Intown: Spring 2024 season update

- Spring registration final numbers:
 - **523** registered players, **126** registered coaches.
 - 2023 **518** / **114**.
- Intown schedule:
 - Added additional Intown day on Saturday, May 25.
 - Added additional PreK / Kinder day on **Monday**, **June 10** (currently 5pm, but going to change to 5.30pm).
 - Working with coaches on player and coach availability.
 - Will consolidate teams and coaches as needed.
 - Opponents to be arranged closer to the time.
 - Membership has been updated.
 - 1st Grade and 2nd Grade last practice (**June 11 and 14**) changed to game day.
 - Opponents to be arranged closer to the time.
 - Assuming no other cancelations, PreK will play all 8 scheduled games and everyone else will play 8 of 9.
- Rosters:
 - Checking in with 1st and 2nd grade coaches every week on how games have been going and parity (or otherwise) of teams.
 - Generally good, but influence of top 4 or 5 players in each grade (unsurprisingly) having a big effect on some of the outcomes.

• Coaches:

- Working with coaches on using and promoting TeamSnap. Definitely scope for improvement on this.
- Uniforms and equipment:
 - Approximately 85 new players this season so had to order additional balls.
 - Patches arrived. Patch Day is June 1.
 - Going to need new pinnies.

Changes/Proposals:

• TJ had an idea about changing timings of combining boys and girls practices for PreK (8am) and Kinder (9.15). Worth a discussion after the season.
