It is not a beauty pageant but rather a personal growth opportunity for local young ladies—one that provides significant training in interview skills, personal presentation, and perseverance, as well as five college scholarships. Over 6:30am Saturday coffee meetings and late night e-mail exchanges, River and Jes have worked tirelessly and passionately to bring this program to you in 2015 and look forward to continuing and expanding the program in 2016.
