#### **Updates/Accomplishments:**

- Spring Registration Late fee in effect, will close in a couple weeks
- Much like fall, spring numbers are down year over year
  - 501 players, 112 coaches as of 4/2/23
    - 544 players 121 coaches as of 5/1/22
    - Likely to get ~10 more player registrations this spring
  - 448 players, 59 coaches as of 3/3/23
    - 473 players, 61 coaches as of 2/26/22
  - 330 players, 46 coaches as of 2/4/23
    - 310 players, 34 coaches as of 2/1/22
  - 219 players, 35 coaches as of 1/6/23
    - 155 players, 26 coaches as of 1/4/22
  - Spring season almost kicked off
    - 2<sup>nd</sup> grade practice held on 3/31
    - Boys Kinders game day held on 4/1

#### <u>Issues/Concerns:</u>

- First week of intown rained out. Recommend 1 week season extension:
  - Restart week 1 next week
  - Kinder Boys get a 10-week program
  - PreK starts 4/15
  - Everyone finishes on 6/10
- Several intown coaches still need credentials
