

- 1. Jesus reconciled **God to mankind** by breaking the power of sin which had separated them
- 2. Jesus reconciled mankind to God:
 - a) by discarding the system of law (Sanhedrin, clergy-laity mediated system)
 - b) by breaking the power of Satan's annexation of mankind
- 3. Jesus reconciled **all mankind to each other** (man to man unity), by breaking the power of enmity (polarity), between all humans and evoking new standards
- 4. Jesus reconciled mankind by **reestablishing mankind to the original physical oversight** position over all the earth, lost from the fall.

INTRODUCTION

DId Humanity Benefit From Jesus?

The point that humanity has benefited from Jesus finished work on the cross is evident to those who know the facts, can understand the depth of the truth, and can utilize it to mature in this new life called Christianity. Jesus really was sent by God to reconcile all of humanity to God, and the other four variations of reconciliation demonstrated in this report.

Bestowing These Benefits

Becoming "born again" and "regenerated" has been widely promoted by churches and it may seem a little diluted, especially without the deeper fundamental meaning of the reasons of reconciliation to help really change the person from the inside. Although there is some merit in these terms, if we take the time to research, we will find that the new humanity Jesus produced in the One-New-Man Model is a **Brand New Person**, not a regenerated one. Those of us who know this are tasked with reaching out to extend the information and bestow all benefits forward.

God Bestowed Love

Just remember that it was God Who presented Jesus as the sacrifice for the sin that separated God from humanity. This proved that He loved us first, because we didn't even know that we were under sin, and we didn't know Holy Spirit was quarantined in the Holy of Holies. So when we hear that God declares sinners to be right in his sight when they believe in Jesus, it is because God bestowed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners. Jesus's one act of righteousness brings a right relationship with God and new life for every person who accepts it. Now saints are also tasked with reconciling humanity to God, but as lights (not saviors), emitting the light of Jesus, Who we are grafted into. Jesus is the example of the new generation of humanity, Christianity. Jesus has implied for each Saint to follow Him, and replicate some of His works. These attributes are witnessed by saints, as they abide in Jesus, and His teachings abide in each.

How Civilization Benefits from Real Christianity

We know through research that each real Christian that has the Word of God in their heart requires less oversight and less government. This is because they are closer to Godliness and operate from the narrow road, like Jesus did. It is because mankind has gotten so far away from God that civil law requires much more oversight. If you remember that it was God who instituted capital punishment to rid the world of evil, so as we see wars, conflicts, and violence, these are signs of how far humanity is away from God. Why do I mention this? The third reconciliation is for each person in humanity to be reconciled with each other, to be at peace with each other, as they will be in heaven. In Christianity, all saints have already been reconciled by Jesus. Christianity is a new form of humanity that did not exist before Jesus created it and had Holy Spirit empower it at Pentecost. The self evidence of this is when we stop and consider others before us. We replace retaliation with tolerance and understanding. Of course I am not advocating we become "doormats" either. But as we do place others before us and help to bear one another's burdens, this reconciliation begins to empower Holy Spirits gifting at a new level.

See for yourself the five levels of reconciliation Jesus provided and the effects on humanity.

1. Biblical evidence that Jesus reconciled God To humanity

Jesus did reconcile God to man by absorbing sin that separated them, it's called redemption.

