The concealed resistance and rejection of Holy Spirit signifies those churches aren't ready for the authentic model yet, although they will be open to revival once every five years. It is for everyone, anytime, for all humanity, so if you're breathing you qualify! It is God Who has derived and currently sustains all life (which includes all human cellular structure) and sincerely wants to know each of us personally as well. The left column are attributes prompted by Holy Spirit's indwelling after each sincere salvation and the right column attributes are prompted by initiating study, prayer and fasting, as Jesus' modeled. The reason I've listed these for us is to review and evaluate, to verify and experience them.

Once We Realize...We'd Be Much More Likely To Consider...

Once we realize Who this Jesus really is and why He came to earth from heaven, and what He accomplished here, and how He impacted humanity, we'd be much more likely to consider entering into His authentic Christian model. This report is to recount the values Jesus has already delivered to earth for anyone to review, accept, internalize, and benefit from.

Enter into God's kingdom now by selecting to acknowledge Jesus. Tell God thanks for sending Jesus to pay my way into heaven and connecting me to Holy Spirit. **Believe it, it's true, and enter into Christianity today!** By sincerely believing in our heart and speaking with our mouth God allows us entrance into His kingdom for both eternal life in heaven eternally and abundant life on earth right now!

• If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your **heart** that you **believe** and are **justified**, and it is with your **mouth** that you **profess** your faith and are **saved**. Romans 10: 9-10 NIV

Absolutism

Absolutism is a form of government or a doctrine, principle, or standard in which all power is vested in a single ruler.



God is unequivocally and completely absolute but doesn't practice absolutism. He wills to and does continue to sustain all planetary cellular life for all concerned. Humanity's free will characteristic, designed by and honored by God, proves that God doesn't practice a dictatorship, tyranny, or authoritarianism. Other earthly leaders have been tyrants, by plotting against their opponents, etc., but God has much higher values, sustaining individual lives as very important (even when they're resisting His values).

Once people realize how absolute God is, even omnipotent, and how God continues to honor individual free will, it makes us wonder about Him and builds credibility and attractiveness towards Him. When we realize that God is sustaining our life right now it adds a bit of clarity to Who He really is.

THE INDOMITABLE WILL

God's Will

This is a subject that has been redefined far too often so I'm identifying original definitions so anyone interested can become aware of them.

God's Desire

- "For **I** desire and delight in dutiful steadfast love and goodness, not sacrifice, and the knowledge of and acquaintance with God more than burnt offerings. (Hosea 6:6 AMPC)
- "And if you had only known what this saying means, **I desire mercy** [readiness to help, to spare, to forgive] rather than sacrifice and sacrificial victims, you would not have condemned the guiltless. (Matthew 12:7 AMPC)

I think it is safe to say that God's desire, as our primary parent, since He is our creator, is to bless His children, to see His children become like Him and carry on the family business. Did you notice that God has given us a free will? That speaks volumes of His unconditional love for us. So it would seem that His greatest desire is to see His children succeed! Doesn't that seem familiar to most of us? Our parents wanted us to succeed, and we want our kids to succeed. It is only natural.

Gods Will Is To Bless Us & He Already Has

God's will is God's Word, and that informs and declares humanity of His wishes. God's system in heaven connects everything and everyone to Him. His environment feeds off His self-existent omniscient life. The universe is subject to this as well. See Greek 2222 in The 5 Elementals. Remember that God made humanity to be like Him. Before the fall of man things were good. Then Satan introduced sin to separate humanity from God, knowing from experience, and being expelled from heaven himself. For a while, on earth, God implemented a centralized clergy laity system, but that proved ineffective. So God sent Jesus to remove the sin barrier and reconcile mankind directly to Him, restoring divine union (see <u>Reconciliation Report</u>). So now God has an individual system that is direct, and not mediated, just like heaven (on earth, as it is in heaven). God's basic standard and His will for each of His children is SOZO; which means saved, healed, delivered, and prospered. God has already determined, in advance, and has decide to favor His creation. His will has been written, and He sent Jesus to bestow a new form of humanity, with new beneficial standards. Sözo, meaning saved, healed and prospered is God's desire for each one of us. God's will sent Jesus to reconcile everyone to Him, and Jesus' will was to do the will of God and become the sanctuary entry point for humanity to enter into His authentic Christianity.

We can know God's will because it is written for all to become aware of. After that we can choose to follow it or reject it. In Romans 10:9 Paul states that whoever believes in their heart and confesses Jesus as Lord will be saved, but that phrase works in conjunction with the balance God's will, and doesn't override other qualifications. For those who ignorantly teach that those who recite a sinners prayer will "Never Lose" their salvation, and can disregard the balance of God's conditions, these verses should be sobering. With that, let's realize, in comparison to the old testament system, today's population really does have it much easier. In the new testament

there is no human mediator overseer or mandated temple service, no financial requirement or forced works. In this system, whoever enters in becomes the temple of God, and is directly aligned to God, by adoption, as God's child. So **God's WILL IS TO MAKE IT EASY!**, but God does have some heavenly standards too.

Any Mystery Of God's Will Is Cleared Up Here

- "Jesus told them, "This is the only work God wants from you: **Believe in the one he has** sent."" (John 6:29 NLT)
- "For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who beholds the Son and believes in Him will have eternal life, and I Myself will raise him up on the last day."" (John 6:40 NASB)
- "And this is His order (His command, His injunction): that we should believe in (put our faith and trust in and adhere to and rely on) the name of His Son Jesus Christ (the Messiah), and that we should love one another, just as He has commanded us. All who keep His commandments [who obey His orders and follow His plan, live and continue to live, to stay and] abide in Him, and He in them. [They let Christ be a home to them and they are the home of Christ.] And by this we know and understand and have the proof that He [really] lives and makes His home in us: by the [Holy] Spirit Whom He has given us." (1 John 3:23-24 AMPC)
- <u>Did Jesus place qualifications on kingdom entrance?</u> "Not everyone who calls out to me, 'Lord! Lord!' will enter the Kingdom of Heaven. **Only those who actually do the will of my Father in heaven will enter.**" (Matthew 7:21 NLT) Matthew 25:31-46 will confirm this explicitly.
- "God has now revealed to us his mysterious plan regarding Christ, a plan to fulfill his own good pleasure. And this is the plan: At the right time he will bring everything together under the authority of Christ—everything in heaven and on earth. Furthermore, because we are united with Christ, we have received an inheritance from God, for he chose us in advance, and he makes everything work out according to his plan. God's purpose was that we Jews who were the first to trust in Christ would bring praise and glory to God. And now you Gentiles have also heard the truth, the Good News that God saves you. And when you believed in Christ, he identified you as his own by giving you the Holy Spirit, whom he promised long ago. The Spirit is God's guarantee that he will give us the inheritance he promised and that he has purchased us to be his own people. He did this so we would praise and glorify him." (Ephesians 1:9-14 NLT)
- "This is good and pleases God our Savior, who wants everyone to be saved and to understand the truth." (1 Timothy 2:3-4 NLT)
- "For God did not send the Son into the world in order to judge (to reject, to condemn, to pass sentence on) the world, but that the world might find salvation and be made safe and sound through Him." (John 3:17 AMPC)
- "The Lord does not delay and is not tardy or slow about what He promises, according to some people's conception of slowness, but He is long-suffering (extraordinarily patient) toward you, not desiring that any should perish, but that all should turn to repentance." (2 Peter 3:9 AMPC)
- Beloved, I pray that in all respects **you may prosper and be in good health**, just as your soul prospers. (3 John 1:2, NASB).
- "Pray, therefore, like this: Our Father Who is in heaven, hallowed (kept holy) be Your name. Your kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven." Matthew 6:9-10 AMPC

God's Will Recap

Does God have some qualifications for kingdom entrance? It is much better to know the truth, straight from God, rather than being cheated out of your eternal life benefit. Here is a recap:

- 1. Believe in Jesus, the one God has sent, <u>NOTICE THIS # 1 because it is the most important!</u>
- 2. This is the will of God, that everyone who believes in Jesus will have eternal life
- 3. This is Gods order:
 - a) we should believe in the name of His Son Jesus Christ

- b) we should love one another, just as He has commanded us
- c) All who obey His orders and abide in Jesus, and He in them....:
 - 1) Saints let Christ be a home to them-self and they are the home for Christ, as a temple
 - 2) By this we know and have the proof that Jesus makes His home in us
 - 3) By the Holy Spirit Whom He has given us and Who indwells us
- 4. Jesus did place a qualification on kingdom entrance with this condition: Only those who actually do the will of my Father in heaven will enter. See Matthew 25:31-46 to confirm.
- 5. Holy Spirit is God's guarantee of the inheritance God promised
- 6. God wants everyone to be saved and to understand the truth
- 7. God wants the world to find salvation and be made safe
- 8. God doesn't desire any to perish, but that all should turn to Him
- 9. God's will is for all to have a generous and prosperous lifestyle
- 10. God's will is for each of us to have **wellness**, physically and emotionally
- 11. God's will is for you to know Him and eternally reside with Him in heaven

God's Will Factors

Jesus <u>has already</u> authentically advanced humanity <u>by bestowing</u> a potential for eternal assurance and abundant life of overcoming, overriding, and overruling sin, symptoms, and circumstances thru gospel acceptance and endearment, enlightenment, and empowerment! These factors and benefits are caught from our awareness, reaching, and embracing to catch these. God's will is that we grow up in Him, and all that we can be.

- 1. **IDENTITY**: God's will is for all His children to be with Him, and they can be, by selecting to exit humanity and enter Christianity, bypassing death and beginning their eternal life at the time of their conversion from sinner to saint.
- 2. **ETERNALLY**: God's will is for all His children to be saved and delivered from all demonic caused wrath, because as saints, we're in alignment with God's heavenly grace standards, and not under the law (which is for sinners only).
- 3. **PHYSICALLY**: God's will is for all His children to be physically healed and in very good health. Since we're now citizens of heaven we should be benefiting from its healthy attributes, especially since sickness doesn't exist there.
- 4. **PROSPERITY**: God's will is for all His children to be prosperous because we're operating in a flourishing system where there is no lack, no death (we bypass spiritual death), no enemies (they're overcome already). Results are upgraded and multiply by secretly sowing.
- 5. **HEREDITY**: God's will is for all His children to be like God, to follow Jesus' examples, and to be in unity with God and then with other saints. Through spiritual adoption God genetically transmits His characteristics into our own individual personality.

