Introduction

Here are some scriptural truths that are revealed and supported to help our knowledge and understanding that God has truly shifted all of Satan's power. Awareness, acknowledgment and activation are keys to succeed. Deception and blindness are two key components Satan uses to steal, kill and destroy, so be informed!

Did God break all of Satan's power?

Interesting question. Let's breakdown some components:

1. By Jesus absorbing sin, which was an impenetrable barrier between God and humanity, God was reconciled to humanity. The impenetrable sin barrier is broken. Sin had broken humanities direct relationship to God and had shifted power to Satan in the garden when humanity was usurped by deceit.
2. Jesus discarded (fired) the clergy system for withholding the average person from kingdom entrance (Matt 23:13), because they aligned themselves with Satan (Matt 23:28 & John 8:44).
3. By maneuvering Satan to forfeit his annexation of humanity God really did terminate demonic ownership of humanity. Because of absorption of sin, the discarding of the legal system, the annexation forfeiture, humanity fundamentally was shifted back to a direct relationship with God, shifting and realigning power back to the people!

Technically all demonic can continue to tempt, afflict, disrupt, and darken society. The difference is that God delivered humanity from the sin-stained, legalistic system Satan controlled and empowered humanity to shift from victims to victors. Jesus delivered His own authority keys and backed them up with a brand new form of humanity that anyone can select, embrace, and abide in. God also backed saints up by personally indwelling, cohabiting with, everyone who selects Jesus. With a new life, a new spirit, a new family, empowered by God Himself it would be safe to say God shifted the power from evil to good.

When God assigned all power to Jesus He impacted Satan's power. By placing all demonic under Jesus' feet, these same demons are under saints feet too, because Christians were lifted to a superior position in Jesus. Because Satan is no longer superior over all humanity, his superior power is broken. Satan still has the power to deceive, tempt, afflict, etc. Christianity has a superior power to liquidate these. God is absolute and His absolute divine nature has significant benefits available to all who enter in.

Current Status

1. Satan is judged, condemned and his sentence is already passed upon him
2. Jesus witnessed Satan falling from heaven – Apparently it was a quick war
3. Now the ruler (evil genius) of this world was cast out (expelled = no power)
4. Light has come into the world and Jesus came to destroy the works of Satan
5. If we truly follow Jesus, we carry His light of life and have discretion to use it

Part 1: Satan - Evil

Is Satan autonomous or a created being under the subjection of another?

1 What is recorded about the creation of evil, Lucifer, Satan?

- *The One forming light and creating darkness, Causing well-being and **creating calamity**; I am the LORD who does all these. (Isaiah 45:7, NASB).*
- *I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, and **create evil**: I the LORD do all these things. (Isa 45:7, KJV).*
- *For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: **all things were created by him, and for him**: (Colossians 1:16, KJV).*
- *Again the word of the Lord came to me, saying, “Son of man, take up a dirge (funeral poem to be sung) for the king of Tyre and say to him, ‘Thus says the Lord God,*
 - *“**You had the full measure of perfection and the finishing touch [of completeness], Full of wisdom and perfect in beauty.***
 - *“**You were in Eden, the garden of God**; Every precious stone was your covering: The ruby, the topaz, and the diamond; The beryl, the onyx, and the jasper; The lapis lazuli, the turquoise, and the emerald; And the gold, the workmanship of your settings and your sockets, Was in you.*
 - *They were prepared **On the day that you were created.** “**You were the anointed cherub who covers and protects, And I placed you there. You were on the holy mountain of God; You walked in the midst of the stones of fire [sparkling jewels]. (Ezekiel 28:11-14 AMB)***

The Bible clearly records that all things are created by God, and that all things were created for God. What is recorded about the creation of Lucifer is that **he is a created being**, under the submission of God. Remember it is God who is in heaven controlling things and it is Satan and the demonic who were all expelled out of heaven. We see that Lucifer was created with a full measure of perfection, very anointed.

- It was God Who created light and darkness, peace and evil ((Isa 45:7, KJV)
- All things were created by God, and for God: (Colossians 1:16, KJV)
- Satan had the full measure of perfection and the finishing touch [of completeness]
- On the day that you were created. “You were the anointed cherub who covers and protects

2 Does scripture expose Satan as the one who embraced and disbursed evil to oppress humanity?

- *You were blameless in your ways from the day you were created, till **unrighteousness was found in you.** (Ezekiel 28:15 ESV)*
- *“You were blameless in your ways From the day you were created **Until unrighteousness and evil were found in you.** “Through the abundance of your commerce You were internally filled with lawlessness and violence, And you sinned; Therefore I have cast you out as a profane and unholy thing From the mountain of God. And I have destroyed you, O covering cherub, From the midst of the stones of fire. **“Your heart was proud and arrogant because of your beauty; You destroyed your wisdom for the sake of your splendor. I cast you to the ground; I lay you before kings, That they might look at you. (Ezekiel 28:15-17 AMB)***
- *Then Satan went out from the presence of the LORD, and **smote Job with sore boils from the sole of his foot to the crown of his head.** (Job 2:7, NASB).*