- 1. Because we understand our fearful responsibility to the Lord, we work hard to persuade others. God knows we are sincere, and I hope you know this, too. Are we commending ourselves to you again? No, we are giving you a reason to be proud of us, so you can answer those who brag about having a spectacular ministry rather than having a sincere heart. If it seems we are crazy, it is to bring glory to God. And if we are in our right minds, it is for your benefit. Either way, Christ's love controls us. Since we believe that Christ died for all, we also believe that we have all died to our old life. He died for everyone so that those who receive his new life will no longer live for themselves. Instead, they will live for Christ, who died and was raised for them. So we have stopped evaluating others from a human point of view. At one time we thought of Christ merely from a human point of view. How differently we know him now! This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a **new person**. The old life is gone; a new life has begun! And all of this is a gift from God, who brought us back to himself through Christ. And God has given us this task of reconciling people to him. For God was in Christ, reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And he gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation. So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!" For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ. (2 Cor 5:11-21 NLT)
- 2. For **God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin**. People are made right with God when they believe that Jesus sacrificed his life, shedding his blood. This sacrifice shows that God was being fair when he held back and did not punish those who sinned in times past, for he was looking ahead and including them in what he would do in this present time. God did this to demonstrate his righteousness, for he himself is fair and just, and **he declares sinners to be right in his sight when they believe in Jesus**. (Rom 3:25 NLT)
- 3. But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners. And since we have been made right in God's sight by the blood of Christ, he will certainly save us from God's condemnation. (Rom 5:8-9 NLT)
- 4. Yes, Adam's one sin brings condemnation for everyone, but **Christ's one act of righteousness brings a right relationship with God and new life for everyone**. Because one person disobeyed God, many became sinners. But because one other person obeyed God, many will be made righteous. (Rom 5:18-19 NLT)
- 5. and reconciling both of them to God in one body through the cross, by which He extinguished their hostility. (Eph 2:16)

Biblical Evidence Support Recap:

Jesus did reconcile God to mankind by absorbing sin that separated them, it's redemption!

- 1. Christ died for all
- 2. Christ died for everyone so those who receive his new life will no longer live for themselves
- 3. This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person
- 4. God brought us back to himself through Christ's finished work on the cross
- 5. God has given us the task of reconciling people to God
- 6. God was in Christ, reconciling the world to himself, not counting people's sins against them
- 7. For God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin
- 8. God declares sinners to be right in his sight when they believe in Jesus
- 9. God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners
- 10. Christ's one act of righteousness brings a right relationship with God and new life for everyone

2. Biblical evidence that Jesus reconciled Mankind to God

Jesus did reconcile man back to God, realigning each person to be in unity with God.

- 1. And since we have been made right in God's sight by the blood of Christ, he will certainly save us from God's condemnation. For since our friendship with God was restored by the death of his Son while we were still his enemies, we will certainly be saved through the life of his Son. So now we can rejoice in our wonderful new relationship with God because our Lord Jesus Christ has made us friends of God. (Rom 5:9-11)
- 2. I pray that they will all be one, just as you and I are one—as you are in me, Father, and I am in you. And may they be in us so that the world will believe you sent me. "I have given them the glory you gave me, so they may be one as we are one. I am in them and you are in me. May they experience such perfect unity that the world will know that you sent me and that you love them as much as you love me. (John 17:21-23)
- 3. That they all may be one, [just] as You, Father, are in Me and I in You, that they also may be one in Us, so that the world may believe and be convinced that You have sent Me. I have given to them the glory and honor which You have given Me, that they may be one [even] as We are one: I in them and You in Me, in order that they may become one and perfectly united, that the world may know and [definitely] recognize that You sent Me and that You have loved them [even] as You have loved Me. (John 17:21-23 AMP)
- 4. When He said, "A new covenant," **He has made the first obsolete**. But whatever is becoming obsolete and growing old is ready to disappear. (Heb 8:13 NASB)
- 5. Jesus fulfilled the Old Testament requirement; thus discarding any further requirements for OT clergy system mediation, but maintaining the moral civic societal code.
- 6. Do not think that I have come to do away with *or* undo the Law or the Prophets; I have come not to do away with *or* undo **but to complete** *and* **fulfill them**. (Matt 5:17 AMPC)
- 7. **Until John came, there were the Law and the Prophets**; since then the good news (the Gospel) of the kingdom of God is being preached, and everyone strives violently to go in [would force his own way rather than God's way into it]. (Luke 16:15)
- 8. Under the law, the murderer becomes subject to the murdered (Nu 35:33). Satan, who influenced Jesus to be killed, under his dominion and responsibility, is now subject to Jesus Himself and all of Jesus' disciples. By killing Jesus, (this was outside Satan's jurisdiction) Satan for the first time became guilty of murdering innocent blood and **forfeited his hold on all who come to Jesus**.

