- Pageant is limited to the first 25 completed applications (combined Miss/Teen divisions)

■ Contestant Agreement & Contract

■ On back of application

■ Business Sponsorship

- Sponsorship help and sample request letter on website
- Business sponsors must be secured before turning in application

■ Special Requirements

- Abide by all Covid restrictions
- Must have access to smart phone or tablet for filming