- *"And this woman, a daughter of Abraham as she is, **whom Satan has bound for eighteen long years**, should she not have been released from this bond (to bind tie, fasten) on the Sabbath day?" (Luke 13:16, NASB).*
- *and a woman there had been disabled by a spirit for eighteen years. She was hunched over and could not stand up straight. (Luke 13:11)*
- *"how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with great power; and He went around doing good and **healing all who were oppressed by the devil**, because God was with Him." (ACTS 10:38 AMP)*

There is significant validation in Acts 10:38 and in Luke that many that were being healed by Jesus were oppressed by Satan who was inflicting them with disease. This implies that Satan was the source of sickness, disease, and bondage. Now that we know the true source of sickness, disease, bondage, and oppression we are free to target them, bind them, and destroy their effects.

Regarding the question of "Satan as the one who embraced evil, disbursed it, oppressing humanity?" The answer is yes! Satan is credited with finding, establishing, demonstrating, and injecting sin, sickness, wickedness, and every form of evil into society, but didn't create evil. Unrighteousness was found in him, along with arrogance, lawlessness, profanity, and violence.

- unrighteousness was found in Satan. (Ezekiel 28:15 ESV)
- unrighteousness and evil were found in you
- you were internally filled with lawlessness and violence
- you sinned; Therefore I have cast you out as a profane and unholy thing - I cast you to the ground
- Your heart was proud and arrogant because of your beauty

3 Does the Bible identify Satan as the accuser, blinder, tempter and affliker?

- *The wicked accuse: the Godly defend. (Prov. 12:6 TLB)*
- *"The thief comes only to steal, and kill, and destroy; (John 10:10 A, NASB).*
- *"HE HAS BLINDED THEIR EYES, AND HE HARDENED THEIR HEART; LEST THEY SEE WITH THEIR EYES, AND PERCEIVE WITH THEIR HEART, AND BE CONVERTED, AND I HEAL THEM." (John 12:40, NASB).*
- *And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, in whose case **the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving**, that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God. (2 Corinthians 4:3,4, NASB).*
- *We know that we are of God, and **the whole world lies in the power of the evil one.** (1 John 5:19, NASB).*
- *And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, **Satan hath desired to have (sift) you**, that he may sift you as wheat: But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren. (Luke 22:31,32, KJV).*
- *Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, **the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.** (Revelation 2:10, KJV).*
- *"If the world hates you, you know that **it has hated Me before it hated you.** (John 15:18, NASB).*

[God has shifted all of Satan's power](#)

The Bible does identify Satan as the accuser, blinder, tempter and afflicter. We were told by Jesus and the Apostles of what the spiritual landscape is and that we need to be prepared and edified to resist what is coming to our lives. Jesus even reported to his disciples that they should expect to be hated, because the world hated Him. So if your life is in Him, you will probably get the same treatment. The world hated Him then, and it hasn't changed. Prov. 12:6 TLB reports that it is the wicked who accuse. Jesus clearly stated that Satan comes only to steal, and kill, and destroy, and that it is Satan that has blinded the eyes so people cannot see the truth and he hardened their heart so they cannot perceive the truth. Jesus went on to report to Peter that Satan wanted to sift him, which probably meant some form of oppression. Then when Jesus returned to Patmos reported to John that the devil was going to have some cast into prison, and be tried. We see that Satan is the accuser, blinder, tempter, and afflicter. To be for-warned is to be for-armed!

This not meant to paint a bleak picture, but to help each other with awareness and to prepare for what is up ahead.



Does God permit the demonic to continue doing evil on earth and if so, why?

Now the subject of God permitting the continuation of demonic evil on earth has many opinions. Since we know that we will die for lack of knowledge, let's take a few minutes and review what God Himself says about this. **Will the answer to this question place the responsibility upon us to realize what the truth is and then meditate on the Word to become edified, so we can know the the truth to overcome temptation and symptoms?** We already know Satan wants everyone deceived and to not know the truth, and we know that those results are bad. Here are some reasons and some verses that support the reasons. God does permit the demonic to continue doing evil on earth:

1 To maintain humility in our lives

- *And because of the surpassing greatness of the revelations, for this reason, **to keep me from exalting myself, there was given me a thorn in the flesh, a messenger of Satan to buffet me--to keep me from exalting myself!** (2 Cor 12:7, NASB). (Now remember when Paul resisted, the enemy did flee.)*

The Apostle Paul reported a thorn in his side, and that it was there to keep him from exalting himself, so it stands to reason it was a reminder to maintain humility in his life. Now remember when Paul resisted, the enemy did flee! So these “thorns” are never permanent, nor do they bring glory to God. Because all Christian's are direct recipients of Jesus' authority keys saints can use them to overcome the thorns in their lives.

