Synod, as defined historically, is a gathering of the leaders of a Diocese, both ordained and lay, who prayerfully consider in God's presence the important matters that are before the



Bishop Andrew Williams, Bishop of New England

The plenary speaker at DWA Synod 2022 will be Bishop Andrew Williams. He asks how can we effectively be the salt and light of the world? How do we best work for God's Kingdom? He will be teaching on these topics at the Synod!

Bishop Andrew began his professional life as a corporate litigator in the United Kingdom, but despite a successful career, he began to sense that something significant was missing in his life. He and his wife, Elena found themselves drawn into something far deeper, and ultimately came to a living faith in God through the love, support and friendship of their Anglican Parish. He trained for ordination at Trinity College, Bristol where he graduated with an honors degree in Church. In a Synod, one may expect to be inspired, encouraged, taught and trained for more effective ministry through the Church. To learn more go to *2022 Synod* to register and find hotel info. theology. He was ordained in the Diocese of Exeter in 2000 and spent six years as Associate Vicar of St. Andrew's, Chorleywood. Beginning in October 2009, Bp. Andrew served as the Senior Pastor of Trinity Church in Greenwich, CT. In 2019 he was elected as bishop for the Diocese of New England.


TALKS BEING OFFERED AT THE SYNOD

This month we are featuring LALU MOOKEN by Lalu and, Iva Heide



I was born in Kottayam, Kerala State, India, Feb. 8th 1945 to Joseph and Grace. I am the oldest one of three. My marriage was arranged by a family friend. We have dowry system. Whatever the bridegroom family asks for, the bride family has to give the money. That custom is still going on. I was married to Joe Mooken in 1964 and in 1965 my oldest daughter was born. In 1966 my husband got a scholarship to come to United States for higher

studies (Pharmacy). In 1967 I came to United States with my oldest daughter Miriam. We were in Michigan until my husband finished his Master's degree. My youngest daughter Michelle was born in 1970 in Michigan. We moved to California when he got a job in LA with one of the pharmaceutical companies for two years and then he got a job in San Diego (La Jolla) area as a chemist.

In California I worked as a Quality Control Inspector in an electronic company and Visual Inspector in another company. Later, I worked a part-time job at Home Goods in Encinitas, CA until I retired. My oldest daughter received a degree in Business and Home Science and the youngest one Michelle received a Doctorate in Pharmacy. Miriam married Tony Katzdorn. He was in the Navy and now is working at a computer firm. They have one son Dane. Michelle married Jay Gupta. He is a mechanical engineer and the Director of his company. They have two sons Dylan and Ryan. I was a member of Good Samaritan Episcopal Church in University City, the Anglican Church of the Resurrection and, now Branches of the Cross. My husband passed away in 2016.

A typical day for Lalu who is a prayer warrior...

Some times I get up at 6:30 a.m. and praise God. After breakfast sometimes I read the Bible and sing some songs from the Anglican Church of Resurrection praise. Then it is time for cooking for that day. At 9 a.m. Monday through Friday I Zoom morning prayer from Christ the King. Then I pray for my kid's family and myself. That takes one hour. By then I have my lunch time. After lunch, cleaning my apartment here and there. In the evening I pray for other people who asked for prayers. That is a big list. That takes another hour. In between I watch news.

Lalu has clergy in her family in India. In her dad's family, there was a Bishop and her husband's brother Mar Aprem, is a Metropolitan Bishop. Under him there are two Bishops that he ordained.

Lalu used to travel to India every two years but then the pandemic came along and she hasn't been back.

Lalu also helps Iva with setting up the food for fellowship on Sundays and clean

up afterwards since Bobbi left.

It is a pleasure to know Lalu and, what a model of dedication she is to her calling as an intercessory prayer ministry.

The cost put us way over budget by at least \$20,000 due to the rising cost of materials, unexpected repairs and extra construction.