These are my own observations of concepts to be recognized, realized, and internalized, so we could embrace these benefits. Are we aware of these benefits? Have we truly acknowledged and activated their qualities? Once we do, and abide in them our lives will change. After a period of adjustment, then we can be salt and light helping others do the same. Then all saints can reflect Jesus' divine nature light, within their own personality. In Christianity we're all recipients of divine nature internally and heavenly standards externally.

God Gave Mankind Freewill So Each Could Choose Their Own Path

Who is in control of our own life? God did set apart humanity by designing into it a free will attribute that only each person can exercise. Why would God do that? So each relationship would be genuine. Take a look at free will definition from the Greek concordance below. God did make mankind with a free will. Everyone has a free will to make choices. So often those choices are muddied with deceptive propaganda which continues to manipulate and alter truth.

Free Will Defined

Strong's Concordance; 1595 hekousios: of free will, voluntary

Definition: of free will, voluntary

Usage: willing, with right good will, voluntary, spontaneous.

In this free will attribute God demonstrated His love for all humanity by setting them free. He didn't place any controls on anyone, or any leashes. That proves unconditional love. See how some verses demonstrate free will:

- ""I am the good shepherd; I know my own sheep, and they know me, just as my Father knows me and I know the Father. So I sacrifice my life for the sheep. I have other sheep, too, that are not in this sheepfold. I must bring them also. They will listen to my voice, and there will be one flock with one shepherd. "The Father loves me because I sacrifice my life so I may take it back again. No one can take my life from me. I sacrifice it voluntarily. For I have the authority to lay it down when I want to and also to take it up again. For this is what my Father has commanded."" (John 10:14-18 NLT)
- "For if I do this work of my own free will, then I have my pay (my reward); but if it is not of my own will, but is done reluctantly and under compulsion, I am [still] entrusted with a [sacred] trusteeship and commission." (I Corinthians 9:17 AMPC)
- "And it was of His own [free] will that He gave us birth [as sons] by [His] Word of Truth, so that we should be a kind of first fruits of His creatures [a sample of what He created to be consecrated to Himself]." (James 1:18 AMPC)
- "But it has been my wish to do nothing about it without first consulting you and getting your consent, in order that your benevolence **might not seem to be the result of compulsion** or of pressure but might be **voluntary** [on your part]." (Philemon 1:14 AMPC)

Cultural Belief & Folklore

Free will is even prevalent in our culture and in our folklore. No doubt you've probably heard, "If you really love someone you'll set them free". If they return to you, then there is a reciprocal love. In other words it has to be both parties, either as friends, family, or mates. It must be copacetic. Another interpretation could be that we can't force someone to love us. We must give everyone the freedom to choose. Que Sera Sera!

Humanity's Free Will

First of all let's recognize that we're all "cramming For Finals" "cramming for finals" in something. There is a reason why there are more older people in church. But we all don't have to wait until we're ready to "cram for finals" to attend a church service either.

Free Will Characteristic (Snapshot Video Text)

Free will is the most **powerful characteristic in all of creation**. Ask any parent about dealing with each child's free will selections, and the struggles from them. We notice psychological strategies toward modifying other people's behavior from religion, to advertising, and military and corporate mindsets. **But true free will is in the heart of each of us**, where our deep beliefs are held. This free will can only be effected by our willingness to focus on what these beliefs are, and then openly evaluate them, one at a time.

Nobody has control over this, **but the person them-self**, unless they've traded it for something else. But, as the most powerful characteristic in all of creation, established by God for each individual, free will can "flip on a dime" as soon as it engages with any enlightenment. So then **the appetite for enlightenment seems to be the critical factor**. I've witnessed this numerous times in ICU and hospice environments, where death is imminent. What is interesting is that every person, regardless of their lifestyle, all unprompted, reached out for Jesus. It appears that necessity really is the mother of invention. I guess they finally got "an appetite" and, "became ready". You see, nobody rejects Jesus while dying. In 30 years of ministry, many of which was spent in intervening for the in-firmed, I've witnessed many free will "flips on a dime"! As anyone submits to truth and enlightenment these factors do activate because God's agenda of perfection begins as we enter in. Darkness is exposed, truth is revealed, and freedom is released!

These are synergistic factors that God does. These are between God and man, as we enter into God's authentic gospel. They are very authentic and cannot be fabricated. Although *we can't do these things for others*, we <u>can intervene</u> in prayer, offer endearment, and be a light ourselves. The onus of all free will enlightenment and even empowerment is within each individual. **Everybody responds whenever they are ready.**

Sometimes we may want more for someone than they want for them-self. Accordingly, as we're helping them, and they're not trying, it's apparent your both not working toward the same goal. Even two oxen are yoked to keep them both going in the same direction. Some just seem completely "clueless", and don't or won't connect. So maybe the best thing to do is to cut them loose, until they're ready, within their own free will. You can lead a horse to water, but you can't make him drink. To intervene in prayer is good, but meddling can hinder or obstruct the impactful consequences of bad choices that could awaken the deceived. Our time can be more productive with people who are earnestly interested. Bearing one another's burden was never

meant to tie us up with the responsibility for other people's slacker ways. There is no sense in tying ourself up in knots, because others aren't interested, or too deceived and unaware. **Note to those seeking prosperity**: "this is very important". If people wait until the smell of death, to engage God's gospel offer of eternal life, then **they've willfully missed the other benefits**, like deliverance, healing, prosperity, true peace, the bonus of all those gifts, and the opportunity to invest treasure in heaven! In reality, since God knows who has resisted His gospel, and rejected His values, if they do make heaven on such a slacker status, **where does that leave them** throughout eternity? They could have been storing up treasures in heaven most of their lives! Smart people on earth work hard, save and store up, for either emergency, hobby, retirement, etc. **If you knew** you could be storing up some of that treasure in heaven, wouldn't you be doing that too? If we can build treasure on earth we can build treasure in heaven as well. As we know about this, we can elect to activate a plan toward storing some up. Jesus said that we'll store up treasure wherever our heart is. **Something else to ponder, while we can!**

Does God Expect His Saints To Actually Do His Will?

Now this is an honest question! I believe we all "intend" on doing God's will. I'll begin with some verses that address this issue, with some comments following.

- "Do not, therefore, fling away your fearless confidence, for it carries a great and glorious compensation of reward. For you have need of steadfast patience and endurance, so that **you may perform and fully accomplish the will of God**, and thus receive and carry away [and enjoy to the full] what is promised." (Hebrews 10:35-36 AMPC) It is implied that each saint would do something.
- 'For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them. not as a result of works, so that no one may boast. '(Ephesians 2:8-10) The implication here is clear that God expects His saints to do good works.

These above verses, coupled with Jesus' Matthew 7:21 and 25:31-46 confirm that there are some expectations from God for His saints to be like Him and to fulfill our earthly destiny, in our personality. We do change our spiritual identity but our earthly personality remains with us.

Incidentally, none of the expectations include mandated church service attendance, or any required level of financial subsidy. If you look closer to Jesus' instructions in Matthew 6, He teaches us to pray, fast, and give, but all in secret. This is where the real leverage is. I like church services too! But it appears church attendance doesn't replace Jesus' teachings or doing God's will. If we're interested in reviewing the six items that Jesus reports that separate the sheep from the goats we'd be startled at how elementary these are. Please review Matthew 25:31-46 to just how easy God made this. Here they are; water to the thirsty, food to the hungry, clothing to the naked, housing to the traveler, visit the sick and the imprisoned. *God did it again!* He made it easy for anyone to enter into His kingdom, and He made it easy to comply with His goat/sheep judgement qualifications! It's all a matter of our own free will and our own intentional effort.

Gospel Favor Principles Are Free Will!

Just like eternal life, healing and deliverance, the favor or prosperity of God is through our free will as well. I'm addressing this in this report so new arrivals can be aware of this, know the truth and help them decipher false teaching to avoid. God does want to favor each of us.

- "[Live] as children of obedience [to God]; do not conform yourselves to the evil desires [that governed you] in your former ignorance [when you did not know the requirements of the Gospel].

 But as the One Who called you is holy, you yourselves also be holy in all your conduct and manner of living." (1 Peter 1:14-15 AMPC)
- "So roll up your sleeves, put your mind in gear, be totally ready to receive the gift that's coming when Jesus arrives. Don't lazily slip back into those old grooves of evil, doing just what you feel like doing. You didn't know any better then; you do now. As obedient children, let yourselves be pulled into a way of life shaped by God's life, a life energetic and blazing with holiness. God said, "I am holy; you be holy."" (1 Peter 1:13-16 MSG)

These are some observations that have served me and others I know. I hope they'll help you.

Favor Principle #1: Original Design

God **made humanity to be like Him**. Satan separated humanity from God with sin. Jesus absorbed all sin, and reconciled humanity back to God, to offer humanity an open option to enter into Christianity, where we're indwelled by Holy Spirit, to be like God, as intended originally.

Favor Principle #2: Recalibrating To Bestow

Because **disciples aren't above their master**, Saints are expected to replicate Jesus humble practices of a quiet life, one of personal prayer, fasting, spending time alone with Holy Spirit, and bestowing God's grace and gifts for anyone whose belief will allow them to receive.

Favor Principle #3: Free Will Practices

All humanity has a **free will to practice their own belief and faith**, in and with their own intentional direction and at their own discretion. These will serve beneficially or consequentially. The onus is on each person to acquire knowledge and practice truth. All free will does have an intentionality that is directed toward the interest of each individual. So knowing our motivations and the direction of our lifestyle choices should be taken into consideration before we exercise choices that may land us in a pothole or a black hole!