2 To develop faith and righteousness in our lives

- ***Blessed is a man who perseveres under trial; for once he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life, which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.** (James 1:12, NASB).*
- ***that the proof of your faith, being more precious than gold which is perishable, even though tested by fire, may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ; (1 Peter 1:7, NASB).***
- ***Be of sober spirit, be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls about like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. But resist him, firm in your faith, knowing that the same experiences of suffering are being accomplished by your brethren who are in the world.** (1 Peter 5:8,9, NASB).*

Here is sufficient scriptural implications that saints are supposed to develop faith and righteousness:

1. Blessed is a man who **perseveres under trial;** (James 1:12, NASB).
2. that the proof of your faith, - tested by fire, (1 Peter 1:7, NASB).
3. **But resist him, firm in your faith,** knowing that the same experiences of suffering are being accomplished by your brethren who are in the world. (1 Peter 5:8,9, NASB).

We see here that Jesus' brother reports to the church an expectation to persevere under trial, which implicates believers are going to get trials. Also Peter discloses that the proof of our faith will be tested by fire, another implication for preparedness. Then Peter joins James in affirming that in resisting the enemy, firm in our faith (not weak in our faith), the enemy must flee. Since we are all going to have similar experiences, we should help each other become strong to better overcome. Trying to establish the roaring lion phrase as a basis for Satan having a powerful supremacy over saints is just not valid. I suspect that the roaring lion phrase is used to justify a

lack of faith, or low prayer results, or as an excuse for failure to recognize and learn of Jesus' keys, and failure to use them.

3 To bring about trials whereby we can be rewarded when we overcome

- *I am writing to you, fathers, because you know Him who has been from the beginning. I am writing to you, young men, because **you have overcome the evil one**. I have written to you, children, because you know the Father. (1 John 2:13, NASB).*
- *'He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. **To him who overcomes, I will grant to eat of the tree of life, which is in the Paradise of God.**' (Revelation 2:7, NASB).*
- *'He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. **He who overcomes shall not be hurt by the second death.**' (Revelation 2:11, NASB).*
- *'He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. **To him who overcomes, to him I will give some of the hidden manna, and I will give him a white stone, and a new name written on the stone which no one knows but he who receives it.**' (Revelation 2:17, NASB).*
- *'And he who overcomes, and he who keeps My deeds until the end, **TO HIM I WILL GIVE AUTHORITY OVER THE NATIONS;** (Revelation 2:26, NASB).*
- *'**He who overcomes shall thus be clothed in white garments; and I will not erase his name from the book of life, and I will confess his name before My Father, and before His angels.** (Revelation 3:5, NASB).*
- *'**He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will not go out from it anymore; and I will write upon him the name of My God, and the name of the city of My God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God, and My new name.** (Rev 3:12).*
- *'**He who overcomes, I will grant to him to sit down with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.** (Revelation 3:21, NASB).*

Has anyone ever heard it reported that saints can be rewarded when they overcome trials? For God to allow the continuation of evil and its effects, one of the reasons is so we can be rewarded when we overcome. I was surprised to see this, so I am listing the examples to support this. These should supply sufficient evidence to impact anyone interested in this level of truth.

1. A clear implication acknowledging overcoming: you have overcome the evil one. (1 John 2:13).
2. Jesus reports: To him who overcomes, I will grant to eat of the tree of life, (Revelation 2:7, NASB).
3. Jesus reports: He who overcomes shall not be hurt by the second death.' (Revelation 2:11, NASB).
4. Jesus reports: To him who overcomes, I will give some of the hidden manna (Revelation 2:17)
5. Jesus reports: he who overcomes, and he who keeps My deeds until the end, TO HIM I WILL GIVE AUTHORITY OVER THE NATIONS; (Revelation 2:26).
6. Jesus reports: He who overcomes shall thus be clothed in white garments; and I will not erase his name from the book of life (Revelation 3:5, NASB).
7. Jesus reports: He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, (Rev 3:12).
8. Jesus reports: He who overcomes, I will grant to him to sit down with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne. (Revelation 3:21).

4 To teach us how to take authority and demonstrate the gospel

- *only in order that the generations of the sons of Israel might be taught war, those who had not experienced it formerly. (Judges 3:2, NASB).*
- *as it is written, "A FATHER OF MANY NATIONS HAVE I MADE YOU") in the sight of Him whom he believed, even God, who gives life to the dead and calls into being that which does not exist. (Rom 4:17).*

Other reasons for God to allow the continuation of evil and its effects are to teach saints how to take authority and demonstrate the gospel. Distributing the gospel is very well accomplished on earth. The church has “papered” mankind over and over, and that in itself is positive and somewhat effective. The testimonies are fabulous. But there is a difference between the distribution and the demonstration of the gospel. Jesus gave us many implications and the apostles have instructed us to replicate the natural and supernatural works of Jesus. These are done by demonstrating, not distributing. If the sons of Israel were expected to experience war in the old testament, what does that implicate for the Saints of God? It is God who calls things into being that didn't exist and has handed us saints the keys to do the same. The sons of God can bind affliction and call things into being through creative miracles too.

