## Cold War[edit]

In July 1947 the regiment was reactivated at <u>Fort Dix</u>.<sup>[62]</sup> In 1957, the regiment was reorganized into the <u>Combat Arms Regimental System</u>.<sup>[62][b]</sup> In 1957, the regiment's 2d Battalion was relieved from the 9th Infantry Division, returning to assignment with the 4th Infantry Division.<sup>[64]</sup> Also 1957, the regiment's 3d Battalion was inactivated and relieved from the 9th Infantry Division, and two years later allotted to the <u>United States Army Reserves</u>' <u>81st Infantry Division</u>.<sup>[8]</sup>

In 1961, the regiment's 2nd Battle Group (the redesignated 2d Battalion) was deployed to Germany. Stationed in Berlin, the regiment remained there for a year;<sup>[65]</sup> the following year the regiment's 2d Battalion was inactivated at Fort Lewis, and the 3d Battalion was inactivated at Atlanta.<sup>[8][64]</sup> In July 1963, the 1st Battalion was reactivated as a part of the <u>171st Infantry Brigade</u>.<sup>[66]</sup> In 1966, at <u>Fort</u> <u>Riley</u>, both the 2d and 3d Battalions were reactivated, with the 3d Battalion being reassigned to 9th Infantry Division.<sup>[8][64]</sup>
