You should bring to the class a pencil, scrap paper, and your enthusiasm to work with a partner to discover answers to accomplish your mission within FamilySearch.



Char Mitts will be contacting you ahead of time to find out what is your experience level with FamilySearch. She will be placing you in two person teams as you work through this class. Upon entering the class you will be given a sealed mission envelope. After the mission introduction your team will open the envelope and the hunt will begin.

Some of the areas of FamilySearch you might be using but are not limited to:

- Learn about your person on their Person's page
  - About, Details, Sources & Timeline tabs
- Clues you can discover using Memories
- Searching for additional records
- Finding duplicates

When you have completed the mission email Char Mitts an image of your detective note of how you solved the mystery. Char will send the answers to the mystery and additional details of Charles Lawrence Wheeler's disappearance. You will also receive a certificate that you have completed the mission. Will you be able to solve it before the class is over?
