NO GOSSIP POLICY



- You must understand and acknowledge what is and isn't considered gossip. A casual or unconstrained conversation or reports about other people, typically involving details that are not confirmed as being true. Gossip however is not raising issues where serious acts of abuse or bullying may be involved. We at NEBULA Wrestling believe in creating an environment that is safe to voice issues without the fear of being antagonised or treated unfairly due to raising awareness to such issues.
- With the above in mind, you should not create or indulge in gossip that we at NEBULA Wrestling feel is unhealthy in creating a safe and drama-free environment for all who attend our performance centre.
- Policies around gossip should be followed by wrestlers, trainees, those attending the performance centre and all members of staff alike.
- Acts of gossip should be reported to the head trainer or head of safeguarding.