Biblical Evidence Support Recap:

Jesus did reconcile man back to God, realigning each person to be in unity with God.

- 1. RESTORATION: Our friendship with God was restored by the death of his Son while we were still his enemies. Lord Jesus Christ has made us friends of God
- 2. UNIFICATION: Jesus provided humanity with a Godly unification potential, free will choice
- 3. BESTOWAL: Jesus gave mankind His glory so the world would believe God sent Jesus I have given them the glory you gave me, so they may be one as we are one
- 4. DISCARDED: Jesus completed and fulfilled the Old Testament legalistic requirements and thus discarded any further requirements for any further OT clergy system mediation, which was only projected to be active until John the Baptist.
- 5. REVERSED: Jesus reversed satanic annexation of humanity. Satan forfeited his hold on all who come to Jesus because he murdered an innocent man.

3. Biblical evidence that Jesus reconciled Man to man

Jesus did reconcile man to man, where each is aligned with each other with the implication to be at peace, harmony and to serve each other.

- 1. "Don't forget that you Gentiles used to be outsiders. You were called "uncircumcised heathens" by the Jews, who were proud of their circumcision, even though it affected only their bodies and not their hearts. In those days you were living apart from Christ. You were excluded from citizenship among the people of Israel, and you did not know the covenant promises God had made to them. You lived in this world without God and without hope. But now you have been united with Christ Jesus. Once you were far away from God, but now you have been brought near to him through the blood of Christ. For Christ himself has brought peace to us. He united Jews and Gentiles into one people when, in his own body on the cross, he broke down the wall of hostility that separated us. He did this by ending the system of law with its commandments and regulations. He made peace between Jews and Gentiles by creating in himself one new people from the two groups. Together as one body, Christ reconciled both groups to God by means of his death on the cross, and our hostility toward each other was put to death. He brought this Good News of peace to you Gentiles who were far away from him, and peace to the Jews who were near. Now all of us can come to the Father through the same Holy Spirit because of what Christ has done for us. So now you Gentiles are no longer strangers and foreigners. You are citizens along with all of God's holy people. You are members of God's family. Together, we are his house, built on the foundation of the apostles and the prophets. And the cornerstone is Christ Jesus himself. We are carefully joined together in him, becoming a holy temple for the Lord. Through him you Gentiles are also being made part of this dwelling where God lives by his Spirit." (Ephesians 2:11-22 NLT)
- 2. A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so **you must love one another**. By this **everyone will know** that you are my disciples, if you love one another." (John 1`3:34-35)
- 3. For just as we have many members in one body and all the members do not have the same function, so we, who are many, are **one body in Christ**, and individually **members one of another**. (Rom 12:4-5)
- 4. **Don't just pretend to love others**. Really love them. Hate what is wrong. Hold tightly to what is good. Love each other with genuine affection, and **take delight in honoring each other**. Never be lazy, but work hard and serve the Lord enthusiastically. Rejoice in our confident hope. Be patient in trouble, and keep on praying. When God's people are in need, be ready to help them. Always be eager to practice hospitality. Rom 12:9-13)
- 5. **Don't grumble about each other**, brothers and sisters, or you will be judged. For look—the Judge is standing at the door! (James 5:9)
- 6. But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, **we have fellowship with one another**, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin. (John 1:7)
- 7. Above all, **love each other deeply**, because love covers over a multitude of sins. **Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling**. Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms. (1 Peter 4:8-10)

Biblical Evidence Support Recap:

Jesus did reconcile man to man, where each is aligned with each other with the implication to be at peace, harmony and to serve each other.

