My dear friends of Branches of the Cross,

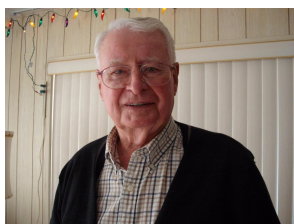

Financial Report by Bob Graves

The May financial report presented to the vestry by the finance committee had some good news and some bad news.

The first piece of good news is that donations to the church have been steadily climbing since January. The increases have not been very large, but it is very encouraging that donations are going the right direction.

The second piece of good news is that May expenses dropped significantly. From December through April, we had unusual and unexpected expenses ranging from \$1500 to \$2000 each month, but our May expenses dropped almost to the level of the expenses we had prior to December.

Despite this good news, we are still operating in the red. Our net loss for the month of May was \$600.

In April, we received payout of the loan the church was carrying. The vestry decided to use a portion of those funds for two major projects. The first was installation of solar panels for the rectory, Shekinah House, and Disciple House. Starting in July, this will save us about \$500 per month on the average, and the system will pay for itself in less than nine years.

The second project is remodeling the kitchen in Disciple House. We have for a long time had significant electrical and plumbing problems there, but have not had the funds to correct them. The good news is that we are now able to do so, but the bad news is that the project is costing us about \$20,000 more than initially expected due to the skyrocketing cost of construction materials. For example, the hardwoods used in the cabinetry come from Russia.

While we do have the cash in the bank to complete the project, we were counting on that \$20,000 as a cushion to sustain us as we rebuild the church's income to previous levels, and as an emergency fund to cover unexpected future expenses that may arise.

We would appreciate your continued prayers for the church's finances, and, of course, we would greatly appreciate any additional financial support you can provide.

There is wonderful news. The kitchen remodel at Disciple House is underway!

It is a major remodel but finally the house will have an adequate draining and sewage system. The dishwasher will be able to be used, there will be ample refrigerator and freezer space, AND there will be a pantry!

The original plan was to expand the square footage of the kitchen space to make room for food service in and out of the patio area. However, expanding the area will have to wait for another time because building and remodeling costs have skyrocketed in the past few months. Old buildings hide unexpected remodel expenses. Not only re-piping, but electrical upgrades, and the cost of other materials are putting us way over budget by at least \$20,000.

So we wanted to appeal to you. **We truly need your help!** Please allow the Holy

Spirit to speak to your heart. If you are able to join us in this effort by contributing to cover the overage in costs.

Apart of the 3-Day and 1-Day Healing Intensives, there are several ministries and churches which are looking at using the Branches of the Cross campus facilities. We have a wonderful opportunity to continue serving the Christian community. And I am asking that you be a part of it. By walking together with us to complete the building and restoration projects, you will be serving the large Church in ways that none of us can fathom.

Let's walk together and see the greatness of God manifested in our midst.
