





8d. PEOPLE'S CHOICE

- **\\$1 = 1 vote ... Donations are tax-deductible**
- Online TOMORROW with names photos Jan 24
- Vote for Me cards, write personal letter to family & friends, post on social media, QR code at your business sponsor, etc.
- We At Pageant Debrief, list of donors for thank-yous
- ONE WINNER takes half of all PC votes collected (\$6300 in 2021)
- OPTIONAL Another way to earn more scholarship money

9. SCORING

Pageant scoring consists of fourteen categories with variable weighting, all scored prior to pageant night:

- Attendance (10%)
- Board of Directors Input (9%)
- Personal Interview (8%)
- Health & Wellness (8%)
- Style & Self-Expression (8%)
- Marketing (8%)
- Speech or Talent (8%)
- Formal Wear (8%)
- Stage Presence (8%)
- Academics (5%)
- Service (5%)
- Physical Fitness (5%)
- Extra-Curricular Activities (5%)
- Work (5%)

9a. ATTENDANCE

Sign in at every MOH event

4 points per required event (light or dark gold on the calendar)
 3 points per excused late, excused early leave, or excused absence
 2 points per upeyoused late or early leave

2 points per unexcused late or early leave

Let River know in writing (text, email, Classroom message) if you need to miss, arrive late, or leave early.

Attendance = 10% of overall pageant score

9b. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- Besides the judges' scoring, the only subjective scoring category
- Scoring based on commitment to what the MOH program stands for:
 - Leadership/mentorship
 - Preparedness
 - Attitude
 - Cooperation
 - Communication
 - Integrity/authenticity
 - Direction following
 - Completed platform/cause volunteer hour

BOD = 9% of overall pageant score

9c. PERSONAL INTERVIEW

Interview coaching Feb. 1



- Wersonal Interviews Feb. 22, by
 - appointment via Zoom
- 10-minute interviews conducted by pageant judges
- Interview = 8% of overall pageant score

9d. HEALTH & WELLNESS

Wellness video diaries

W Directions:

- Address both topics specifically
- Minimum 30 seconds for each video diary
- Submit through Google Classroom
- Submit by midnight every Friday

One point per direction followed

Just you and the camera - no parents or friends in the room

9e. STYLE & SELF-EXPRESSION

Weight Style & Self-Expression video diaries

- Address both topics specifically
- Minimum 30 seconds for each video diary
- Submit through Google Classroom
- Submit by midnight every Friday

One point per direction followed Just you and the camera - no parents or friends in the room



9f. MARKETING

Turn in sales money – in a sealed envelope with name, dollar amount, what was sold and how many to file boxes (folders by contestant #) or to Miss Kate at Windermere on any Wednesday

- Applebee's Pancake Breakfast Tickets = 2 points per ticket
- Usborne Cards = 5 points per boxes set
- Well-Wish Ads = 5 points per 1/8-page ad (max 4) or 10 points per 1/4-page ad (max 2)
- Pageant Tickets = 10 points per ticket
- Bring a Friend = 10 per new contestant

Marketing = 8% of overall pageant score

9g. TALENT/SPEECH

- Waximum 90 seconds
- Speeches must be delivered without notes
- Speech topic = CHANGE
- **'** Filming March 4
- Talent/Speech = 8% of overall pageant score



9h. FORMAL WEAR

- Pick out a dress or outfit that makes you feel happy and confident
- You do not need to spend money; try to use one you already have in your closet, or borrow one from a friend or the Pageant Closet
- Scoring:
 - Confidence
 - Walk/Timing
 - Suitability of dress/outfit, hair, and make-up
 - Added style or accessories
 - Connection with audience
- 👾 Filming March 4
- Formal Wear = 8% of overall pageant score

9h. FORMAL WEAR



- Short dress
- Long dress
- Tuxedo/Women's suit
- Heels or flats



9i. STAGE PRESENCE

Scoring

- Choreography
- Eye contact
- Smile
- Walk
- Introduction
- Connection with audience

Stage Presence = 8% of overall pageant score



- Based on cumulative GPA through first semester, trimester, or quarter + rigor of classes
- We will submit transcript requests to OHHS
 Homeschooled students see River
- We Non-OHHS Transcripts due by Feb 15
- We have no points in this category Academics = 5% of overall pageant score



9k. SERVICE

Verification Form must be signed by supervisor

Eligible hours = those worked for organizations

- Church
- Nonprofit business
- Service club (outside of school hours)
- Eligible dates = Jun 18 Feb 28

Service = 5% of overall pageant score

91. PHYSICAL FITNESS

- Verification Form
 - Must be completed by coach or instructor
- Eligible dates = Sept 1 Feb 28
- HS sports = 10 points each for fall and winter seasons
- PE class = 0.5 per class first semester, trimester, or quarter this year
- **Club Sports & Athletic Classes**
 - 1 point per month (1 day/week)
 - 2 points per month (2 days/week)
 - 3 points per month (3 days/week)
 - 4 points per month (4 days/week)
 - 5 points per month (5 days/week)
- Thrive = 0.25 points per 60-minute workout Jan 12 March 11
- We Physical Fitness = 5% of overall pageant score

9m. EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

- Activities that you participate in outside of school hours
- Clubs, plays, dance performances, NJROTC, etc.
- Cannot count hours included on any other form
- Eligible dates = Sept 1 Feb 28
- Extracurricular Activities = 5% of overall pageant score



Verification Form Must be signed by supervisor

- Work for which you were paid
- 👾 1 point per hour, Sept 1 Feb 28
 - Work = 5% of overall pageant score
