

The Mr. Oak Harbor Scholarship Competition scoring system is the most comprehensive and objective model that one is ever likely to find. It incorporates fourteen categories with variable weighting and is designed to honor the whole person.

Competition points are earned in Attendance, Board of Directors Input, Video Journals, Marketing, Personal Interview, Platform/Cause Presentation, Formal Wear, Academics, Service, Presentation or Talent, Stage Presence, Physical Fitness, Extra-Curricular Activities, and Work.

Competition scoring in most primary categories takes place prior to competition night. On competition night, our judges will score Presentation/Talent, Formal Wear, and Stage Presence, as well as an impromptu question for the top five contestants. Those scores will be added to the contestants' overall competition scores to determine final placement, with the top three overall being crowned Royalty.

PLATFORM/CAUSE PRESENTATION 7% of Overall Score	Clear introduction of platform and cause/organization, obvious research of platform and cause/organization, clear and informative presentation Scored by Competition Judges
FORMAL WEAR 7% of Overall Score	Poise, confidence, walk, timing, appropriate clothing, connection with audience Scored by Competition Judges
ACADEMICS 5% of Overall Score	Multiply GPA by 10 + 1 per AP & Running Start class; + 0.5 per Honors & "College" Class Through end of school last year
SERVICE 5% of Overall Score	1 per volunteer hour: March 1 – October 31 Required: 1 hour of service with personal platform/cause
PRESENTATION/TALENT 5% of Overall Score	Talent: Degree of difficulty, ability, originality, execution, stage presence, personality Presentation (can be a speech): Delivery and profundity of message, pronunciation/clarity, intonation/pitch, rhythm/timing, eye contact, body language/theatrics Scored by Competition Judges
STAGE PRESENCE 5% of Overall Score	Introduction, walk, eye contact, smile, connection with audience Scored by Competition Judges
PHYSICAL FITNESS 5% of Overall Score	10 per high school sport this school year – fall season only Up to 5 per month per athletic class or club sport June 1 – October 31: 1 per month for number of days per week 0.25 per 1-hour workout September 29 – October 31
EXTRA-CURRICULAR 5% of Overall Score	1 per hour: June 1 – October 31
