- 3. In email subject line, please put name of team and opponent (ex. Girls Grade 1 Revolution (home) vs. Galaxy (away)), Date of Game and Coach's Name
- ***Please provide the Grade, as well as the home team name and the away team name in the subject line or email content***
- 4. Add players' names (First / Last) and **team name** where appropriate, please include all players on the team.
- 5. Send email (email must be sent by 5:00pm, the Sunday following the weekend game)
