Front man, lead vocals, and guitar - Jeff Tatum has many years of experience in the entertainment business. For over 30 years, he has gathered some of the best talent from Missouri and Oklahoma to produce Jeff Tatum and Palomino Moon. He started playing guitar when he was 13 years old. In the 80's, in Tennessee, Jeff was one of the founding members of The Blind Farmers with Alan McDonald, Ben Northern, Sammy Baker and later Roy Watts. They had the pleasure of sharing the stage with the Georgia Satellites, Guadalcanal Diary, RPM, Bill Lloyd, Radny Foster of Foster and Lloyd and numerous others. Upon returning to Missouri, Jeff formed The Palomino Moon Band, playing at venues across the U.S., as well as touring at events sponsored by Coors Ranch Rodeo.

Lead guitar and vocals - Danny McBride began playing at 4 years old with father Bobby McBride and in the shadow of the Texas Playboys, and at 18 years old with Merle Travis, then went on to play with Brooks and Dunn, David Frizzel, Vern Gosdin, and Clinton Gregory. Also, Danny was in the movie "8 Seconds" and played on multi-platinum selling albums during his 45 yrs playing experience.