Importance Of Truth & Belief

Belief, both secular and religious, are known commodities, and have been studied, documented, and reported for a long time. My interest and question is does any of these have the capability to move the needle on any issues? That is the real question. Theory is good. But empowerment, effectively producing results is better. That is the difference between pontification and demonstration. Even Jesus reported to let things happen according to our own beliefs. Psychology has reported on belief, meditation, and their effects for decades. As people are peacefully in a therapy session, alternative factors can be acknowledged and then potentially activated. If they're abided in, they can succeed.

Truth plus knowledge equals our personal belief. Our belief is what our faith is derived from. Whenever we recognize that our effectiveness is ultimately from our personal truth, then truth must be evaluated going forward. Jesus even said that we'll have what we believe and speak. That marks that as a Godly principle. Don't miss the mark on this. Most haven't discerned this principle, it is important.

What Research Has Reported

Pew Research has reported that many are still well connected to their God and their personal belief system, even though they're not attending as many events. So the issue of belief is growing, but more personally. Belief, as a concept, implies the existence of a substance or the status of something with some degree of intentionality. This is controversial, and has been debated for a long time. However, if our belief is derived from a true base of empirical and stable knowledge, then it has the ability to become more productive. Empirical is from observation and experiential, not theory *(not just intellectual)*. So as we observe, build our awareness, acknowledge, and activate new tactics we're operating in the experiential. When we do this with expectations, and with intentionality, we're setting something in motion.

With this understanding, add to this the practicality of being unified with Jesus and indwelled with omniscient and omnipotent Holy Spirit. Jesus had Holy Spirit without measure, or was completely empowered. Today's saints have Holy Spirit potentially without measure as well. As we follow Jesus' tactics, empowerment increases. The onus is on us to remove anything blocking Holy Spirit's enlightenment and empowerment.

Thoughts, Words, Deeds (TWD's)

What if you knew that it was *your own thoughts, words, and deeds* (TWD's) that have created a blockage to God's favor in your life? If sin separates man from God (*which is proven*), carnal lifestyle's (*gospel resistors without Holy Spirit*), and those who selectively activate conflicting practices, their selections block God's favor. Saying you didn't know isn't an acceptable excuse. All are created and sustained by God's self existent life. If you're breathing, it is because it is God's will for you to keep doing that. See <u>The 5 Elementals</u> for details on this.

Who Is Effected By Our Choices?

As a person turns to God, that person is embraced by God, indwelled by Holy Spirit, cleansed of past sins, and enlightened to know new heavenly standards. These new covenant standards are exposed, illuminated and made apparent. If our own TWD's produce conflicting carnal practices, these practices will separate that person from God. God isn't effected here. Only the person is effected by their own choices. God isn't effected by our sin, because He's absolute and inviolable (cannot be violated). God doesn't lose!

Some repent, which reinstates Holy Spirit. Some don't, and continue to practice conflicting values, which keeps them separated from God. Many of these have revised the gospel to include their own values. They've always considered themselves progressive. Today the church has more than 50,000 denominations. This creates a maze of values, and practices, that require time to decipher, to pick one that is effective toward deriving God's favor. Actually you don't need any

of them. Denominations offer traditions, practices, and belief systems. They're all theological, or revised, mostly away from Jesus authentic model. My observation is that rules were changed to accommodate membership comfort levels and hirelings were brought in to guard the "approved" culture. Speakers and spectators populate events and somehow enough of the gospel does get through to seeking hearts for salvation to manifest. People who are earnestly seeking God out of their free will can receive wherever the gospel is spoken or printed.

Abiding Standards

Acceptable authentic practices were identified by Jesus and Paul. We only need Jesus' authentic Christianity, where we directly enter into and embrace Jesus and both He and Holy Spirit then embrace us. If and when we keep the authentic gospel values and become aware of God's values, acknowledge and activate them, then we can abide in them. *It's only in "abiding in Jesus" that God's favor is consistently prevalent!* I know because I've tried the others, and they don't work. I've witnessed more who've failed as well.

However whenever we return to Jesus, abide in Him, the odds of Holy Spirit empowering His gifts and favor are much more prevalent. The reason is simple. It is because Holy Spirit is still with us, and they are His gifts. So if He is still with us, we've not removed Him by our TWD conflicting practices. Our TWD's will and do produce results, both beneficial and consequential. Jesus said that it's a Narrow Road and few will find it. I hope you do. It is worth the effort, today, tomorrow and forever.

- Did you get your portion of favor and blessings yet?
- Are you aware that these are already in transit to you?

Answers: What is supposed to be added to you, spiritually, physically, and financially has already been released by God, but may have not been received yet or activated by us individually. Reception may require us to develop "eyes to see and ears to hear" so we don't miss these benefits. As we become dedicated to meditation our receptivity becomes more focused which activates a better receptivity. May God bless you richly, today, tomorrow and forever!



JESUS MADE IT HAPPEN

Jesus made it happen by exposing and expelling the evil and the demonic, in both the spiritual beings and the clergy (at that time). Jesus delivered to earth a new system of life, out of Himself, and called it Christianity. How God made all this happen for humanity is a very important subject and should be understood for many reason that do impact us. I hope everyone chooses to know about Jesus' accomplishments, teachings and standards. Proviso

The reason Jesus is established as mankind's only true mediator is because **ONLY HE** reconciled God to mankind. Christ is the one who paid the price, as the pascal lamb, on the cross, shedding His blood, to go on the Mercy Seat, to remove the stain of separating sin. Nobody could duplicate this, because nobody has ever come from heaven, with the credentials to fulfill God's requirements to remove the sin barrier. Jesus is the only "Spiritual Covering" we have. Jesus did this to benefit people individually and corporately.

Jesus Is The Only Mediator, and the only advocate, and only way to God. Jesus replaced the entire Sanhedrin clergy mediator system with Himself as the active mediator. This is a very important and strategic factor to internalize, because it is in Jesus, by which we are set free and gain access to the reconciled heavenly standards.



JESUS' BLOOD GOES DOWN TO THE MERCY SEAT

- "For there is [only] one God, and [only] one Mediator between
 God and mankind, the Man Christ Jesus," (1 TIMOTHY 2:5 AMP)
- But now Jesus, our High Priest, has been given a ministry that is **far superior to the old priesthood**, for he is the **one who mediates** for us a far better covenant with God, based on better promises. (Hebrews 8:6)
- "But as it is, Christ has acquired a [priestly] ministry which is more excellent [than the old Levitical priestly ministry], for **He is the Mediator** (Arbiter) of a better covenant [uniting God and man], which has been enacted and rests on better promises. For if that first covenant had been faultless, there would have been no occasion for a second one or an attempt to institute another one [the new covenant]. (HEBREWS 8:6-7 AMP)
- When God speaks of "A new covenant," **He makes the first one obsolete**. And whatever is becoming obsolete (out of use, annulled) and growing old is ready to disappear." (HEBREWS 8:13 AMP)
- And so [because of the oath's greater strength and force] Jesus has become the certain
 guarantee of a better covenant [a more excellent and more advantageous agreement; one that
 will never be replaced or annulled]. (Hebrews 7:22)
- For this reason **He is the Mediator and Negotiator of a new covenant** [that is, **an entirely new agreement uniting God and man**], so that those who have been called [by God] may receive [the fulfillment of] the promised eternal inheritance, since a death has taken place [as the payment] **which redeems them from the sins committed under the obsolete first covenant.** (Hebrews 9:15)
- and to **Jesus, the Mediator of a new covenant [uniting God and man]**, and to the sprinkled blood, which speaks [of mercy], a better and nobler and more gracious message than the blood of Abel [which cried out for vengeance]. (Hebrews 12:24)

The Sanhedrin clergy laity system **were** the priest-mediators between God and man, **until** Jesus replaced them, making that whole entire clergy system obsolete.

Highlights

- 1. There is only one Mediator between God and mankind, the Man Christ Jesus. (1 Tim 2:5)

Highlight Recap

We see that there is only one Mediator between God and man, and that is the new superior High Priest Christ Jesus, who mediates a far better covenant, and also unites God and man. It was God Who made the first covenant obsolete and out of use, and made Jesus to become a guarantee of a better covenant, **never to be replaced or annulled** (*by returning to another clergy system*). We see here the absolute establishment of a major transition for all of Gods people. This transition includes the annulment of the old mediated system and the new direct relationship system.

- God did make man to be like God with these heavenly standards.
- Before the fall, Adam administrated the naming of all the animals, and managed the garden.
- Jesus did reconcile mankind with God, and extended to all humanity His own empowerment keys to overcome many obstacles.
- Holy Spirit indwells anyone, who selects God's salvation offer of Jesus, to be like God, through adoption, tutoring, guidance, and empowerment.

How did God remove the sin so humanity could enter into Christianity?

- 'For our sake **He made Christ [virtually] to be sin Who knew no sin**, so that in and through Him we might become [endued with, viewed as being in, and examples of] the righteousness of God [what we ought to be, approved and acceptable and in right relationship with Him, by His goodness].' 2 Corinthians 5:21 AMPC
- God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.' 2 Corinthians 5:21 NLT
- 'God presented Christ as a sacrifice of atonement, through the shedding of his blood—to be received by faith. He did this to demonstrate his righteousness, because in his forbearance he had left the sins committed beforehand unpunished—he did it to demonstrate his righteousness at the present time, so as to be just and the one who justifies those who have faith in Jesus. 'Romans 3:25-26

Observation: As a sinner I can't be reconciled to God because God is inviolable. Inviolable is to be secure (impregnable) from any violation, including any form of sin, symptom, temptation, etc. God knew this, and saw the law had failed mankind, so He sent Jesus as the Pascal Lamb to absorb our sin, on our behalf (individually and collectively), to remove the sin barrier so all could easily be reconciled to God alone. God made man to be like Him, but sin got in the way.

Now that Jesus took away that impediment (sin), we're all capable of entering into Christianity at our own discretion.

How God Applied His Righteousness to His Saints?

