

Wyoming and District Soccer Club Weather Policy

To protect the well-being of all participants, officials, and spectators, the following guidelines and principles shall be used in cases where the weather or field conditions should result in a delay, rescheduled, or canceled game.

Temperature and Humidity:

Temperature will be determined by the Weather network.

Under 32°C: Games proceed as normal.

32°C - 38°C: Frequent breaks for water and rest will be implemented.

38°C and over: Games will be canceled.

Announcement of Cancellations:

Decision on cancellations due to temperature or humidity will be announced:

By 5:30 PM on the day of the game.

Air Quality:

Air quality decisions will be based on advice from the Weather Network website.

Lightning and Thunder:

Games will be canceled if lightning or thunder is heard or seen:

30 minutes before the scheduled start time.

If it occurs during the game.

Field Conditions:

Two executive members will inspect the fields before games to assess standing water and agree on next steps.

Game Progression:

Prior to Game Start:

Games will start as scheduled, and weather will be monitored.

Standing water, puddles, or extreme weather conditions will result in game cancellation.

Heavy rain will result in a 15-minute delay. If rain persists, games will be canceled. It is at your discretion whether or not to attend a game if it has been deemed playable by officials.

During the Game:

Standing water, very slippery conditions, or extreme weather will result in game stoppage. Lightning, thunder, or threatening weather will result in game stoppage. Heavy rain during the game will prompt a 15-minute delay. If rain persists, games will be canceled.

Games Stopped Due to Weather:

Communication of canceled games will be via facebook page and/or email. It is the responsibility of parents/coaches to check emails. No rescheduling will be made for missed games.
