2024 Operating Budget - The "Summary Budget" tab has a consolidated presentation while more detail can be found on the "2024 Budget" tab. Dennis received feedback from Frank and TJ on their lines. For all others, absent input, he did best to estimate based on prior year results and 2023 budget. Based off these numbers we have a very small operating surplus and not much cushion for unexpected expenses. Additionally, we are slated to go over \$500K in cash revenue (audit threshold) so that needs to be monitored closely. We can work with the accountants when converting these numbers to the accrual basis which is required for our financial statements. 2/9/2024

Mike G. motion; Melissa Fiore as a 2nd

Move two 6th grade players up from Girls 5/6th grade mixed team (Thunder) to the girls 6-3 team (Rockets). After polling the coaches, the players moving up are Kyla Cottini and Leighana Ridley. The 6-3 Rockets lost one player to an injury, and one moved out of town, dropping their roster from 14 to 12. The Thunder currently have 16 on their roster.

Megan N. asked:

Have all other gender/grade teams remained stable in terms of numbers from Fall to Spring? Have any coaches shared/been asked if they have players that may be 'on the roster' but have basically decided to no longer participate (I ask because I had a situation in basketball where my team had two kids who basically decided not to play anymore/participate so I always faced low numbers – I am sure that can translate to soccer experiences as well).

What are the splits per gender/grade level in terms of roster numbers in current state for Spring? Is there any scenario where we have exposure for being inconsistent in terms of numbers if we make this adjustment? In this situation ... did travel identify this situation and look to solution? Or did the coach/team request a change?

Is either player the daughter of one of the coaches (I am not familiar with the coaches here so don't know)?

Per Melissa F.

The 6-3 coaches asked for assistance but did not identify players of interest.

Travel had 2 off season registrations that were added to the 5/6 mixed (per policy) increasing their fall roster from 14 to 16 for the spring season. Travel was aware during the fall season that the 6-3 team was having difficulty fielding a team on Saturdays (given their use of player pass) even with their roster size of 14. This past week a coach from 6-3 approached Travel with her concerns for the spring. She stated they had difficulty fielding a team when their roster was 14 and had concerns about fielding a team for the spring with only having a roster of 12 (due to the player that moved out of town and the other one out for the season with an injury). Player pass was reviewed with her and she shared that she ultimately only had the 5/6 mixed team to pass from because the 5-1 and 5-2 teams were in a higher division. She did reach out to the 4-1 team in the fall asking if any of their players would be interested in helping out and the coach declined citing the age difference (4th graders playing with 6th graders), the field size difference, and the skill difference of her players. She stated she felt it was unsafe.

With the 6-3 team roster dropping from 14 to 12 the roster falls below the WYSA roster minimum (13) for 9v9 teams so Travel reached out to the mixed team coaches for their player rankings. Those coaches identified Kyla Contini and Leighana Ridley as their top players. Travel then cross referenced that info with last year's PPE scores, Coach Scores and TD scores. The coaches recommendations aligned with the 3 pillars. We decided to motion both players for movement since the 5/6 mixed team had gained two players over the winter and both rosters would now have 14 players. The 5/6 mixed team would be an even mix-7 6th graders and 7 5th graders.

One other point I forgot to mention- Harper Hill was identified by 5/6 mixed team coaches as the "top" player, that also aligns with 3 pillars. We did not motion her for movement because Harper is a twin and her parents have requested the sisters stay together. Her sister, Ella, scores towards the bottom of the mixed team so Harper was not motioned to move

The two players who are no longer playing on the 6-3 team were among the most committed, with their absence the team will struggle even more fielding a team

The 5/6 mixed team gained two players over the winter, so moving two up does not make their roster smaller. It creates an even mix of 5th and 6th graders (7 and 7) as well as, allows us to accept more late registrations (if the opportunity arises). Historically, we attempt to leave room on the bottom teams across all age groups/genders to allow for late registrations to ensure all kids can play.

Brian M. -

For the whole board's knowledge, the Player Pass (borrowing a player from another travel team) will cost \$5 per transaction this spring. The league developed a method to conduct this all via the Essex portal vs the manual process previously. This \$5 per is to recoup the money spent.

I raise this as we try to avoid roster moves as much as possible when we build the season roster. We also try to avoid any teams that rely on player pass throughout the year. Regardless of the new cost the league is introducing, this roster move proposal makes sense to me given the circumstances...and its being granted to the 2 deserving players.

Rich P.

Player pass will now be an expense that we need to monitor - and possibly establish some further guidelines on when it can be used. Aka not letting an 9v9 coach with a roster of 13 or 14 use a player pass when only missing 1 player.

FYI - a few towns in Essex don't allow player pass at all due to the complexities (and it's a PIA) while most others have guidelines built around where and when.

Mike G. motion; Melissa Fiore as 2nd

Motion to allow the boys 3rd grade 5 team (Bengals) to have 14 players on their roster. They currently have 13 and we would like to add 1 more player to their roster. Explanation below.

Our travel policy maximum roster size for 7v7 is 13 players. We have a late registration being added (an intown player who skipped the fall). Normally we add to the bottom team and poll the coaches for the top 3 players who could possibly move up to the team above. When polling the 3-5 team coaches, they raised concern over player commitment. 3 players did not attend practices or games the final 3 weeks with no response from parents after contact attempts from head coach Matt Dorothy. 1 player only attended home games as their parents did not wish to travel to away games. The Bengals top 3 players were players with 100% attendance. Therefore the travel committee suggests allowing 14 players on the roster, above the maximum of 13.

Megan N. asked how many players were on 4 team ... answer 12.