- "I have been crucified with Christ [in Him I have shared His crucifixion]; **it is no longer I who live, but Christ (the Messiah) lives in me;** and the life I now live in the body I live by faith in (by adherence to and reliance on and complete trust in) the Son of God, Who loved me and gave Himself up for me." Galatians 2:20 AMPC
- "For [as far as this world is concerned] you have died, and your [new, real] life is hidden with Christ in God." Colossians 3:3 AMPC
- We know that **our old self was crucified with Him** so that the body of sin might be rendered powerless, that we should no longer be slaves to sin. Romans 6:6
- But if Christ is in you, **your body is dead because of sin**, yet the Spirit gives you life because of righteousness. Romans 8:20
- "For in Christ lives all the fullness of God in a human body. So you also are complete through your union with Christ, who is the head over every ruler and authority. When you came to Christ, you were "circumcised," but not by a physical procedure. Christ performed a spiritual circumcision—the cutting away of your sinful nature. For you were buried with Christ when you were baptized. And with him you were raised to new life because you trusted the mighty power of God, who raised Christ from the dead. You were dead because of your sins and because your sinful nature was not yet cut away. Then God made you alive with Christ, for he forgave all our sins. He canceled the record of the charges against us and took it away by nailing it to the cross. In this way, he disarmed the spiritual rulers and authorities. He shamed them publicly by his victory over them on the cross." Colossians 2:9-15 NLT

Observation: As we select to enter into Christianity we see that we enter into a new life. This new life reflects the characteristics God has had for us all along (since Pentecost), if we'd have known about this and were able to activate it. We've been grafted into Jesus, His death, His resurrection, and therefore His new life. What has changed is that now we have died to sin, our old sin nature, and have developed into His divine nature. That is why we see things differently, we react to things differently. It is because of the heavenly standards we're operating in now.

God's Adoption Effect

There is an absolute effect that takes place upon every adoption. Our new life in Christ has been compared to the adoption process, so in order to understand more of the ramification we should review these dynamics as well. There is an effect from exiting humanity and entering Christianity. The Apostle John identifies this as one who stops sinning.

- So you too must count yourselves dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus. Romans 6:11
- Certainly not! How can we who died to sin live in it any longer? Romans 6:2
- If you have died with Christ to the spiritual forces of the world, why, as though you still belonged to the world, do you submit to its regulations: Colossians 2:20
- "Anyone who continues to live in him will not sin. But anyone who keeps on sinning does not know him or understand who he is. Dear children, don't let anyone deceive you about this: When people do what is right, it shows that they are righteous, even as Christ is righteous. But when people keep on

sinning, it shows that they belong to the devil, who has been sinning since the beginning. But the Son of God came to destroy the works of the devil. **Those who have been born into God's family do not make a practice of sinning, because God's life is in them**. So they can't keep on sinning, because they are children of God. **So now we can tell who are children of God and who are children of the devil**. Anyone who does not live righteously and does not love other believers does not belong to God." I John 3:6-10 NLT

Barrier & Blockage Removal

God made it easy for humanity by sending Jesus to earth. Jesus came to earth to generate a new divine nature heavenly standard for all humanity to enter into, at their own free will discretion. Once here, Jesus had to remove three big barriers that blocked humanity from a direct relationship with God. Up to this point only a few prophets had broken through to directly connect with God. Removing these blockages did ultimately benefit mankind greatly. In order for a Godly reconciliation to operate directly the three big "S" blockages had to be removed:

- 1. **Sin**: it need to be removed as a barrier because it block God from directly accessing people, so God now indwells His children who select Jesus and His authentic gospel model.
- 2. **Satan**: he needed to be dealt with after usurping mankind under him when he deceived Adam and Eve in the garden. Satan forfeited all his power and authority to Jesus and His disciples.
- 3. **Sanhedrin**: it needed to be discarded so Jesus eliminated the clergy system that acted as a mediator between God and man so now God could directly connect to each person.

Jesus Christ has removed all of sin blockages, has destroyed Satan's works, and has discarded the Sanhedrin clergy laity system. These are much more detailed in the Book "<u>FINISHED</u>".

Please recognize that God sent Jesus:

- 1. to remove the sin blockages that caused a barrier between God and man
- 2. to destroy Satan's works of how he added sin to Adam and Eve, usurping control over humanity
- 3. to discard the Sanhedrin system, as mediators between God and man, and replace it with Jesus, as only mediator, and Holy Spirit to baptize each with the baptism of fire.

Jesus should be identified as the greatest humanitarian advocate ever, as the Messiah, and as the savior of humanity.

Heavenly Standards

When you think of heavenly standards what does this connote or suggest to you? What expectations will we have when we reach heaven?

- 1. Peace or War
- 2. Love or Hate
- 3. Tranquility or Turmoil
- 4. Rich or Poor

- 5. Health or Sickness
- 6. Grace (favor) or Law (wrath, sin)
- 7. Direct or Mediated
- 8. Superior or Inferior

If you picked the first options you'd be right. These are great standards and we know they exist in heaven, hence heavenly standards. Notice that war, hatred, turmoil, poverty, sickness, or legalistic mediated practices are not part of the heavenly standards, and by implication are not part of Jesus' original Christianity model that saints have their earthly existence in. You may have noticed some slight variations of these attributes in denominational theology. We need to establish what God's heavenly standards are, in order to develop the proper expectations, to persevere for a breakthrough to His absolute effect!

Heavenly Standards, on earth as it is in heaven

- 1. Grace (God's favor)
- 2. We're Accepted
- 3. Love, Joy & Fun
- 4. Body and Soul Health
- 5. Adopted in Family
- 6. Prosperity (funded)
- 7. Peaceful
- 8. Perfection
- 9. Purity
- 10. Regenerated

- 11. Completeness (in Christ)
- 12. Supremacy (over evil)
- 13. Inviolableness
- 14. Tranquility
- 15. Directly connected

What Does God Really Want?

God is looking for people who are after His heart, who are loyal to Him, hungry for Him, and who want to join Him in changing them self first, in order to change the world. That is why He sent Jesus, to reconcile humanity to Him, so anyone can enter in! By joining Jesus, and embracing the adoption of Holy Spirit, these grafting effects begin to enlighten us and our environment.

Jesus' Heavenly Standards:

- 1. Eternal life in God, a new DNA from Adam to Jesus
- 2. Direct relationship with God, adopted into God's family with benefits
- 3. Restored peace, innocence, health, and provision

Jesus came to earth to offer these standard benefits. How can we access heavenly standard benefits on earth? First embrace these Heavenly Standards, and second extend to others the same access to enter in and apply these to their own lives.

Exiting humanity and entering into an experiential form of Christianity is what Jesus modeled and bestowed upon everyone. Like anything else, if we're unaware of this we cannot access it. So becoming aware of Jesus' standards and how to access them, here on earth, is important.

Affecting Earth With Heavenly Standards

Jesus came from heaven to earth, with attributes such as purity, perfection, completeness, supremacy, and inviolableness, to introduce a new form of life built on these absolute heavenly standards. His level of superiority was so far above everyone else, but few recognized it. He affected many people by bestowing upon them these standards, then He bestowed these keys to His followers to do the same.

Out of the Absolutes that Jesus effectively ushered in we see peace, love, tranquility, rich supply of resources, health and healing, and grace with God's favor for each of us.

God made man to be like Him, and within His standards. Jesus delivered the open door for anyone to enter in to become more Godly. God wants our heart and Jesus has reconciled us to Him, and removed all blockages, withholding us from giving Him our heart. Bypassing awareness and restricting access is blocking these benefits. Initiating meditation practices, like Jesus, embellishes possibility and probability of breakthrough, favor and benefits.

By selecting Jesus as Savior we exit humanity and enter into Christianity, a brand new form of life and lifestyle. As we pursue discipleship, we get to know Holy Spirit, learn Jesus' teachings, develop and then bestow grace and gifts upon humanity, like Jesus did. Affecting earth with heavenly standards is available for every saint.

ABC's of Jesus' Heavenly Standards

A. God sent Jesus

- 1. God sent Jesus from heaven to earth to intervene for a failed humanity
- 2. Jesus and God are one, are absolute, and deployed a new strategy
- 3. Jesus willingly died to absorbed all sin that intervened for all mankind
- 4. Jesus removed clergy mediated system
- 5. Jesus broke all Satan's power and reversed his annexation of mankind
- 6. Jesus released Holy Spirit from quarantine
- 7. Jesus established Holy Spirit as His earthly replacement

B. Jesus created something new

- 1. Jesus created a new form of humanity
- 2. Jesus reconciled God to man & man to God directly, without OT mediation or covering
- 3. Jesus, God, and saints are at one in unity
- 4. Saints start living eternal life at salvation because they cross over from death to life
- 5. Saints are handed Jesus keys to heaven
- 6. Saints are adopted, tutored, guided by Holy Spirit, mental renewal (to catch up with their newly created spirit)
- 7. Saints (new branches) are grafted into Jesus Christ (the vine of true life)

C. Saints practice something new

- 1. **Personal**: Saints practice living with power of Holy Spirit, shifting from carnal to divine nature Gal 5:16-26 & 2 Pet 1:3-8
- 2. Corporate: Saints practice corporate synergistic fellowship in 1 Cor 14:26 model
- 3. **Doer**: Saints become doers (overcoming sin), James 1:22-25
- 4. Fruitfulness: Saints produce fruit of the Spirit
- 5. Workmanship: Saints begin doing works (natural & super) Matt 10:1, 8 & 25: 31-46
- 6. **Bestowment**: Saints bestow gifts of the Spirit
- 7. Sanctuary: Saints offer sanctuary to mankind and reconcile all people to God

Relevancy Heavenly Standard Factors

- 1. Jesus came from heaven and brought heavenly standards to earth for all humanity
- 2. Jesus absorbed sin and discarded OT system so heavenly standards could be imputed into society
- 3. Jesus created a One New Man Model for saints to join Him and God, to be in unity with God, for these heavenly standards to work
- 4. Jesus gave saints His keys to heaven, to exert enforcement of heavenly standards
- 5. Jesus aligned saints with Holy Spirit to edify, deploy, and empower heavenly standards

Jesus' Authentic Christianity Model

Out of Himself, Jesus created Christianity, to replace humanity, for everyone to enter in, and join Him in reconciling everyone to God. As one enters, each experiences significant changes in their spiritual DNA, identity and status. Jesus has already mediated this new life model and Holy Spirit's indwelling transmits and transfers God's new temple model standards.

