Sunday is a "Get to Know You" pickleball event. Players will be paired up with a partner and opponents. Teams will all start play at the same time at the blow of a whistle. Play will continue for 7-10 minutes and another whistle will sound. The team that is ahead will move up to the next court and split (change partners) with the team that is there. If there is a tie, "rock, paper, scissor" will determine who moves. The whistle will sound for another 7-10 minutes of play. Play as many rounds as you like, or just come and enjoy the fun. We will provide paddles and balls or you can bring your own. This is a fun fast way to play the game and meet a whole bunch of people. Join us at the Community Center from **1:30 PM to 4:30 PM**.
