Swimming NSW, with support from the Office of Sport, will be responsible for administering the grant to its eligible affiliated clubs. Applications for this funding close on 24th March 2022.

This Grass Roots Funding was available last year, and I was disappointed that not every Swimming Club within SISA applied for the grant. I strongly urge every swimming Club within SISA to apply for this years' funding. This money will help SISA Clubs who have been struggling during the COVID restriction.