5 To allow affliction in order that we may repent

- *It is actually reported that there is immorality among you, and immorality of such a kind as does not exist even among the Gentiles, that someone has his father's wife. And you have become arrogant, and **have not mourned instead, in order that the one who had done this deed might be removed from your midst.** For I, on my part, though absent in body but present in spirit, have already judged him who has so committed this, as though I were present. In the name of our Lord Jesus, when you are assembled, and I with you in spirit, with the power of our Lord Jesus, I have decided to deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of his flesh, that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus. (1 Corinthians 5:1-5, NASB).*
- *"And his lord, moved with anger, handed him over to the torturers until he should repay all that was owed him. "So shall My heavenly Father also do to you, **if each of you does not forgive his brother from your heart.**" (Matthew 18:34,35, NASB).*

Another big reason for God to allow the continuation of evil and its effects might be so people can repent. Arrogance is a blockage to blessing and God has seen fit to allow for things to motivate repentance. The willful practices of sin, error, and immorality were addressed by Paul to be arrogant, and such behavior needs to be removed from every believing body of believers. Now let's review **Jesus' seldom-quoted verse** about un-forgiveness and un-repentance in which He states God will hand over the perpetrators to the torturers for not forgiving (and probably not repenting either).

6 To demonstrate the power of God over Satanic power

- *And just then there was in their synagogue a man with an unclean spirit; and he cried out, saying, "What do we have to do with You, Jesus of Nazareth? Have You come to destroy us? I know who You are--the Holy One of God!" And Jesus rebuked him, saying, "**Be quiet, and come out of him!**" (Mark 1:23-25, NASB).*

- *"And these signs will accompany those who have believed: in My name they will **cast out demons**, they will speak with new tongues; they will pick up serpents, and if they drink any deadly poison, it shall not hurt them; **they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.**" (Mark 16:17,18, NASB).*
- *And when they had gone through the whole island as far as Paphos, they found a certain magician, a Jewish false prophet whose name was Bar-Jesus, who was with the proconsul, Sergius Paulus, a man of intelligence. This man summoned Barnabas and Saul and sought to hear the word of God. But Elymas the magician (for thus his name is translated) was opposing them, seeking to turn the proconsul away from the faith. But Saul, who was also known as Paul, filled with the Holy Spirit, fixed his gaze upon him, and said, "You who are full of all deceit and fraud, you son of the devil, you enemy of all righteousness, will you not cease to make crooked the straight ways of the Lord?" And now, behold, the hand of the Lord is upon you, and **you will be blind and not see the sun for a time.**" And immediately a mist and a darkness fell upon him, and he went about seeking those who would lead him by the hand. **Then the proconsul believed when he saw what had happened**, being amazed at the teaching of the Lord. (Acts 13:6-12, NASB).*

Demonstrating the power of God over the power of the enemy is relief for those oppressed with sickness, diseases, and darkness (continually block from enlightenment, truth, and power). Healing the sick, raising the dead, casting out the demonic is not recognized as normal in many church cultures, therefore it has been expedient to just offer a verbal prayer for God's will by applying a sincere prayer. This level of faith is not in alignment with what Jesus did, nor with His expectations. Since Jesus supplied the saints with the keys to bind and loose, we should become aware, acknowledge and activate these keys as well. Jesus made it clear He came to destroy the works of the enemy, and He expects His followers to do the same. We see in these verses that Jesus demanded the spirits to be quiet and come out of people. This set an example for His followers to do the same. It is interesting to note that the Apostle Paul even made someone blind temporarily, as a measure of authority, to exert a "cease and desist order" upon them to stop their activities. So it could be concluded that God does permit the demonic to continue doing evil on earth and these reasons do offer some verification to be aware of them, and to activate your faith in resistance.

Part 2 Jesus Christ – Absolute - King of Kings

Did Jesus destroy Satan's works and disarm demonic powers and authorities?

Did God expel Satan and the demons from heaven? Is Satan subject to Jesus Christ?

1 Christ predicted triumph over Satan

- *And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel. (Genesis 3:15, KJV).*
- *And He said to them, "I was watching Satan fall from heaven like lightning. (Luke 10:18, NASB).*
- *And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name. And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. (Luke 10:17,18, KJV).*
- *Now is the time for judgment on this world; now the prince of this world will be driven out. (John 12:31)*

Here are three separate verifications that Satan was evicted from Heaven. Jesus did announce judgement and Jesus did end Satan's reign (John 12:31).

2 The purpose Jesus came to earth was to bind the enemy

- *For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil. (1 John 3:8b, KJV).*
- *I came that they might have life, and might have it abundantly. (John 10:10b).*

Clearly Jesus gave specific notice that He was coming to destroy the work of Satan and to deliver abundant life to all humanity (whoever would accept it).