- 1. Jesus united Jews and Gentiles into one people when He was in his own body on the cross
- 2. Jesus broke down the wall of hostility that separated us, each other
- 3. Jesus made peace between Jews and Gentiles by creating in himself one new humanity
- 4. Now all can come to God through the same Holy Spirit because of what Christ has done
- 5. You are citizens (members of God's family) along with all of God's holy people, all the angels and saints. Christians have crossed over from sinner to Saint and from death (under wrath) to eternal life, bypassing death (John 5:24). Just do what God says and be happy!

5 Levels of Reconciliation

One More Thing:

• "Attention, all! See the marvels of GOD! He plants flowers and trees all over the earth, **Bans war from pole to pole, breaks all the weapons across his knee**. "Step out of the traffic! Take a long, loving look at me, your High God, above politics, above everything."" (Psalm 46:8-10 MSG)

Do you think there is an implication here for all humanity to be in unity? Do you think God might be telling us to stop the aggressive tactics that promote dissension, conflict, and strife?

The wicked accuse, the Godly defend. (Proverbs 12:6 TLB)

4. Jesus reconciled mankind over the physical earth

Jesus reconciled mankind by **reestablishing mankind to the original physical oversight** position over all the earth, lost from the fall, with a new form of life, and with the keys to the kingdom of Heaven until He returns.

- 1. "By abolishing in His [own crucified] flesh the enmity [caused by] the Law with its decrees and ordinances [which He annulled]; that He from the two might create in Himself one new man [one new quality of humanity out of the two], so making peace." (Eph 2:15 AMPC)
- 2. "But the person who is united to the Lord **becomes one spirit with Him**." (1 Cor 6:17 AMPC)
- 3. that all of them may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I am in You. May they also be in Us, so that the world may believe that You sent Me. (John 17:21)
- 4. "Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither can you unless you abide in Me." (John 15:4 NASB)
- 5. But if some of the branches were broken off, and you, although a wild olive shoot, were grafted in among the others and now share in the nourishing root of the olive tree, (Rom 11:17)
- 6. And the Ever-living One [I am living in the eternity of the eternities]. I died, but see, I am alive forevermore; and I possess the keys of death and Hades (the realm of the dead). (Rev 1:18 NLT)
- 7. Now I say to you that you are Peter (which means 'rock'), and upon this rock I will build my church, and all the powers of hell will not conquer it. And I will give you the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven. Whatever you forbid on earth will be forbidden in heaven, and whatever you permit on earth will be permitted in heaven." (Matt 16:18-19)
- 8. Hold fast to what you have until I come. Revelation 2:25

Biblical Evidence Support Recap:

Jesus did reinstate man over physical earth, with the keys to the kingdom of Heaven.

- 1. The government is on Jesus' shoulders and He gives saints authority over the nations, as His Ambassadors (Rev 2:26-27, NASB).
- 2. Jesus alone now possesses the keys of death and Hades (Rev 1:18)
- 3. Jesus reinstated man by perfecting saints to be at one with God, by grafting saints into Himself, and by Holy Spirit adopting saints, to operate with His keys, in the divine nature.
- 4. Jesus instructs disciples to hold fast to what you have until He returns (Rev 2:25). This "hold fast" indicates that we are to take ground and hold it.

5. Jesus reconciled mankind over spiritual life thru Christ

Jesus reconciled mankind by reinstating humanitarian potential to overcome all sin and override all demonic temptation, symptoms, and influence:

