All terms and conditions herein must be agreed upon and adhered to while a contestant in the competition. A subsequent Royalty Contract will be activated upon your coronation, should you achieve the title of Mister Oak Harbor. Prince. Teen Mister Oak Harbor, or Teen Prince.

As a contestant in the Mr. Oak Harbor Scholarship Competition, I certify that I meet the following required criteria, and if I should fail to meet such criteria at any time during the program, I will resign from the competition, forfeiting any fees which were paid on my behalf, either by my sponsor or myself.

- \* I live in Oak Harbor School District or attend an Oak Harbor school
- \* I possess moral integrity
- \* I identify and live my life authentically as male

### I also agree to the following:

- 1. I will attend and be on time to the scheduled events required of me.
- 2. I will come fully prepared for rehearsals and scheduled events.
- 3. I will give my undivided attention during all competition activities.
- 4. I will limit my cell phone usage at rehearsals and program activities to emergency purposes and breaks only.
- 5. I will at all times conduct myself in such a manner that is in keeping with the prestigious image that is associated with the program.

The Mr. Oak Harbor Scholarship Competition will award thousands of dollars in scholarships and prizes. In exchange for the opportunity to compete for scholarships and prizes, contestants agree to spend 6 weeks working with Whidbey Royalty and its affiliates on mostly Monday and Wednesday nights as well as one or two Saturdays for a few hours. Scoring Categories: The Mr. Oak Harbor Scholarship Competition uses a unique scoring system that takes into account the whole person and incorporates 14 scoring categories: Attendance, Board of Directors Input, Video Journals, Marketing, Personal Interview, Platform/Cause Presentation, Formal Wear, Academics, Service, Presentation or Talent, Stage Presence, Physical Fitness, Extra-Curricular, and Work