3 Did Jesus enter the house and bind the enemy? Did He give us keys to do the same?

- *"But no one can enter the strong man's house and plunder his property unless he first binds the strong man, and then he will plunder his house. "Truly I say to you, all sins shall be forgiven the sons of men, and whatever blasphemies they utter; (Mark 3:27,28, NASB).*
- *"I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; and whatever you shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." (Matthew 16:19, NASB).*
- *"When a strong man, fully armed, guards his own house, his possessions are undisturbed. "But when someone stronger than he attacks him and overpowers him, he takes away from him all his armor on which he had relied and distributes his plunder. (Luke 11:21-22 NASB)*
- *But if I cast out demons by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you. "Or how can anyone enter the strong man's house and carry off his property, unless he first binds the strong man? And then he will plunder his house. (Matt 12:28-29 NASB)*

Jesus did invade the strong mans house and conquered all demonic beings (Luke 11:21-22) then He drove out demons by Holy Spirit, validating Gods kingdom had come (Matt 12:28). and empower saints to do the same (Matthew 16:19)), shifting power from evil to good.

4 Satan has been cast out, judged, condemned, and sentenced

- *Now the judgment (crisis) of this world is coming on [sentence is now being passed on this world]. Now the ruler (evil genius, prince) of this world shall be cast out (expelled). (John 12:31,32, AMB).*

- *About judgment, because the ruler (evil genius, prince) of this world **[Satan] is judged and condemned and sentence already is passed upon him** (John 16:11, AMB).*
- *"Then He will also say to those on His left, 'Depart from Me, accursed ones, into the eternal fire which has been prepared for the devil and his angels; (Matthew 25:41, NASB).*

The fact that Jesus did evicted Satan from heaven should confirm Jesus is superior. Because saints are grafted into Jesus and are at one with God through Jesus, this implies that Christians are superior to Satan and all demonic influence and activities as well. This truth needs to be exposed, embraced, developed, and activated.

5 Jesus rendered the devil powerless and nailed the law and its decrees to the cross

- *Since then the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death **He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil;** (Hebrews 2:14, NASB).*
- *And you who were dead in trespasses and in the uncircumcision of your flesh (your sensuality, your sinful carnal nature), [God] brought to life together with [Christ], having [freely] forgiven us all our transgressions, **Having cancelled and blotted out and wiped away the handwriting of the note (bond) with its legal decrees and demands which was in force and stood against us (hostile to us). This [note with its regulations, decrees, and demands] He set aside and cleared completely out of our way by nailing it to [His] cross. [God] disarmed the principalities and powers that were ranged against us and made a bold display and public example of them, in triumphing over them in Him and in it [the cross].** (Col 2:13-15, AMP).*
- *"For **God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin**. People are made right with God **when they believe that Jesus sacrificed his life**, shedding his blood. This sacrifice shows that God was being fair when he held back and did not punish those who sinned in times past, Yet God, in his grace, freely makes us right in his sight. He did this through Christ Jesus when he freed us from the penalty for our sins. For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. **We are made right with God by placing our faith in Jesus Christ**. And this is true for everyone who believes, no matter who we are. But now God has shown us a way to be made right with him without keeping the requirements of the law, as was promised in the writings of Moses and the prophets long ago." (Romans 3:21-25 NLT)*

All humanity was dead in their sin until Christ absorbed both that sin and death, and then His resurrection life generated a brand new life for us. The law was enslavement to the Jews and a "categoric repressive barrier wall" keeping Gentiles from God. See how Jesus abolished the Jewish legalistic enslavement of the law by discarding the entire clergy system and the wall that was blocking Gentiles from God. Jesus broke Satan's power by cancelling out the regulations, decrees, and demands, changing the system from law to grace. By nailing these to the cross He disarmed all the power of sin that were against all humanity. Romans 3:21-25 explains it another way, how God sent Jesus to absorb the sin so He could just change the system.

6 How much power was given to Jesus and was anything placed under his feet?

- *And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, **All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth**. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: (Matthew 28:18,19, KJV).*
- *And **what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe**, according to the working of his mighty power, Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at*

*his own right hand in the heavenly places, Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: And **hath put all things under his feet.** and gave him to be the head over all things to the church, Which is his body, the **fulness of him that filleth all in all.** (Ephesians 1:19-23, KJV).*

God is absolute and He has given Jesus all power both in heaven and earth. Since Jesus has 100% of that power, how much is left for the demonic? Answer: zero. Since deception is still in play for the enemy the saints are tasked with enlightenment to overcome lies, false teaching, temptations and symptoms. Saints are at one with Jesus, therefore do carry the potential to use Jesus' power to oppose evil.

Exerting Enforcement #1

**"I assure you and most solemnly say to you,
whoever says to this mountain,
'Be lifted up and thrown into the sea!'
and does not doubt in his heart [in God's unlimited power],
but believes that what he says is going to take place,
it will be done for him [in accordance with God's will].
For this reason I am telling you, whatever things you ask for
in prayer [in accordance with God's will],
believe [with confident trust] that you have received them,
and they will be given to you."**

MARK 11:23-24 AMP

By Christ's death do Saints receive deliverance from Satan's bondage?

