A subsequent Royalty Contract will be activated upon your coronation, should you achieve the title of Miss Oak Harbor, Princess, Teen Miss Oak Harbor, or Teen Princess.

As a contestant in the Miss Oak Harbor Scholarship Pageant, I certify that I meet the following required criteria, and if I should fail to meet such criteria at any time during the program, I will resign from the competition, forfeiting any fees which were paid on my behalf, either by a sponsor or myself.

- * I live in Oak Harbor or attend an Oak Harbor school
- * I possess moral integrity
- * I identify as female

I also agree to the following:

1. I will attend and be on time to the scheduled events required of me.
2. I will come fully prepared for rehearsals and scheduled events.
3. I will give my undivided attention during all pageant activities.
4. I will limit my cell phone usage at rehearsals and pageant activities to emergency purposes and breaks only.
5. I will at all times conduct myself in such a manner that is in keeping with the prestigious image that is associated with the pageant.

The Miss Oak Harbor Scholarship Pageant has awarded many thousands of dollars in scholarships and prizes. In exchange for the opportunity to compete for scholarships and prizes, contestants agree to spend 6 weeks working with Miss Oak Harbor and its affiliates on Monday and Wednesday nights (7pm-9pm) as well as several Saturdays for a few hours. MEDICAL RELEASE AND LIABILITY WAIVER: I do hereby authorize Pageant Representatives to act as Agents for me (or my child, if under age 18) and to consent to emergency medical, surgical, or dental examinations, treatments, etc. In addition, I hereby release and discharge Miss Oak Harbor, the Pageant, and any sponsoring organizations from any and all claims for personal injuries.