Jesus' Authentic Christianity Model Autonomic Change Factors

IDENTITY	From Sinner (carnal nature, lost, unregenerate)	To Saint (divine nature, unified with God)
DNA	From Humanity (Adam rooted, sin stained)	To Christianity (Jesus rooted, grace saved)
STATUS	From death (no Holy Spirit, orphaned, outsider)	To Life (Holy Spirit baptized, adopt, insider)

How did God make it so easy? God automated this spiritual regeneration for each of us, upon our own free will activation. Since Jesus removed the sin barrier and Holy Spirit is out of quarantine, God has done His part to rescue everyone from the failed humanity model and the ineffective humanitarian efforts to remodel mankind. Now, by our own choice, we can exit humanity and its paraphernalia, and enter into Jesus' authentic Christianity. **JUST SIMPLY ENTER IN!**

Autonomic Factors

These factors are automatic so <u>they're activated involuntarily by an autonomic</u> spiritual system. Disciples do see these effects mature and become effective <u>as free will discipline and training are embraced</u>. Remember these were set in motion by Jesus for His authentic model and are currently <u>conveyed by Holy Spirit</u>. If one doesn't experience these please recalibrate your relationship with Holy Spirit ASAP. *You can't buy these because they're caught, not bought!*

Exerting effort is good and can be effective for results. In denominational religion there are a lot of rules that apply as chronic contingencies to benefit potentials. These contingencies can deny the birthright benefits to saints, as the new temple of God. Because churches mandate meeting attendance, submission to leadership (under another person who acts as a mediator between God and them) and compulsory activities, these edicts are in direct conflict with Jesus' model.

However, in authentic Christianity a person enters into Jesus, then Holy Spirit simultaneously begins indwelling them. It's automatic! Then if the person embraces the baptism of fire, the same baptism Jesus experienced and then set up for Pentecost, they've initiated adoption. Adoption repositions saints inside, part of the family, where private tutoring is bestowed. No need for a mediator, meetings, or compulsive agendas when you already crossed over from death to life. Fellowship meetings are good, and Jesus said that where two or three are gather He'd be there. The Apostle Paul reported fellowship outlines in 1 Corinthians 14:26. Adoption brings many autonomic characteristics to those who are aware and embrace them. Freely, we select or deny. Godly automatic characteristics prompted by Holy Spirit's indwelling:

- 1. Sinner to Saint
- 2. Carnality to Divinity
- 3. Death to Life
- 4. Orphaned to Adopted
- 5. Deceived to Enlightened

- 6. Mortality to Immortality
- 7. Outsider to Insider
- 8. Wide to Narrow Road
- 9. Adams root to Jesus' root
- 10. Unregenerate to Regenerated

We can all select to work at these characteristics and try to appropriate them on our own, or just join Jesus, in His new model, where the adoption process can begin to manifest God's characteristics within our self. We've witnessed very few who were able to acquire them instantly. As we initiate class time with Holy Spirit, His instruction brings intermittent breakthroughs and new benchmarks that reposition our ability to see, hear, and understand things. As you can imagine, when an orphan is adopted, it's usually a major upgrade. These above beneficial attributes would fit into a major upgrade status. Now everyone can begin living their eternal life, abundantly wherever they are located!

Transformational Factors Effecting Each Salvation

- 1. New Identity:
 - DNA; from Adam (humanity) to Jesus (now spiritually saved and rooted in Christianity) so by exiting humanity we enter into Christianity, which is Jesus' new model.
 - by entering in, we shift our identity from sinner to saint
 - illumination exposes carnality (carnal nature) & revelation inspires divinity (divine nature)
 - sinners are orphaned, lost and unregenerate, but saints are adopted and unified with God
 - Humanity breads death, no Holy Spirit, outsider, Jesus brought life, Holy Spirit baptism, adoption and an insider status.
- 2. Heavenly Standards: now directly connected, <u>as the new temple model</u>, saints are baptized by fire with illumination, revelation and inspiration to overcome temptations, override symptoms and overrule circumstances. We were originally made to be like God. Jesus cleared the sin obstacles for us to enter in. Holy Spirit imparts and empowers new model standards. *God made it easy, Jesus made it happen and Holy Spirit makes it work!*

"Baked In"

"It's just baked into the cake!"

What is embedded into each authentic Christian conversion?

Jesus Explains

Jesus answers disciples and us today with, "Do you finally believe? In fact, you're about to make a run for it—saving your own skins and abandoning me. But I'm not abandoned. The Father is with me. I've told you all this so that trusting me, **you will be unshakable and assured, deeply at peace**. In this godless world you will continue to experience difficulties, tribulations, trials, distress and frustration. But take heart! **I've conquered the world**. You see <u>I have deprived it of</u> its power to harm you and have conquered it for you." (Based on John 16:31-33)

Since Jesus has conquered the world for us, and has given us His own Keys, and aligned us with His very own tutor, the onus is now on us to enter in and abide to benefit.

Revelations of Many Baked-In Attributes

The more I learn about Jesus authentic Christianity attributes the more I realize how much I've missed and that I need recalibration. After 14 years of Catholic education, and over 30 years of Christian volunteer ministry witnessing hundreds of phenomenal healings and miracles, I realized I'm still not on the Narrow Road, but only on the road's shoulder. I was convicted of this

after a short meditation where Holy Spirit began illuminating these things to me. He revealed that Jesus' 40 day desert prayer, fast and recalibration time wasn't just for symbolism, or theoretical non-practicality. It is to be followed, by His disciples, for His Narrow Road entry, where carnality is replaced by divinity and heavenly standards are instilled. Since I missed this I'm initiating a new agenda to comply and recalibrate. Even with the significant experiences I've been blessed to witness I've had to face it that the residual carnal effect of my "personal baggage" is still very capable of producing negative results, like bad thoughts or blockages. I'm tired of that and I'm also sick of any self-sanctioning of artificial standards debasing what Jesus has delivered to me to become an overcomer. Double-mindedness is costly.

Listening, like endearment, requires intentionality. When we initiate a hearing time, our faith is being built because faith comes by hearing. Holy Spirit represents Jesus and teaches us all things that Jesus taught. Everyone who is faithful to listen and obey what Holy Spirit says will overcome sin, will overrule symptoms and will override circumstances, like Jesus did. Jesustype results are already "baked in", that is, into the DNA of the authentic Christianity model, because God already imbedded divinity into saints through the indwelling of Holy Spirit (same one that filled Jesus). This, in itself, shifts our identity from carnal nature to divine nature, from sinner to saint, and from natural man to both natural and supernatural man. Remember saints are indwelled with Holy Spirit Who isn't limited to humanity's boundaries, but unlimited! Once we use our free will to become aware and stop resisting the Narrow Road Model, a breakthrough is more possible. So saints have to learn new potentials, skills and characteristics, which is why hearing Holy Spirit becomes eminent. The results are only as good as we activate personal meditation, study, abiding, hearing and obeying. In knowing this now, we should increase our expectations, learn to exert enforcement of heavenly standards, and hopefully improve our results!

Embedded Defined

To embed is to securely fix firmly and deeply into a surrounding solid mass. To implant is to establish securely, as in the mind or consciousness; to instill. In the case of the indwelling both of these terms explore and explain how Holy Spirit has been firmly fixed within each saint, establishing and instilling a divine nature and also heavenly standards. This is why I use the term "baked in", because it expresses how conversion effects us. There are actual characteristics that are introduced into each saint at every salvation conversion, because Holy Spirit has His own "process". Every relationship effects the other. Friends, associates, and athletes all effect their teams and team members. We see this most interestingly upon people during dating and early marriage. So when we're saved and indwelled by Holy Spirit His persona will effect those He relates to. "It's just baked in"! So what should we be aware of and what expectations should we have concerning these new characteristics? Let's take a look!

Embedded Characteristics

Have you ever thought of what characteristics Holy Spirit brings into every conversion to potentially embed into each saint? This should be interesting for everyone. Being God almighty, the list is endless, so let's focus on the major items we know about. Eternal life, peace, comfort, endearment (listens to us), enlightenment (teaches us), empowers us as well. It's been recorded

that Holy Spirit illuminates (breaks all darkness exposing error), reveals (identifies areas needing focus), inspires (guides us to help others). So our proximity to Him is important because it has a direct bearing on being filled without measure, and also upon our ability to replicate Jesus' greater works. Because Jesus made Holy Spirit a priority we'd be wise to follow. Objectively, if our results aren't in alignment with Jesus' does that reveal we need to get closer to Holy Spirit? Logically yes, unless there is another empowerment source (but there isn't!).

Into each authentic Christian conversion Holy Spirit is embedded with:

- 1. Exiting carnality and entering to divinity, how God makes us to be like Him
- 2. Illumination which removes darkness so we can see our issues
- 3. **Revelation** which informs us how we can deal with our issues
- 4. **Inspiration** which can influence us to overcome our issues
- 5. **Solutions** to each problem and answers to each question

Targets For Breakthrough

So what do we target to breakthrough to these new characteristics and benefits? Initiating a quiet time to hear Holy Spirit is eminent to hear Him. In meditation if we'd learn stop thinking and open up to allowing Him to illuminate, then we'd be able to see what needs exposure, and is holding us back. So our early target is getting quiet before Him, and wipe our thoughts clean. We want to hear and see His comfort, peace, illumination, enlightenment, and guidance (interpretation and instruction). Remember that the saints were in the upper room for a period of time, waiting, before Holy Spirit baptized them with fire.