1 Apparently the enemy represented absolutely no threat to Jesus.

- *And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking unto me, and saying in the Hebrew tongue, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks. And I said, **Who art thou, Lord? And he said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest. But rise. and stand upon thy feet: for I have appeared unto thee for this purpose. to make thee a minister and a witness both of these things which thou hast seen, and of those things in the which I will appear unto thee; Delivering thee from the people, and from the Gentiles, unto whom now I send thee, To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.** (Acts 26:14-18, KJV).*

Christ has so much authority that even as Saul was in the act of prosecuting Jesus' church He just recruited Saul into Kingdom Service. He never paid attention to the enemy's authority on Saul. There was no kickback or retaliation.

2 Did Jesus destroy the devil and His power of death at the crucifix?

- *For as much then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; **that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.** (Hebrews 2:14,15, KJV).*

This subject is covered in good detail in "Finished". There many components to the finished work of Jesus and I recommend you review that report whenever you can. Suffice it to say that Satan's power was shifted by God, but Satan can still deceive, accuse, tempt, and afflict. Jesus delivered to humanity His own keys to follow His examples.

3 Did Jesus set free Christians from law and death?

- *For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus **has set you free from the law of sin and of death.** (Romans 8:2, NASB).*
- *It was for freedom that Christ set us free; therefore keep standing firm and **do not be subject again to a yoke of slavery.** (Galatians 5:1, NASB).*

Jesus delivered to humanity His own sanctuary to enter into directly. He discarded the Sanhedrin clergy system and made it obsolete. As humanity embraces and acknowledges Jesus gospel offer of salvation we enter into eternal life that is housed and supplied by Jesus. Jesus, within Himself, has created a new form of humanity. It's called Christianity!

Entering into Jesus' original Christianity creates in us a new life, eternal (beginning now and forever), an abundant life (indwelled by Holy Spirit), and begins physical, emotional and intellectual regeneration (overriding all oppression), along with a new spiritual family adoption process. As we wait on Holy Spirit, and embrace His manifest presence, we can begin to experience His indwelling with tongues of fire, just like God originally designed!

Part 3 - Christian Saints

Do Saints have access to empowerment?

1 How does humanity access Jesus' empowerment?

Access to empowerment comes to saints solely from salvations new birth, a constant reliance on being in Christ, and an obedience to the Word and Holy Spirit.

- *Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, **Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.** (John 3:3, KJV).*
- *I am the vine, ye are the branches: **He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit:** for without me ye can do nothing. (John 15:5, KJV).*
- ***Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.** (1 John 4:4, KJV).*
- ***The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul:** the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes. The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether. More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold: sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. Moreover by them is thy servant warned: and in keeping of them there is great reward. (Psalms 19:7-11, KJV).*
- *All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: **That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.** (2 Timothy 3:16,17, KJV).*
- *Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord, According as **his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness,** through the knowledge (experience) of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might **be partakers of the divine nature,** having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. (2 Peter 1:2-4, KJV).*
- *For the report of your obedience has reached to all; therefore I am rejoicing over you, but I want you to be wise in what is good, and innocent in what is evil. And the **God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet.** The grace of our Lord Jesus be with you. (Romans 16:19,20, NASB).*

Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. If he can't see it he can't experience it. So selecting salvation is the first step toward empowerment. **Note: any human being (sinner) can use Jesus' name to effect an oppressive spirit (once, in a pinch).** The empowerment is in the name of Jesus, not the person using it. Once saved, that person can have the anointing from Holy Spirit, can mortify their carnal nature and can edify their divine nature. The reason the sinner doesn't have the anointing is that they never selected salvation, so the likelihood of empowerment is remote, or nil. If you reject God, His Son Jesus, and Holy Spirit you also nullified your ability for their manifest presence, until you change.

How can believers be aware of demonic schemes and stand against them?

1 Ignorance, apathy and deceit are weapons of Satan

- *Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for **we are not ignorant of his devices.** (2 Cor 2:11, KJV)*
- *And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, in whose case the **god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving**, that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God. (2 Corinthians 4:3,4, NASB).*

Satan can take an advantage over saints from their ignorance of his strategies. As the god of this world his objective is to blind people from seeing the truth and keep their minds confused with unbelief, fear, and carnal distracting temptations.

2 Must the devil flee?

- *Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil. and he will flee from you. (James 4:7, KJV).*

Whenever a saint rebukes a temptation or a symptom, it must flee. As we submit to God, and actively resist the devil the benefit of the Absolute Effect ensues and they will flee. Adding the activity of praying in tongues amplifies the manifestation of the anointing and expels demonic influences.

3 How do we avoid the adversary?

- ***Be of sober spirit. be on the alert.** Your adversary, the devil, prowls about like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. **But resist him. firm in your faith.** knowing that the same experiences of suffering are being accomplished by your brethren who are in the world. And after you have suffered for a little while, the God of all grace, who called you to His eternal glory in Christ, will **Himself perfect, confirm, strengthen and establish you.** (1 Peter 5:8-10, NASB).*

We avoid the adversary by becoming acquainted with temptation, right and wrong, evil and good, and also to build ourselves up in our faith to overcome and override all demonic influences. The demonic can prowl around all they want, but after being beaten up, expelled, and vaporized they look for dumber prey. Our best resistance tools are getting the knowledge of truth, knowing who we are in Christ, and knowing how to handle verbiage, like Jesus did. Avoidance is best, but when confronted be ready to defend and defeat. It takes a while but you will see how God has an Absolute Effect, and the fact that our life is at one with God, the demonic must bend a knee to us, like they did to Jesus.

