 Ultimately the membership supported the move The collaborative survey was emailed to the full WYSA membership (945 families), each of whom is listed in the Mass Youth Soccer members' database as being a current participant in Mass Youth Soccer programming. 654 recipients opened and, presumably, read the survey. Of those, 77 responses were submitted on the question of whether the respondent favored or opposed the move of WYSA from MYSL to ECYSA.  Net Replacement Schedule – recommend adopting the provided schedule to replace all nets on a 3 year period, with the exception of Yentile 11v11 which requires a 2 year replacement cycle.
