





The Mr. Oak Harbor Scholarship Competition scoring system is the most comprehensive and objective model that one is ever likely to find. It incorporates thirteen categories with variable weighting and is designed to honor the whole person.

All contestants participate in the same 6-week program and are scored using identical models. 9th- and 10th-graders compete for the title of Teen Mister Oak Harbor, while 11th- and 12th-graders compete for the title of Mister Oak Harbor.

Competition points are earned in Attendance, Board of Directors Input, Personal Interview, Video Journals, Marketing, Speech or Talent, Formal Wear, Stage Presence, Academics, Service, Physical Fitness, Extra-Curricular Activities, and Work.

Competition scoring in most primary categories takes place prior to competition night. On competition night, our judges will score Speech/Talent, Formal Wear, and Stage Presence, as well as an impromptu question. The judges will score their responses, and those scores will be added to the contestants' overall competition score to determine final placement, with the top 3 in each division being crowned Royalty.