4 How do believers fight the enemy?

By knowing schemes, resisting and rebuking

- *Finally, be **strong in the Lord**, and in the strength of His might. Put on the full armor of God, that you may be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places.*
 - *Therefore, **take up the full armor of God**, that you may be able to resist in the evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm.*

- **Stand firm therefore, HAVING GIRDED YOUR LOINS WITH TRUTH** (*know truth*)
- **HAVING PUT ON THE BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS, and**
- **Having shod YOUR FEET WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE;**
- **In addition to all, taking up the *shield of faith* with which you will be able to extinguish all the flaming missiles of the evil one.**
- **And take THE HELMET OF SALVATION, and**
- **The *sword of the Spirit*, which is the word of God. With all prayer and petition pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be on the alert with all perseverance and petition for all the saints, (Ephesians 6:10-18, NASB).**
- *We are human, but we don't wage war as humans do. We use God's mighty weapons, not worldly weapons, to knock down the strongholds of human reasoning and to destroy false arguments. We destroy every proud obstacle that keeps people from knowing God. We capture their rebellious thoughts and teach them to obey Christ (2 Corinthians 10:3-5, NLB).*

Just say no is the beginning of defending yourself. Avoidance of temptations is smart and goes so far. I think that sincerely wanting more of God is a big deal, and most of us don't really want that. I didn't, but then I repented and told Holy Spirit I NEEDED more of Him. He helped me. Effectiveness comes from two factors. First is that we learn to feed the root, not the fruit. Second is we will reap what we sow. If we'd continually starve our infilling practices, then a weak spirit is what we'll become. Recognize that Jesus came to destroy evil works and has given saints His keys to replicate this, so be encouraged to learn about them, try to use the them, and persevere.

Satan can tempt any believer but every believer can defeat Satan

1 Does God make a way for escape from temptation?

- *No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation **will provide the way of escape also**, that you may be able to endure it. (1 Corinthians 10:13, NASB).*

2 Does Holy Spirit deliver believers from the power of the flesh and give sonship?

- *However, **you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit**, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him. And if Christ is in you, though the body is dead because of sin, yet the spirit is alive because of righteousness. But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, **He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who indwells you**. So then, brethren, we are under obligation, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh-- for if you are living according to the flesh, you must die; but if by the Spirit you are putting to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!" **The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ**, if indeed we suffer with Him in order that we may also be glorified with Him. For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory that is to be revealed to us. (Romans 8:9-18, NASB).*

3 Does heartfelt obedience deliver freedom?

- *But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but **ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you**. Being then **made free from sin**. ye became the servants of righteousness. (Romans 6:17,18, KJV)*

- *"And the one on whom seed was sown on the good soil, **this is the man who hears the word and understands it**; who indeed bears fruit, and brings forth, some a hundredfold, some sixty, and some thirty." (Matthew 13:23, NASB).*

4 Was the sin of our old man dealt with at the cross by Jesus?

- *Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the **body of sin might be destroyed**. that henceforth **we should not serve sin**. **For he that is dead is freed from sin**. Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him: Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; **death hath no more dominion over him**. For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God. Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin. but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body**, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof. Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God. **For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.** (Romans 6:6-14, KJV).*
- *Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, **should live unto righteousness**: by whose stripes ye were healed. For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls. (1 Peter 2:24 KJV)*

Interesting Observations Here:

1. Saints old carnal nature was crucified with Christ, so that our body of sin might be destroyed (*leaving Christ's purity for saints to reside in*).
2. Technically saints are dead to sin so they're freed from sin. Reckon yourselves dead to sin, and enjoy the freedom to live the new abundant life in Christ.
3. Death or sin doesn't have dominion over saints. If death doesn't then neither does temptations or symptoms.

These are major power shifts God accomplished to influence His creation through Christianity.

Is Satan subject to Saints, and have Saints been given authority over demons?

What is it that Saints are complete in?

- *For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. And **we are complete in him**. which is the head of all principality and power: (Col 2:9,10, KJV).*

Saints have been completed in God, and there are benefits for those who know.

Where are Christians from and are they greater than Satan?

- *Little children, **you are of God [you belong to Him]** and have [already] defeated and overcome them [the agents of the antichrist], because **He Who lives in you is greater (mightier) than he who is in the world.** (1 John 4:4, AMP).*

Saints are from God so technically we've already defeated and overcome all evil and demonic because Holy Spirit Who indwells us is greater than all the enemy spirits who are in the world.

Did Jesus give his followers power over sickness and disease?

