### FORMAT:

September 5	<b>Best Ball</b>
September 12	<b>Scramble</b>
September 19	<b>Alternate Shot</b>
September 26	<b>One Club &amp; Putter</b>

Points will be given for each event. One for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, etc. Team with the lowest points wins. Cash prizes based on entries.

Since this tournament has prizes, you must have someone else, beside the two team members, sign the scorecard. Each team must play with someone to verify that their score is accurate

## **SEPTEMBER 5 – BEST BALL**

How it's played – Each player plays his own ball and keeps track of his own score. At the end of the round, handicap will be subtracted off each hole and the best score between the partners will be used towards final score.

## **SEPTEMBER 12 – SCRAMBLE**

How it's played – Each player hits the ball. Then you must on the better ball and each player hits from that spot. Play the entire round like that. Only one score should be recorded on the scorecard.

## **SEPTEMBER 19 – ALTERNATE SHOT**

How it's played – Both players tee off on the first hole; Choose the best shot and play alternate shot from there on out. **DO NOT ALTERNATE TEE OFF'S!** The player who makes the final putt **DOES NOT** tee off on the next hole.

## **SEPTEMBER 26 – ONE CLUB & PUTTER**

How it's played – Each player plays his own game by choosing one club to use for the entire round, plus the putter. Subtract your handicap off at the end of the round and then add your 2 scores together.

In order to be eligible to win a prize, ALL 4 matches must be played. Please try to make up a missed match by the following Thursday. Points will be given for each event: 1 for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, etc. Team with total low points wins. Cash prizes are based on entries. Prizes will also be awarded for each night's event.
