

## MEMBER CODE OF CONDUCT – GENERAL STANDARDS

These are the minimum standards required of all members of the Leopold Cricket Club:

- 1. The use of verbal or physical abuse is not acceptable
- 2. Members will refrain from any form of harassment including:
  - a. harassment of any person with a disability
  - b. sexual harassment
  - c. racial harassment or vilification
- 3. Members are expected to take pride in our clubrooms and respect the furniture and fittings. Prior to leaving the clubrooms, members must ensure the area they (or their guest/s) have used is clean and tidy
- 4. Members are responsible for the behaviour of any visitor/s they introduce to the club
- 5. Members are expected to both conduct themselves in an acceptable manner and display responsible behaviour
- 6. Members are expected to make umpires, opposition players and officials feel welcome when they are our guests at all times
- 7. Members are expected to respect our club officials and other members
- 8. When in charge of a motor vehicle, members are expected to drive in a sensible and safe manner, especially in the presence of pedestrian traffic
- 9. Senior playing members are expected to assist in the development of junior players, be prepared to attend junior training sessions and matches when called upon.
- 10. Current members are expected to welcome new members and include new members in their activities
- 11. Children are not permitted to enter the change room facilities unless directly supervised especially on match days or unless involved in player support eg water boys
- 12. Children under the age of 16 are not permitted to attend club functions without parental supervision
- 13. Abuse of alcohol is not acceptable and contravenes the club's commitment to the ADF Good Sports programme