These key revelations aren't built-in or baked in, but may need some attention for each key point to become activated and help us produce better results:

Key #1

Peter told Jesus they didn't have any other place to go, accept to Him, Jesus. Since He is in heaven, today's disciples have no place to go, accept to Holy Spirit. Getting the revelation that Holy Spirit is God's promise and is primary (before the bible and the church), and it should reposition our respect for Him. Only Holy Spirit is sufficient and the promise of God, as well the One Who derives and sustains every cell in the universe. The bible and church, as good as they are, cannot replace Holy Spirit, because they're both completely insufficient. This epiphany should raise the importance of the baptism of Holy Spirit for every saint.

Key #2

Another key is to <u>learn to control our deeds</u>, <u>words and thoughts</u>. In order to do that we must first control our thoughts. The byproduct of that is we'll develop a filter for what our mouth produces. This shift into fewer words and more endearment is usually immediately recognized by family, associates, etc..

The purpose is to open up opportunity for new illumination to expose error and new revelation to deliver solutions. In an overcrowded thought life we're not getting any solutions or revelation,

because we've resisted and quenched Holy Spirit. Now do you see why clearing our thoughts and respectfully waiting on Holy Spirit will embrace His manifest presence? This is a key turning point for all who really seek to "catch" what they can from God. You'll never be sorry for getting closer to Holy Spirit.

Key #3

We're all "cramming for finals", so everyone who believes does get to be saved! Not everyone who is saved will select the same model to practice. Not everyone gets baptized into authentic Christianity. There are many denominational models that have revised the original gospel model to fit their agenda. All saints are designed to be at one with God, and to be like God. This is how God originally made us to be, but we need an individual initated activation with sincere solitary prayer and meditation. Disregarding this one key debases the Narrow Road potential. Until we make it our business to connect directly with Holy Spirit to transition from the carnal to the divine nature we're going to allow for carnality to resist, delay and block the benefits of divinity. After salvation, this should be our #1 priority, to connect for personal tutorial times with Holy Spirit. Everyone can grow in so many denominational (synthetic) versions of church, but without abiding in Jesus and an authentic baptism in Holy Spirit the Narrow Road potential is obstructed and shut off because only Holy Spirit generates the infilling. Each model has it's own imminent effect, and usually unfolds as their history has recorded. So the original authentic Pentecostal baptism of Holy Spirit is the only functional pathway to the Narrow Road, or Jesus wouldn't have continually instructed it, placing the onus on each student to increase their effort.

Breakthrough Benefits:

- 1. Peace, comfort and counsel of Holy Spirit
- 2. Shifting out of carnality and into our divine nature
- 3. Illumination and enlightenment
- 4. Inspiration and empowerment
- 5. Answers, solutions, guidance (to advance and avoid pitfalls)

In Authentic Christianity

Our Body

is cellularly impacted by Holy Spirit bringing life into our mortal flesh

Our Soul

(mind & emotions) are impacted by Holy Spirit's illumination and enlightenment

Our Spirit

is now imbedded into Jesus' roots, unified with His throne & citizenship

Breakthrough Impediments

Free Will is free will, and until it is activated nothing ever happens! All saints have a student-teacher relationship with Holy Spirit. It's been reported by teachers that when they're putting forth more effort than the student then the student isn't trying hard enough, and the teacher knows they can't learn for them. So too, Holy Spirit knows who is "dogging it" and who is attentive. Spoon feeders need religious pulpit teaching, meetings, acceptance and maybe need to be indulged in pampering. Self-feeders have grown enough to read and meditate alone, continuously planting and fertilizing God's teachings where He makes them grow. Mature saints will pick up the cross and dedicate them-self to God's agenda for their life, where they are in the growth cycle, not in someone else expectations or requirements. Jesus modeled this for us and God waited until He was ready to initiate the New



Testament. So our growth cycle is important and should be respected, then when we're ready we can share the gospel, and bestow God's grace and gifts. As we introduce others to Holy Spirit, we leave it there, and when they're ready they'll "begin to drink", or in this case activate some level of awareness and abiding. Helping others into the classroom is as far as we can go. We're always available for support, listening, helping clarify and fellowship, try to teach where possible, but with the motive to always get all saints to embrace their personal Tudor, Holy Spirit because we are limited but the unlimited only comes from the One Who is unlimited!

Logically, the more we make Holy Spirit a top priority, and the more we initiate individual "class time", the more illumination and revelational benefits we'll be getting. This application is only activated though individual free will initiation.

If you must be a human, and live on earth, then authentic Christianity is the best way. Being at one with God and benefiting from His omniscience and omnipotence changes our perspectives on almost all issues. This is what is "baked in", and it should be given time to think about, and appreciate what Jesus produced for each of us.

Being able to replicate Jesus' works, upon your own free will (when a need arises), through endearment, enlightenment and empowerment from Holy Spirit is phenomenal, and sets us up for personal ministry opportunity. In Jesus authentic Christianity model there is no lack and life is never boring. It's just a superior way of living.

Holy Spirit's absolute empowerment will:

- 1. Exert enforcement of heavenly standards
- 2. Bind all the works of the enemy
- 3. Loose all the divine nature benefits
- 4. Call into being things that are not, as though they were
- 5. Stop rain storms, wind, etc.

So you say what if this doesn't happen?

- 1. God is no respecter of persons and Gods hears those who are His, all who sincerely embrace Him and the model Jesus provided to humanity
- 2. God must respond because He can not deny Himself or His people that He is indwelling
- 3. Humility and perseverance guarantees God's response, and that saints won't fail (1 Peter 2)

"Baked In" Conclusion

Understanding that Holy Spirit, with His characteristics, have been included into our salvation experience and embedded into it, should be an awakening. Because we saints are at one with God He hears us, and also because we're at one with God and are planting and fertilizing the seeds, God will make them grow. It doesn't matter if our prayers are for sinners to get saved, sick to get healed, food to grow and multiply, provision, or any other circumstances. All circumstances are always subject to God, and since we're technically (those who've selected Jesus) at one with Him, all these circumstances should be subject to us too! Awakening to these truths will build our awareness, acknowledgment, activation and to abide. It takes time. "Baked in" is a very interesting revelation, it's exciting, and it's biblical, truthful, and useful.

Affirmations to repeat that will help us shift:

- 1. Jesus, thank you for paying for my sin and canceling my debt so I can enter right in
- 2. I'm now out of Adam's humanity root and my new spiritual DNA is rooted in Jesus Christ
- 3. I've changed my identity from a carnal sinner to divine natured saint
- 4. My status is changed from death and orphaned to life and adopted
- 5. I am God's new temple model as I've been baptized by Holy Spirit, just like Jesus was.


The Only Real Solution

The only real solution to humanity's problems is Authentic Christianity, life for today, tomorrow and forever, where we've been completed in Jesus and we're being regenerated by Holy Spirit!

HOLY SPIRIT MAKES IT WORK

Holy Spirit makes it work by His indwelling and infilling. Holy Spirit was primary with Jesus and He is primary with all saints. Jesus and Holy Spirit set the agenda for Christianity through baptism. Jesus then modeled it. After the resurrection He sent His disciples to be baptized in the upper room. He wants His followers to duplicate His works, abide and remain in Him, and to hold fast until He returns. All New Testament applications are based on the indwelling of Holy Spirit. This is primary.

- 1. Holy Spirit makes it work by **indwelling** all the new temples, which are all saints who enter in.
- 2. Holy Spirit makes it work by **transmitting** enlightenment and empowerment
- 3. Holy Spirit makes it work by **representing** Jesus on earth as His representative
- 4. Holy Spirit makes it work by **helping** us mortify, purify, rectify and edify, classroom sessions bring revelation lessons.
- 5. Holy Spirit makes it work by **directing** us, inspiration, to fulfill out earthly destiny.



Absolute Effect Cycles

Reciprocal Reactions

Upon entering into Jesus' original authentic Gospel model there are certain reactions to each of us that do occur upon our entrance into authentic Christianity (what Jesus delivered at Pentecost)

- 1. Whenever we enter into God and He enters into us there is a spiritual reaction
- 2. God's entry impacts each human with:
 - a) Illumination, exposing darkness, issues, sinful thoughts, words, deeds
 - b) God's heavenly standards, recalibration our spiritual equilibrium

Modifying Sin Isn't Acceptable

Sin isn't modified upon kingdom entry, it is vanquished (destroyed). Each person attempting to enter into God's kingdom willingly carrying sin, and sinful activity or supporting such is expelled, like the demons were from heaven, and Adam and Eve were from God's garden. By nursing sin along we're resisting the absolute effect of Jesus' absorption of our sin. It does take time to recalibrate our thoughts, our vocabulary, and our values that drive our deeds. It may take years. But as long as Holy Spirit is indwelling us illumination will keep exposing deeper things that need expulsion and enlightening better things that need to be embraced.

Don't be coddled in your own sin. Be vigilant to join Jesus and Holy Spirit to vaporize it, so you can make room for the Godly attributes available to enlighten and empower your own destiny. **Either we're getting reciprocal reactions or we're not!** Where is your own "line" that alerts warnings upon crossing it? This line should be determining which road your on, wide or narrow. If you haven't established your own "line in the sand" yet then you have to ask yourself how serious you are in entering in and maintaining your authentic Christianity relationship. These boundaries impact both of our eternal life status and our abundant life potential.

The synthetic format being portrayed today as a legitimate version of Christ's church is a counterfeit at best. Only when people enter into Jesus' authentic model can they be baptized by fire and indwelled by Holy Spirit. After witnessing so many versions and so many modifications of Christianity, over 50,000, humanity has experienced enough, and now people want the real thing.

Regarding salvation, is there supposed to be any kind of an effect? Should people, as they exit sinful humanity and enter perfect Christianity, where they're entering into Christ's created position for them be effected somehow? If there is supposed to be an effect, what expectations should we have? Keep in mind that if we don't have any expectations for God's sozo effect, then why would we look forward to discipleship?

The Kingdom of God begins in the inner life, where it is discovered and developed, ... then it flows outward!

