

## MOH Scoring 101



The Miss Oak Harbor Scholarship Pageant scoring system is the most comprehensive and objective model that one is ever likely to find. It incorporates thirteen categories with variable weighting and is designed to honor the whole person.

All contestants participate in the same 6-week program and are scored using identical models. 9<sup>th</sup>- and 10<sup>th</sup>-graders compete for the title of Teen Miss Oak Harbor, while 11<sup>th</sup>- and 12<sup>th</sup>-graders compete for the title of Miss Oak Harbor.

Pageant points are earned in Attendance, Board of Directors Input, Personal Interview, Video Journals, Marketing, Formal Wear, Stage Presence, Speech or Talent, Academics, Service, Physical Fitness, Extra-Curricular Activities, and Work.

Pageant scoring in most primary categories takes place prior to pageant night. On pageant night, the pageant judges score Formal Wear, Speech/Talent, and Stage Presence, then the top 5 in each division will be asked an impromptu question. Those scores will be added to the contestants' overall pageant score to determine final placement, with the top 3 in each division being crowned Royalty.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR 5% of Overall Score	1 per hour: September 1 – February 28
FORMAL WEAR 9% of Overall Score	Poise, confidence, walk, timing, suitable and age-appropriate dress, hair and makeup, added style or accessories, connection with audience <i>Scored by Pageant Judges</i>
MARKETING 10% of Overall Score	Fundraising Event: 2 per ticket WR Valentine's Day Ball: 6 per sweetheart ticket, 4 per regular ticket Well-Wishes: 5 per 1/8-page ad or 10 per 1/4-page ad PaperPie Cards: 5 per boxed set Pageant Tickets: 10 per ticket Bring a Friend: 10 per contestant Find Your Own Sponsor: 10
PERSONAL INTERVIEW 10% of Overall Score	Timely arrival, self-introduction, eye contact, smile, posture, appearance, enthusiasm, self-confidence, depth/profundity, candidness/honesty, persuasiveness, communication style, timing/thoughtful consideration, minimal use of verbal fillers, overall impression <i>Scored by Pageant Judges</i>
PHYSICAL FITNESS 5% of Overall Score	10 per high school sport this school year – fall & winter seasons only Up to 5 per month per athletic class or club sport this school year (1 per month for number of days/week) 0.5 per PE class 1 <sup>st</sup> trimester, semester, or quarter this school year 0.25 per 1-hour gym workout
SERVICE 5% of Overall Score	1 per volunteer hour: June 1 – February 28 Required: 1 hour of service with personal platform/cause
SPEECH/TALENT 5% of Overall Score	Talent: Degree of difficulty, ability, originality, execution, stage presence, personalitySpeech: Delivery and profundity of message, pronunciation/clarity, intonation/pitch, rhythm/timing, eye contact, body language/theatrics Scored by Pageant Judges
STAGE PRESENCE 8% of Overall Score	Dance, introduction, Formal Wear, walk, eye contact, smile, connection with audience Scored by Pageant Judges
VIDEO JOURNALS 10% of Overall Score	3 per weekly video journal that addresses the weekly topic, is the appropriate length, and is submitted on time by the appropriate method
WORK 5% of Overall Score	1 per hour: September 1 – February 28