- 1. Since the children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might break the power of him who holds the power of death--that is, the devil-- (Heb 2:14)
- 2. Now judgment is upon this world; now the prince of this world will be cast out. (John 12:31)
- 3. For what the Law was powerless to do in that it was weakened by the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful man, as an offering for sin. **He thus condemned sin in the flesh**, (Romans 8:3)
- 4. He chose the lowly and despised things of the world, and the things that are not, to **nullify the things** that are, (1 Corinthians 1:28)
- 5. Jesus called his twelve disciples together and **gave them authority to cast out evil spirits** and to heal every kind of disease and illness. (Matt 10:1 NLT)
- 6. **Heal** the sick, **raise** the dead, **cure** those with leprosy, and **cast** out demons. Give as freely as you have received! (Matt 10:8 NLT)
- 7. Again he said, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I am sending you." Then he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive anyone's sins, they are forgiven. If you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven." (John 20:23 NLT)
- 8. And then he told them, "Go into all the world and preach the Good News to everyone. Anyone who believes and is baptized will be saved. But anyone who refuses to believe will be condemned. **These miraculous signs will accompany those who believe**: They will **cast** out demons in my name, and they will **speak** in new languages. They will be able to handle snakes with safety, and if they drink anything poisonous, it won't hurt them. They will be able to place their hands on the sick, and they will be healed." (Mark 16:15-18 NLT)
- 9. Look, I have given you authority over all the power of the enemy, and you can walk among snakes and scorpions and crush them. Nothing will injure you. (Luke 10:19 NLT)

Biblical Evidence Support Recap:

Jesus reconciled mankind by reinstating humanitarian potential to overcome all sin and override all demonic temptation, symptoms, and influence with the same Holy Spirit

- 1. God broke the power of Satan and all the demonic, and just as God cast Satan out of heaven he will cast Satan completely out of the earth, and all the world. He is already sentenced.
- 2. By absorbing sin, God condemned sin in the flesh (or sickness), and nullifies their effects
- 3. Jesus gives all saints authority to heal the sick, raise the dead, cure those with leprosy, and cast out demons, on every kind of disease and illness, over all the power of the enemy, by including saints to also have Jesus' personal authority over all demonic influence
- 4. If you forgive anyone's sins, they are forgiven. If you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven
- 5. These miraculous signs accompany those who believe: cast, speak in tongues, heal sick, etc.

REPORT EPILOGUE

As Christians go forward and replicate Jesus natural and supernatural works, they too are demonstrating that God did send Jesus.

Commenting on the reinstatement of man over the physical earth might bring ideas of stoping wind storms, blocking rain, pacifying dangerous animals with God's presence where the lion lays down peacefully (as in heaven), or even restocking waterways with fish after they have been plundered. I have personally seen wind storms stopped, rain blocked, and skies opened to bright sunshine, and have heard of other testimonials where outdoor events were protected and kept dry from massive rain on top of them and around them, yet not a drop on anyone while the event was active! These keys really do work, but only for those who truly believe.

It is because saints are established by God and Jesus, from His throne in heaven, that we can use the authority given to us to supercede evil, illness, darkness, and many other things. I assure you there is nothing more rewarding than seeing the impossible accomplished by God when He sends you out to an impossible situation and you see the sick healed, or someone delivered from demonic oppression, or when we forgive sins and see the glory of God clear out the darkness and reinstate peace. Because we are at one, as He is, so are we in this world. (1 John 4:17) We all choose if we want to acknowledge and use any of the keys at our own free will.

In reference to this report there are a number of truths that can be safely recapitulated:

- 1. **Jesus was sent by God** to absorb everybody's sin so each has ample opportunity to choose God's best for them-self, build a relationship, flourish, and fulfill their own destiny on earth.
- 2. Jesus' finished work on Calvary **restored God to mankind**, mankind to God, and man to man through discarding the old legal system and reversing out satanic and sinful influence.
- 3. **Jesus created a new form of humanity** called Christianity, were saints become one with God, grafted into Jesus, and adopted by Holy Spirit. In this model saints are:
 - a) tasked with focusing on Jesus and believing, not double-minded, and not doubting
 - b) tasked with bestowing grace on sinners (without condemnation), by being light and salt, to flavor the gospel in their own personality, to extend the gospel to their own environmental spheres of influence who will accept it and want it.
 - c) tasked with overseeing the earth's integrity to manage the nations by establishing righteous (moral) lifestyles glorifying God.
 - d) tasked with utilizing the keys to bind and loose, heal, deliver, and bestow the prophetic, intervening as needed to destroy works of evil and manifest the natural and supernatural works of Jesus. As we lighten others load, and enlighten with the gospel, God is happy!