There have been reports of olden times when people would wait on God for hours and hours, in order for them to feel like they were "being saved". Some waited days. They may have been waiting on a breakthrough, without knowing it, or they had the right idea of a truly retentive salvation. Either way, they were effected by God toward holiness and sin was something of the past, so nobody had to nurse them along in heir old habits. That's the point. Their old habits vaporized, and they established new habits. Some say this is their new identity in Christ. If we're kept so busy changing dirty diapers of bad attitudes and sinful behavior, and being sensitive to a sinner mentality, how can we ever get to real edification? As long as sin continues to adjust our agenda, it's unlikely we'll succeed. Only by recognizing what separates us from God, sin, and learning how to avoid and overcome it, will we be establishing ourself as Jesus' followers. For some of us it's a shock to see how awful we were, but to whom much is forgiven, much is really grateful.

None of us ever deserve to be saved. It's God's mercy to include us into His kingdom. I had to do a lot of renouncing after reading the those sins that separated, the filthy 50. And I knew there was

so much more on earth for us to do, and I was looking forward to fulfilling my personal destiny, and helping others do the same. I never wanted to go back.

An Inner Change

Should their be an absolute effect upon each person, as they enter Christianity? We've seen that it is God's will to exercise shifts in our makeup as we're adopted. What do you think are **the factors** that facilitate and inner change and validate salvation?

Metanoia Defined

Metanoia is a fundamental change in one's beliefs, effecting personal character and outlook, due to a repentance. This reflects a conversion, rebirth, and a regeneration that has taken place in the heart of the person. These are obvious to those who know the person. Something, outside the person, has entered in to affect them.

Metanoia Applied

When a person enters into authentic Christianity, God enters into them. **God's enlightenment exposes and reduces darknesses effects, and reveals new truths.** In these new truths knowledge is developed and beliefs begin. It's out of new beliefs that our personal character shifts. God is the outside factor effecting metanoia, when authentic entrance happens.

When this happens, people don't need prompting, prodding, or pulling. They're at one with God, are in good hands, and should be encouraged to continue with God, to develop and see what their destiny is. This Metanoia shouldn't be diminished or replaced, but honored. Metanoia is internally driven, usually spiritually, so that **the deriving source needs to be sustained** (honored) for potential benefits to ensue.

Inimitable Defined

Inimitable means unique and beyond imitation and it is impossible to duplicate or copy. The absolute effect is inimitable, is always original, and is influenced and empowered by God. When we enter into Jesus, God enters into us. This is how we both witness and access the absolute effect, the authentic experiential model Jesus provided us.

As any person begins to know their identity in Christ, then overcoming temptations and symptoms will ensue

Success is usually operating in a narrow range, within a single standard. Saints are born into this, and then regenerate their own personal standards to be in compliance with God's standards. If it weren't for double-standards sinners wouldn't have any standards. Double-standards are characteristics of the wide road of destruction, failure and rebellion.

Successfully overcoming symptoms and temptations is accomplished by first being able to identify them, then executing tactics to avoid, deflect, or destroy them. Our first line of defense is to able to identify what entities are in conflict with heavenly standards. These would be the items Jesus and Paul have identified, that keep a person out of the kingdom of God. I call them the filthy 50, or the dirty dozen. Our second line of defense is to know, unequivocally, who we are, in Christ. This is essential to success. As any person begins to know their identity in Christ, then

overcoming temptations can and will ensue. Managing risk and success has to do with the development of truth, in everything.

How does this "experience" work? There are three bases to cover for every Godly attribute and characteristic. First is awareness, then acknowledgement, then activation. Once we've studied, internalized, and initiated these, we can begin to abide in them. It is always in the abiding that the benefits ensue. Abiding is the home plate where runs are scored and winning occurs! So far I've identified three distinct versions. Sozo, discipleship, and manifest presence cycles. All these cycles are off the coattails of what Jesus has produced, and our efforts are to renew our mind and recalibrate our identity and standards. Take a look at what they are and how they effect us.

Sozo Absolute Effect Cycle


Sözo is being saved, healed, delivered, and prospered. Jesus delivered and set these attributes in motion for every single person. They are all part of the authentic salvation experience, for all who are aware of this. There is also a synthetic version (another gospel) prayer "clause" that the church uses, that doesn't recognize these experiential factors. All saint must choose which one they want to pursue. How does this "experience" work?

Let's review "being saved", as an example, to exercise a subjective study.

- 1. **Aware**: Are we aware that salvation changes our identity from sinner to saint? What should be the impact from this upon our lives? Do I recognize that I am being adopted into God's family (spiritually speaking).
- 2. **Acknowledge**: Upon recognition of being a saint we begin to shift our thoughts. Noticing our new identity, granting its new standards, and embracing kingdom characteristics are part of the renewing process, upgrading us and recalibrating our thinking.
- 3. **Activate**: This shifts our behavior toward our new identity. Knowing new truths is good but activating them by recognizing temptations and symptoms and overcoming them on ourself and others is how we activate our faith, in Christ and empowered by Holy Spirit.
- 4. **Abide**: As we abide in Jesus' teachings, from our acknowledgement and activation, God's favor can begin to ensue. Biblically, it is is reported that it is in the abiding, not the others that benefits are derived. When we think of the favor God can place on our lives, the direction He can give, and the solutions He can deliver, out of His omniscience, it makes good sense to abide.

What Effects What?

Are their demonstrative factor effects of entering in? If so, what are they? Because we've entered into God, He's entered into us. God affects people, people don't affect God. You see God made man to be like Him. But God also gave man a free will to exercise, in saying yes or no, if they want to be like God, or not. So that leaves each of us responsible, to generate a free will activation to enter into that integration level. If we do, when God does enter in significant effects ensue, because God upgrades everything to His heavenly standards. This is verifiable, can be evaluated, and can be validated through our own heart, senses, outlook, and our behavior. Heavenly standards reflect a Narrow Road pathway Jesus refers to, a



divine nature empowered by Holy Spirit, instead of carnality, and are well documented by Jesus and the Apostles. When heavenly standards take precedence, then illumination and revelation begin to enlighten. We're either embracing God's standards and becoming stronger, closer to godliness, or we're delaying, denying His standards, distancing oneself from godliness. It's one or the other. We're all subject to this!

It is out of this enlightenment that a change in one's beliefs becomes apparent, effecting our personal character and outlook. This is often reflected on as a conversion, a rebirth, and a regeneration of that person. God does transform people's lives. We see His standards begin to take priority. So when worldly standards replace them we know it isn't God living there anymore because he doesn't change, and each persons free will continues to reflect which standards they're subscribing to. This is clear to those who have eyes to see.

Entering into authentic Christianity is extremely effective, and it doesn't allow for impure practices, synthetic replacements, or false teaching. This is why it is personal, personally practiced, and kept as a treasure in our heart, protected. It isn't simulated (imitated) either. It is either authentic or it isn't. The reason why this inner life change and effect is so important is to establish that all authentic Christian discipleship is based on it too. Yes, it is God who illuminates, reveals truth, and inspires us to go and do good works. So when we speak, our words are empowered by God. The more we're aware of the spiritual inner life effect God has on salvation, the more we'll be receptive to His discipleship development and direction.

THE BETTER WE ACCEPT THE SPIRITUAL INNER LIFE EFFECT THE MORE RECEPTIVE TO DISCIPLESHIP WE'LL BE!

If we don't recognize the authentic, and we stick to a synthetic format or denial, we'll suffer the consequences of our own choices. A direct validation of authentic salvation could be a self initiated discipleship effort. Actions speak louder than words sometime.

Inner Man Validation

The sozo effect is verifiable. The components to verify "being saved" are:

- 1. the initial characteristics of being a saint (not a sinner)
- 2. being the temple of God, being perfected (sanctified) because we're indwelled by Holy Spirit
- 3. having a new divine nature, operating from Jesus' heavenly standards model

These are done by God, as one enters into Jesus. <u>Link to God's will factors</u>. Remember it is God's will to be at one with His children. If we're "fudging" on these, we need to recalibrate our thinking or our salvation. If we're in the kingdom of God, we're a saint, we're the temple of God, and we're operating in divinity, God's divine nature for Christianity. You can't expect Holy Spirit to maintain a visitation or a habitation with a sinner, or an unbeliever, or the double-minded. Validating these components are <u>essential</u> toward the goal of eternal and abundant life.

Validating Salvation Effect Factors

There seems to be misleading information that disregards many of the factors Jesus and Paul reported for kingdom entrance. If these factors can identify important components to help us succeed, we should be aware of them. God has heavenly standards that Jesus delivered to earth, and Holy Spirit delivers to each saint to comply with. As we enter into Jesus authentic Christianity those standards are exposed and illuminated. If and when we reject these standards and return to a sinful lifestyle, Holy Spirit will vacate our dwelling, ostensibly severing our life with God, now and eternally. Sin separates man from God. This is an accounting of facts that can help us. If these facts are inadmissible (not allowed to be reviewed), for a complete evaluation, to get to the truth of the matter, then the truth is restricted. That leaves us with unsubstantiated data and fabricated propaganda. This is what Jesus warned against, and called it building on sand.

Are there factors that validate if we've crossed over from death and wrath to eternal life, from sinner to saint, and from carnal to divine? *If there are observable validations I'd like to know what they are.* I'd like to discern if my own salvation really took root. What would those components be? All seeds that take root, do grow, and produce fruit. Here is a short list of ten items, that I've observed, to help us to identify some biblical salvation components that could ensure we're on track with this goal. Building our spiritual esteem is important.

