Skills Assessment

The below is a nice summary of the various skill levels for tournaments in WNY. This was put together by one of the tournament hosts in Buffalo that we utilize as well.

It is VERY important that people be able to self-assess their skill level to ensure all tournaments are SAFE and FUN for everyone.

Not sure? Ask the people you regularly play with! Ask your hosts. Remember, it's not about ego! We just want everyone to have the best experience possible.

DESCRIPTION:

B League:

Low Rec - No background or formal volleyball training, there for fun, 6 v 6 is played wherever you are standing on the court.

High Rec - Little to no background or formal volleyball training. Competitive, goal is to win. 6v6 is played wherever you are standing on the court

A League:

Low Int - Some background or formal volleyball training, high school level possible. 6v6 is basic and played with setter in front middle (3 spot) and setting responsibility may change based on who stands in 3 spot.

High Int - More background or formal volleyball training, some college level experience possible, may see topspin jump serving. 6v6 is positional and specialized. Basic 5-1 rotation is used. Players use designated positions and play competitively.

<u>Power</u> - High levels of background and formal training, high level collegiate competition. Advanced skill sets and plays.

**One area the CCVC is hoping to add to our repertoire is skills training and coaching! Keep an eye out for that!
