1 DAY OOTY TOUR PACKAGE

Botanical Garden: A large, well-maintained garden with a variety of plant species. The
gardens have around a thousand species, both exotic and indigenous,
of plants, shrubs, ferns, trees, herbal and bonsai plants. In the centre of the gardens lie
a fossilized tree trunk estimated to be 20 million years old. The gardens consist of
several lawns with flowering plants, ponds with lilies, beds of flowers and ferns laid out
in an Italian style, several plots of flowering plants, a variety of medicinal plants



• Rose Garden: The Ooty Rose Garden, located on the slopes of Elk Hill in Ooty, is one of the largest and most well-maintained rose gardens in India. Spread across 10 acres, the garden features over 20,000 rose plants representing nearly 3,000 varieties, including rare colors like black and green roses. Laid out in a terraced design, the garden offers beautiful pathways, rose arches, and scenic viewpoints, making it a favorite spot for nature lovers, photographers, and tourists. Maintained by the Tamil Nadu Horticulture Department, it is best visited during the blooming season from March to June.



Doddabetta Peak: Doddabetta Peak is the highest point in the Nilgiri Hills, located about 10 km from Ooty. Standing at an altitude of 2,637 meters (8,650 feet), it offers breathtaking panoramic views of the surrounding valleys, forests, and distant plains. The peak is accessible by road and features a Telescope House for tourists to enjoy a closer look at the scenic landscape. Surrounded by dense shola forests, Doddabetta is a popular spot for nature lovers, photographers, and trekkers visiting Ooty.



Ooty Lake: Ooty Lake is a scenic artificial lake located in the heart of Ooty, originally built in 1824 by John Sullivan. Surrounded by eucalyptus trees and greenery, the lake stretches over 65 acres and is a popular spot for boating, offering pedal, row, and motor boats. With a small amusement area, garden, and food stalls nearby, it's a perfect place for a relaxed family outing. The calm waters and pleasant surroundings make it one of Ooty's most visited tourist attractions. Tea Museum: An ideal stop to learn about the teamaking process and sample Ooty's famous teas



• **Sims Park**: Sim's park and the Botanical Garden to gather from the largest repository of temperate plants in India and an important destination for Botanists. Sim's Park is the venue for the annual vegetable and fruit show.
