## \*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*2025 MBRA Finals Rules & Regulations\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*

## Do not arrive on the grounds UNTIL 10:00 AM Thursday October 2nd

- Each contestant must be a current member of the Manitoba Barrel Racing Association (MBRA) and be qualified to compete in the appropriate division they have entered. To qualify each contestant must attend the required number of jackpots within their division(s).
  - **Open**: 5 jackpots **Youth**: 3 jackpots **Select**: 3 jackpots (Open members must have competed at 2 jackpots on MB Soil / Youth and Select must have competed at 1 jackpot on MB Soil)
- 2. Entry form will be available on-line only and payment options will be e-transfer (password: mbra2025) or cheque. All fees and appropriate paperwork must accompany the finals entry and received to the office by September 8<sup>th</sup> or will be considered late and NOT be accepted. You must pay in Canadian Funds.
- 3. Registration will be at the office located by the canteen area from 10:00am 9:00pm. All competitors must register (or have someone register on their behalf) by no later than 9:00pm Thursday October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2025. Failure to comply with this can result in a turnout with no refund.
- 4. A contestant may enter and ride as many horses as they have qualified in their division, with the **exception** of the Pee Wee Division where only one horse per contestant can be entered.
- 5. CARRY OVERS: Youth Contestants can carry over their time to Open for Day 1 and Day 2 if they enter the Open division. If they make the short-go in both of their respective divisions, the contestant will have to run in both divisions to be eligible for prizes in that division. Select Contestants choosing to carry their time will run in the Open and carry over their time to Select for Day 1 and Day 2 if they enter the Open division. If they make the short-go in both of their respective divisions, the contestant will have to run in both divisions to be eligible for prizes in that division. If a contestant enters Select only, they will run separately from the Open.
- 6. Running order will be determined by a random draw for the 1st go. The order will be reversed for the 2nd go. The short gorounds will run from slowest time to fastest time (for qualified horses). All competitors must run horses in their draw order. Running out of draw order will result in a No Time.
- 7. Contestants must be ready when called to ride into the holding pen when group of five is called. **Once Arena Director closes** the gate you cannot enter the holding pen and you will receive a No Time.
- 8. Contestants' names will be called 3 times and then their run will be forfeited should they not ride their horse into the arena and start their run after the 3rd call. No exceptions. Arena director has the final call on this.
- 9. Reruns shall be granted if the timer fails to work properly or if the barrels are not placed properly on their markers. No prior penalty will apply to the rerun. The arena director will determine when the rerun is ran.
- 10. The **Arena Director has the final decision** on any matters related to competition runs or rule violations during a run. Decisions on any matters related to the event will be made by the MBRA executive in consultation with the arena staff.
- 11. The arena is set up with paneled wings and a closed gate. All runs are to be completed at competition caliber. Riders are to stay up near the front of the holding pen when someone is running and are to <u>stay mounted</u> on their horse until all runs in their group are completed (this is for the safety of you and others).
- 12. The arena will be worked with a tractor after a set number of runs. This number will be determined by the MBRA executive prior to the start of the event and will be posted.
- 13. Losing your hat in the arena will result in a \$5 fee to get your hat back.
- 14. Western attire is mandatory when competing, long sleeve shirt, cowboy boots and cowboy hat or approved helmet.
- 15. Absolutely no horses not entered in Finals will be allowed on the grounds.
- 16. Order of go will be posted at the event. No trades or changes will take place.

- 18. Short Go award winers must be in attendance and dressed in western attire (cowboy hat and long sleeve shirt) to receive awards. Should the winner not be present, the prize will be forfeited, no exceptions. Sidepot awards (Futurity/Derby/MB Bred) can be picked up on our behalf as we understand you may not have made the short go to be present. Sidepot results will be posted Saturday night, so it is your responsibility to have someone there to pick up a sidepot award Sunday if you are not there.
- 19. If there is a tie for prizes a coin toss will be done to determine the winner of the higher prize.
- 20. Inhumane treatment of horses will not be tolerated and will result in disqualification.
- 21. You are not allowed to tie to your trailers overnight. Violation of this rule may result in disqualification from the event.
- 22. There will be no tack stalls available. Please be considerate of fire regulations and not clutter the aisles. Stalling is assigned for those who select stalling. We will accommodate stall requests within reason. If you request stalling by another competitor your stall will not be slotted on the map until their entry arrives. Please ONLY request stalling beside another competitor you are hauling with or a family member.
- 23. Absolutely no riding your horse down the barn aisles.
- 24. Dogs must be on a leash at all times; they are not allowed beyond the barn. Please respect the rules of the facility. (NO DOGS IN THE ARENA)
- 25. NO SUBSTITUTION OF QUALIFIED HORSES is permitted after entries close, and the draw is complete.
- 26. Absolutely no selling of competition spots under any circumstances.
- 27. Cheques not picked up at the finals will be mailed the week following finals. Payout will be made in Canadian Funds.

## 28. **Refunds:**

If a horse or rider becomes injured and unable to compete before the event starts, a refund may be requested. 70% of entry fee money only will be refunded for divisions entered and MB Bred and Futurity/Derby side pots. A vet/doctor certificate must be received to the MBRA office by October 1, 2025. If the horse/rider has been registered when they become unable to compete, there will be no refund. There will be **NO refunds for stall fees** and un-notified vet or doctor releases.
