YOUR VERY OWN MAGIC REINDEER!

Congratulations on being selected to receive a Genuine North Cove Magic Reindeer! Your Reindeer will be made of either Copper Beech or River Birch (or both). Carefully cared for your reindeer should provide years of holiday entertainment and cheer for you and your family.

Magic Reindeer Parts List



In addition to these instructions, you should have been given each of the following parts (Figure 1).

You should have a Reindeer body, 4 reasonably same length legs, a neck, a head, and 2 antlers.

Assembly of your Magic Reindeer



All parts have been carefully selected and hand-fitted to your particular Reindeer, although very briefly so as not to overly influence your reindeer's ultimate unique personality tendencies and motivational drives.

First, insert 1 leg into each of the 4 predrilled leg joints on the reindeer body. When done correctly you should have 4 legs touching the ground and a reasonably straight reindeer back. Some Reindeers are walking, so yours may have only 3 legs touching the ground. See Figure 2

Next place the neck into your Reindeer's head, followed by experimenting with the best arrangement for the antlers as shown in Figure 3.



Finally, put a good head on your Reindeer's shoulders by attaching assembled head to reindeer body. Your Reindeer should look similar to Figure 4 on the left.

Depending on where you live and other unknown factors, your Reindeer may come partially assembled. If you receive a PARTIALLY ASSEMBLED Reindeer, those parts are most likely glued together for your reindeer's long-term health. If glued it is most likely the Reindeer body and 4 legs are one unit, and the head, neck and antlers are a second unit. Do not dissemble those parts unless you are a Reindeer Physician or butcher.



In all cases your Reindeer's head and neck are NOT glued. This is for 2 reasons. First, you can adjust where you reindeer is looking by turning the head (and neck), and second so that your Genuine Magic North Cove Reindeer can properly rest and recover during the off-season.

Figure 5 to the left shows your Magic Reindeer just prior to animation or during it's rest and recovery period.

Care & Nurturance of your Magic Reindeer - Early Development, Adolescence, Adulthood and Old Age

While assembled, your Magic Reindeer is active and alert to it's surroundings and will develop an attitude because of it. It is delivered with a temperament but it is up to you how it develops from there.

Selecting an appropriate name for your Reindeer is important and left up to you. Note that name selection is the single most important remaining determinant of your reindeer's attitude.

For example, if you name your Reindeer "Crusty" as we have one of ours, your Reindeer will both love you but will also periodically mock you. We have named one "Cenni", as in "Eccentric" which seems to fit in particularly nicely for our holiday times. Depending on name selection we have seen Reindeers develop into highly helpful, interested, curious, questioning, helpful, friendly, and well-adjusted beings. We have also seen mischievous pranksters, trouble-makers, and very difficult Reindeers. Some others have turned out to be caring and loving, a few even very amorous creatures.
