| Enrollment: | Maximum of 100 campers (ages 5 to 14) |
| Fees/Payments: | Weekly Camp Fee: \$75/week per camper; *\$5 discount for 3 or more or campers registered prior to May 27th. \$100/week for all-inclusive rate. Registration: \$45/camper (non-refundable) **Payments must be paid by cash, cash app (parent must pay additional 2.75% fee – see page 4), check, or money order payable to Love Life Center . Weekly fees are payable on the Friday before the next camp week . If the weekly fee for the child is not paid by that Monday morning beginning the new camp week, the child will not be able to attend camp until fees are paid plus an additional \$5.00 late fee . **Weekly fees are due even if the camper does not attend camp for that week. As a courtesy, families are allowed one-week vacation without penalty (please provide advanced notice of the week the camper(s) will be away from camp). A late fee will be charged if a parent picks up his/her child up late. Late fees are as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 6:00 p.m. – 6:15 p.m. – free grace period• 6:16 p.m. – 6:59 p.m. – \$1.00/minute• After 7:00 p.m. (Dept. of Family & Children Services) will be contacted. |
| Late Pick-up: | |
| Sign-In: | Children must be escorted to the building to be signed in/out. Only authorized persons on file may pick up campers – no exceptions . |
| Field Trips: | A Field Trip notification will be given out weekly. Parents will be responsible for paying cost for each field trip before the scheduled trip if opting out of all-inclusive rate. If a parent chooses not to pay for his/her child to attend one of these outings, the parent is asked to make other arrangements for the child for that day. Campers should wear their camp t-shirt for all field trips. |

| Meals: | Breakfast and Lunch are prepared by Bold Ministries, Inc. A menu will be posted. Meals are served only during the designated time (breakfast: 7:30 a.m.- 8:30 a.m.; lunch: 12:00 p.m. - 1:15 p.m.) If a child has specific food allergies or dietary needs, parents should provide medical documentation to the camp director and may send additional pre-prepared food to the camp if desired. Camp Love Life provides an afternoon snack. |
| Weekly Schedule: | A schedule outlining weekly activities and guest presenters (Hot Topics!) will be given to parents each week. |

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CAMP ESSENTIALS

- Parent/Guardian must complete and sign each page of the Enrollment Package before a camper can be left on-site (Forms includes Enrollment Application, Camper Pick-up Authorization, Permission Form/Liability Release, and Disciplinary Action and Penalties),
 - Learning Book and Notebook/Journal (provided by camp)
 - School Summer Packet or Required Book (if assigned by school)
 - Medicine or Inhaler in plastic bag with camper's name (if needed)
 - Bag (to carry personal items – write camper's name on it)
 - Water Bottle
 - Change of Clothes (if child has accidents)
 - Sneakers (if child wears flip flops or sandals)
 - Shorts or leggings (if girls wear skirts or dresses)
 - Sunscreen
 - Bug Repellent
 - Towel and Change of Underwear (Swimming Days)
 - Blanket (If child will take a nap)
 - Light Jacket (if child tends to get cold)
 - Game Bag or Plastic Zip Lock with camper's name (for electronic games) •
- Labels with camper's name on every CD, DVD, or Board Game

There are nine weeks of camp. There will be no field trips taken during Week #1 (with the exceptions of park/library). On occasions, field trips or groups will be split up according to age, gender or height criteria (depends on location). The mode of transportation is passenger van and/or school bus with a licensed CDL school bus endorsement. The exact dates and rates will be **provided. Field trips must be paid for the day prior to the scheduled date.** Monies will not be accepted the day of the trip. Field Trips are a privilege. The Camp Love Life Staff and Parents have the right to deny a camper participation on a field trip.