- *And when he had called unto him his twelve disciples, **he gave them power against unclean spirits**, to cast them out, and to **heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.** (Matthew 10:1, KJV).*

God has shifted all of Satan's power

- *"And as you go, preach, saying, 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand.' **Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse the lepers, cast out demons; freely you received, freely give.** (Matthew 10:7,8, NASB).*
- *And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that believe; **In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.** (Mark 16:15-18, KJV).*
- *And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, **even the devils are subject unto us through thy name.** And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. Behold, I give unto you power **to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy:** and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven. (Luke 10:17-20, (KJV).*
- *Behold! **I have given you authority and power to trample upon serpents and scorpions, and [physical and mental strength and ability] over all the power that the enemy [possesses]; and nothing shall in any way harm you.** (Lk 10:19 AMP)*
- *And **by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the people;** (and they were all with one accord in Solomon's porch. And of the rest durst no man join himself to them: but the people magnified them. And believers were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.) Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them. There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed everyone. (Acts 5:12-16, KJV).*
- *Therefore they that were scattered abroad went every where preaching the word. Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria, and preached Christ unto them. And the people with one accord gave heed unto those things which Philip spake, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did. For **unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed with them:** and many taken with palsies, and that were lame. were healed. And there was great joy in that city. (Acts 8:48, KJV). Taking Authority*
- *And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying: The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation. And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, **I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her.** And he came out the same hour. (Acts 16:16-18).*
- *To me, the very least of all saints, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the unfathomable riches of Christ, and to bring to light what is the administration of the mystery which for ages has been hidden in God, who created all things; in order that the **manifold wisdom of God might now be made known through the church to the rulers and the authorities in the heavenly places.** (Ephesians 3:8-10, NASB).*
- *The signs of a true apostle were performed among you with all perseverance, **by signs and wonders and miracles.** (2 Corinthians 12:12, NASB).*
- *And my message and my preaching were not in persuasive words of wisdom, but in **demonstration of the Spirit and of power,** that your faith should not rest on the wisdom of men, but on the power of God. (1 Cor. 2:4,5).*
- *For **the kingdom of God does not consist in words, but in power.** (1 Corinthians 4:20, NASB).*

Jesus gives saints authority and power to trample upon serpents and scorpions, and over all the power that the enemy. He gave them power against unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness. In Jesus name saints can cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; they shall lay hands on the sick, and **the sick shall recover**, and even the devils are subject unto any Saint through Jesus' name.

Part 4 Conclusion - CHOICES

Everybody must make their own choice...

- *Do you not know that when you present yourselves to someone as slaves for obedience, **you are slaves of the one whom you obey**, either of sin resulting in death, or of obedience resulting in righteousness? But thanks be to God that though you were slaves of sin, you became obedient from the heart to that form of teaching to which you were committed, and **having been freed from sin, you became slaves of righteousness**. I am speaking in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh. For just as you presented your members as slaves to impurity and to lawlessness, resulting in further lawlessness, so now present your members as slaves to righteousness, resulting in sanctification. (Romans 6:16-19, NASB).*

The Apostle Paul breaks down the simplicity of this cause and effect truth. Whoever you obey or participate with, you become a slave to. We need to be aware of the effect from our relationships.

Choosing to become aware can expose the truth about deceitful teachings. I've witnessed some very distorted 'half truths' about the power of Satan. These were taken from scripture, **out of context**, and applied to manipulate people in fear, by very deceitful teachers. Peter was addressing the elders (warning them) in this 'featured' remark and warning them to remain humble. This did not establish a Satanic supremacy standard to reign in the church, as some would have you believe.

- ***"Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour. Stand firm against him, and be strong in your faith. Remember that your family of believers all over the world is going through the same kind of suffering you are."** (1 Peter 5:8-9 NLT)*
- *And the devil said to Him, **"I will give You all this domain and its glory; for it has been handed over to me, and I give it to whomever I wish.** (Luke 4:6, NASB).*

1 Peter 5:9 instructs saints to resist him, and James 4:7 informs saints that when we do resist he MUST flee. Peter is acknowledging that Christians do come under attack, and Peter has identified the oppressing source as Satan. However, because we're in Jesus, we can overcome and defeat any attacks.

Satan tries to bribe Jesus after His baptism in Luke 4:6. Satan knows that if we agree with him that those are grounds for separation from God. Jesus rejected his offer, of course. If Satan was willing to bribe Jesus with all, EVERYTHING HE HAD, that would be an indication of how desperate he was then.

Jesus informed saints that whatever He went through, the devil will try on us as well. We know that demonic evil oppression, in the form of temptations, will try to entice everyone, then the demons try to impound the victims before they devour them. So just say no!

Final thought

Knowing that God has shifted all of Satan's power and placed him and all the demonic under Jesus feet, and knowing that because saints are at one with Jesus all demonic are subject to us as well, is a very important truth to learn and never forget. This ***one truth shifts the leverage of power*** from people being victims to knowledgeable saints becoming victors. I sincerely hope this report has helped anyone who has taken the time to review it.

One More Thing
