Constitution of Biggar United Junior Football Team

Article I: Name

The name of the organization shall be Biggar United Junior Football Club.

<u>Article II: Purpose</u>

The purpose of the team is to promote youth participation in football, develop players' skills, foster teamwork and sportsmanship, and engage positively with the local community.

Article III: Membership

- 1. Membership is open to all youth interested in playing football.

Article IV: Governance

2. Each body shall be reviewed annually.

Article V: Meetings

1. Regular meetings shall be held monthly to discuss team activities, finances, and any other

pertinent issues.

2. Special meetings may be called by the Chairman or upon request by a majority of the

committee members.

Article VI: Financial Management

1. The team shall maintain a bank account for funds, managed by the Treasurer.

2. All expenditures must be approved by the committee.
