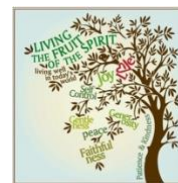


## **“Red Door” News: Bulletin for June 29<sup>th</sup> – Pentecost 03**

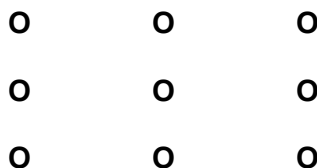
