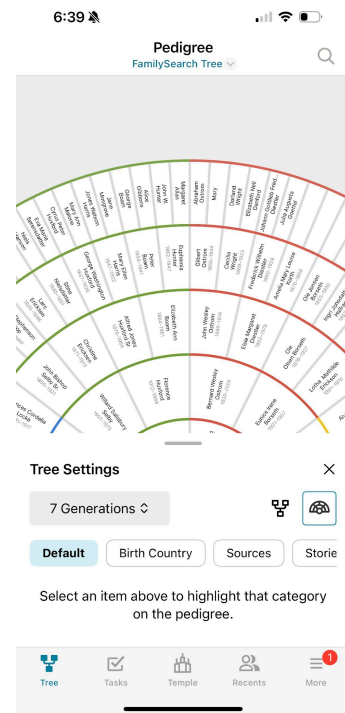

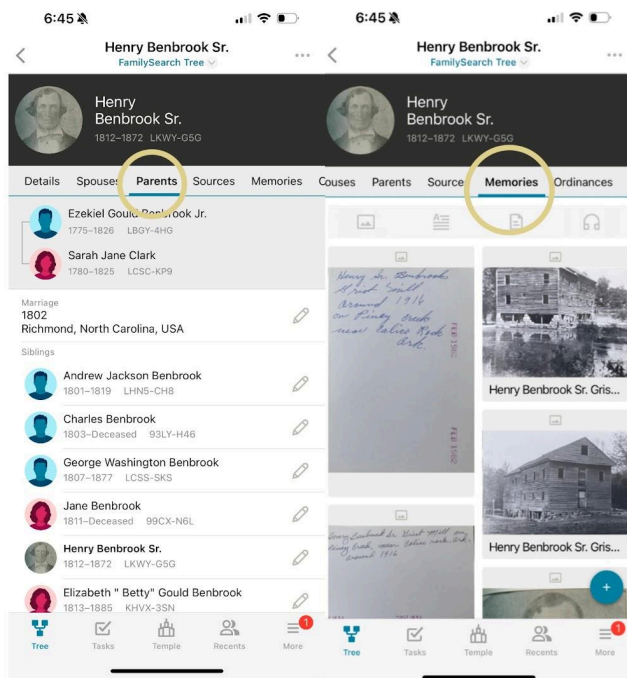
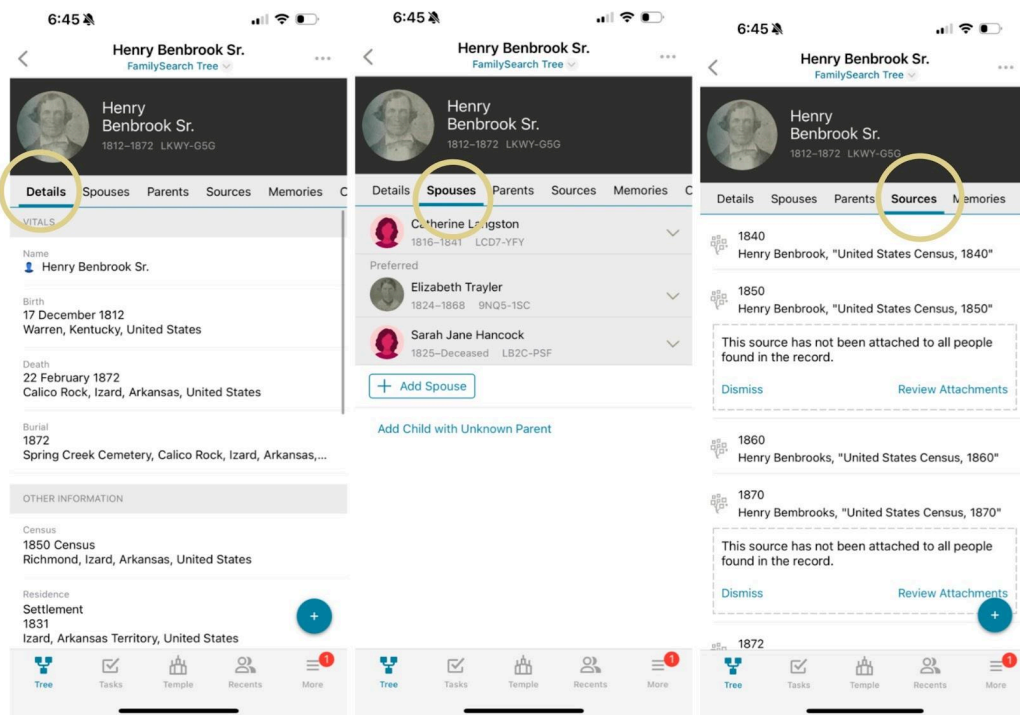

Tasks

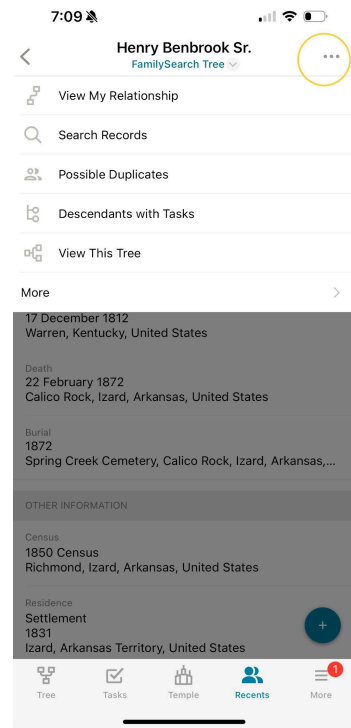
Hints for records of people in your family. FamilySearch notifying you they found different records that could possibly be your family member.
