<u>New Business:</u>

Player pass policy

Overview

The WYSA Player Pass Program is intended to provide teams the ability to field a team each week so that players can play soccer. It is NOT intended to increase your competitive advantage or fill a particular skill position that happens to be absent. It is intended for use in filling the PLANNED absences of players throughout the season. The Player Pass is only valid during the regular season; Player Pass is not valid for postseason play. Players must prioritize the game for their "regular" team as their first priority, be courteous when selecting players to pass as their own team/coach rely on them. A player may play only one player pass game per day, and must play in their own game.

Roster Limits Per Team

Use of player pass under the WYSA Player Pass Program cannot exceed the "standard number" of players on the field for your age group +4 G4,G6, +5 G8,G10,PG to align with WYSA's roster minimum requirements for each age group. The purpose of player pass is to provide you enough players to field a team and have substitutions.

- G4=11 total players
- G6= 13 total players
- G8, G10, PG= 16 total players

Players may not be added to teams beyond these limits.

Player Pass requests must be submitted to <u>Travel@wilmingtonyouthsoccer.org</u> by Thursday 11:59 pm weekly. When requesting Player Pass please include your TEAM NAME, names of absent players and names of requested guest players (if any of the information is missing or not provided by the deadline your player pass request will be denied). A member of Travel will process your request and email you a pdf of your updated roster. If you are unable to print a color roster please contact a member of Travel. Do not alter the roster in any way other than to write in missing roster numbers, any other markings will void your roster.
