WAITING ON GOD



WHAT IS OBSERVED FROM WAITING ON GOD?

- 1. The seeking of God involves waiting FOR God.
- 2. God has waited for men to wait for Him.
- 3. For those who wait for God there is a promised blessedness, without exception.

WHY DOES GOD KEEP MAN WAITING?

- 1. To silence man's natural spirit of restlessness and agitation.
- 2. To teach man of his unworthiness and a reverence for a holy God.
- 3. To increase man's desire for God so that God might have a greater opportunity for a better response.
- 4. To condition man's human faculties for better reception and submission for a fuller benefit of that which is to follow.

THE PROPER CHARACTERISTICS OF OUR WAITING

- 1. **Early** in your day without procrastination and before other interests
- 2. **Daily** waiting should be systematic and not spasmodic
- 3. Watchfully, be alert to His response but without strain
- 4. **Continually**; it should be a mode of life and not merely a temporary expediency in time of need
- 5. **Objectively**; this waiting should have a definite purpose with Him being the principle objective
- 6. **Expectantly**; with confident and active expectation and not in a state of mere pious wishing
- 7. **Patiently**; calmly enduring the seemingly fruitless expenditure of time and effort in the realization that to hurry God is to find fault with Him. *View it as an opportunity to grant God the extravagance of your best time!*
- 8. Hopefully; with quiet, unwavering confidence in an ultimate response to God
- 9. **Lovingly**; this waiting should not be the waiting of a selfish beggar, but the waiting of a yearning lover
- 10. Preferentially; desiring Him in preference to anything else