SOZO SELF-EVALUATION & VALIDATION COMPONENTS

- 1. **Believe** in my heart and confess with my mouth that Jesus is Lord
- 2. **Initiating** a secret time alone with Holy Spirit, for fellowship, learn, edify
- 3. **Becoming** a self feeder (reading the Bible on my own), not just a spoon fed baby
- 4. **Identifying** and overcoming sin, especially past life bad behavioral choices
- 5. The **activation** of the nine fruits of the spirit
- 6. **Trying** to find your earthly destiny and prepare to

- deploy that
- 7. **Practicing** the six things that separate the sheep from the goats
- 8. Carrying one another's burdens, actually fulfilling the law of Christ
- 9. **Building** your life on the divine nature, solid rock, Narrow Road
- 10. **Praying**, fasting, and giving in secret, in anonymity and obscurity

These are the discernible factors that can be validated, that should lend comfort to saints and help them to ensure their salvation is intact, they've entered into God's kingdom, and they're building treasures in heaven. The purpose of reporting this is to identify biblically supported factors that do validate our salvation, and so some slick person can't swindle us into another model. We all need clarity on this issue, so these are some observations I'm documenting. I hope these succeed in helping us realize where we are in these cycles.

As opposed to positive validations, what are the discernible validations that ensure being severed from God's kingdom? See the filthy 50 in the <u>Pothole Series</u>. There is a difference between falling from grace, and overtly practicing sinful behavior. These are verses that address those who openly practice sin. They're not meant to judge, but to warn, to help us avoid.

Let's review "being healed", as another example, to exercise a subjective study.

- 1. **Aware**: Are we aware that being saved and being healed are both from the greek word sozo. So authentically if we are saved then we are healed as well. Just because we don't feel healed, or that we continue to house symptoms doesn't have anything to do with this. Those are residual "hitchhikers" that haven't been expelled yet. If we're operating in new heavenly standards, then the application of those standards can be applied in faith. What should be the impact from this upon our lives? We should be disabling symptoms, like Jesus did.
- 2. **Acknowledge**: Upon the recognition of being healed (as well as saved), and the additional recognition that symptoms must flee (James 4:7), we can begin to acknowledge the keys Jesus empowered us with. There are many verses that we want to acknowledge and study to recalibrate our thoughts on this subject.
- 3. **Activate**: Armed with these new truths we shift our behavior toward binding and loosing with Jesus' keys (Matt 16:19). Our new identity is victor, no longer victim. Just as Jesus evicted the demonic from heaven and earth, because we're in Him, we can do the same.
- 4. **Abide**: As we abide in Jesus' teachings, and as we speak His words, we plant seed. Those seeds can be words of encouragement to some, or words of direction or solutions, and binding and loosing to others. In salvation one of us may plant the seed, another of us my fertilize that seed, but it is God who makes it grow. In healing when we speak the word in binding and loosing, it is God that is empowering His gifts of the spirit. It is the same God that is making both happen. One is converting a sinner to a saint and other is evicting demonic oppression and symptoms.

The healing rewards of abiding in Jesus should open an atmosphere of receiving the benefits of Jesus heavenly standards. Since there isn't any sickness in heaven, and we're the temple of God, indwelled by Holy Spirit, technically we shouldn't be afflicted either. Whatever is afflicting

should be served notice to vacate now. If someone can reject a temptation they can also reject a symptom. Having a new divine nature allows us to bestow God's grace and His gifts (healing, prophecy, etc).

Jesus proved **HE WAS THE ONE TO COME** by showing to all humanity what God is really like. Holy Spirit has replaced His earthly position to be the saints counselor, teacher and empowerer. In Jesus' original authentic Christianity model these did and now continue to occur:

- 1. the blind see
- 2. the lame walk
- 3. the sick are healed
- 4. the deaf hear
- 5. the dead are raised and
- 6. the poor receive the prosperity of His authentic gospel

(Based on Matthew 11:3-6)

Let's review "being prospered", as an example, to exercise a subjective study.

- 1. **Aware**: By now you know sozo represents saved, healed, and prosperity. So authentically if we are saved then we are prospered as well. Just because we don't feel prospered doesn't mean we really are. It just means we haven't received it yet. Jesus overcame poverty and empowered saints with favor, blessings, and riches. If we're operating in new heavenly standards, then the application of those standards can be applied in faith. What should be the impact from this upon our lives? We should be attracting favor of others and calling in the assets made available to God's children.
- 2. **Acknowledge**: Upon recognition of being a saint, with prosperity characteristics, we begin to shift our thoughts. Noticing our new identity, granting its new standards, and embracing kingdom characteristics are part of the renewing process, upgrading us and recalibrating our thinking.
- 3. **Activate**: This shifts our behavior toward our new identity. Knowing new truths is good, it upgrades our expectations, and it helps us in activating our ability to create and call in God's favor, and His prosperity. This is done in faith. Just as our words confess Jesus in salvation, and our words bind symptoms in healing, our words create and call in favor in prosperity. We plant and water, God makes it grow, and He wants to bless us.
- 4. **Abide**: As we abide in Jesus' teachings, and as we speak, our words evoke power, to bless and to curse. Those words will encourage some, will inspire others, and will create value to a hearer or a reader. When we're promoting God's words and feeding the sheep (humanity) God knows, and responds. In salvation our words plant seed, in healing we bind symptoms, however in prosperity we're loosing God's heavenly standards of favor and calling in things that do not exist. It is God that is making these things happen. Acting in unity with God and calling things into being requires faith. The prosperity rewards of abiding in Jesus should open an atmosphere of receiving the benefits of Jesus heavenly standards. Since there isn't any poverty in heaven, and we're the temple of God on earth, indwelled by Holy Spirit, technically we should be rich. All poverty should be served notice and be evicted ASAP. If someone can reject a poverty they can also receive prosperity. Having a new divine nature allows us to bestow God's grace and His gifts.

The prosperity benefits of abiding in Jesus should be an entire spiritual identity shift. These initial characteristics are from being a saint, being the temple of God, being perfected (sanctified), and having a new divine nature.

Discipleship Absolute Effect Cycle

Now that we know we are saved, healed, delivered, and that we are also prospered by God, what do we do with this information? We become a disciple of Jesus, to be like God, as originally intended. But to do this in our own personality. This occurs through the indwelling of Holy Spirit.

As opposed to Sozo, which is initiated by Jesus and empowered by Holy Spirit, discipleship is initiated by saints and requires attention and work to overcome blockages, temptations, and trials. Discipleship characteristics that are essential to success are,

- 1. study to show our self approved,
- 2. pray, fast, and give, (all in secret, requires humility and meekness; inner strength)
- 3. wait on God in quiet meditation (like Jesus did)
- 4. to be edified, built up, as a temple of God, to carry God's anointing

Only temples of God bestow Gods grace and gifts. In todays environment this can be trying, if we aren't in synch with Holy Spirit, Who guides and empowers.

Let's review **Discipleship Factor Effects:**

- 1. **Aware**: Disciples are self feeders, connected directly to Holy Spirit, and not dependent on any other persons approval, because they seek God's approval. They become aware of Jesus' profile, teachings and accomplishments, as a basis for their future.
- 2. **Acknowledge**: After acknowledging Jesus' teachings and His accomplishments it sets a precedent for our ability to raise our expectations for what is possible, from operating in the divine nature, as opposed to where we were operating from the powerless carnal nature.
- 3. **Activate**: Each disciples behavior intersects preparedness with opportunity. When we intervene for our self or for others we actually expect things to go in the direction we speak. Being in unity with Jesus and Holy Spirit, both omnipotent, has empowerment capabilities to overcome, override and overrule all obstacles, as you will see when you exercise the activation of the gifts. Even though we're speaking, God is empowering.
- 4. **Abide**: Abiding in Jesus has the potential to exercise superior authority where every demonic knee shall bow and flee. When you witness this it is awesome, God is glorified, the saints are encouraged, and the sinners begin to reevaluate their positions. I've seen all these things happen. When you see this happen you'll be amazed too.

Manifest Presence Absolute Effect Cycle

The glory of God, on earth, replicates heavenly standards. If you wanted to experience what some of the heavenly attributes are, experiencing the manifest presence or the glory of God, on earth, will open our eyes and our heart. When we witness God answering prayers, manifesting a healing, delivering a word of knowledge, bringing direction or solutions to impossible situations, we witness Gods own manifest presence. We can experience this as often as we are willing to.

There are no restrictions from Gods side. If the glory of God isn't being manifested around you it is being blocked or restricted. We overcome blockages and restrictions to overcome temptations, symptoms, and to bring a manifest presence of God by building our spirit man, praying in tongues, and waiting on God. See other website reports that address this subject (<u>link</u>).

SANCTUARY COMPONENTS, BENEFITS & VALIDATIONS

Entering In Component, Characteristics & Benefits

"Entering In" Components

To enter into God's kingdom there is **no requirement** for your name, email, phone, or any other contact information. This is between you and God. He is the one you're reconciled to, not me, and not the church! All of this media is from Him to you, for your benefit.

Technically, all who accept Jesus and His gospel, sincerely say the sinners prayer, and sincerely repent, are saved from God's wrath, and converted to saints, with eternal life benefits. Many want to discover our gifts, develop them to reach our full personal potential, and fulfill our personal destiny. Reviewing these



"entering in" factors can disentangle the many perception issues that cause restriction, and can allow for a better understanding.

Understanding these components, their importance, and how they connect all kingdom effectiveness will enlighten and inspire. The entering in and the absolute effect phases require us to initiate effort and perseverance. It is worth the effort when the benefits ensue.

How Is This Even Possible?

How it is even possible to ENTER INTO God's kingdom is because **somebody paid our way**. Because Jesus took our place on Calvary (absorbing our sin), and because He was raised from the dead, and now is on His throne at God's right hand, **we can enter into His sanctuary on His coattails**. We actually enter into His crucifixion, His resurrection, and now His throne room position. - *NOW*, *HOW GOOD IS THAT?* -

Jesus voluntarily suffered crucifixion to literally absorb sin and discard the Sanhedrin clergy system. Both proved impossible obstacles to overcome anyway. That's why God sent Jesus, to rescue us. Jesus did all the work, rightfully gets the glory, and mankind gets the benefit! Jesus dealt with sin so we'd be able to just accept His sacrifice. By acknowledging His acts, we actually exit humanity and enter into Christianity. No applications and no testing, and no waiting in line either!

Why Does God Make It So Easy?

Loving parents take good care of their children, and God, as a parent of creation, **continues to favor us**. God wants us as we are. As we go into Christianity, God trades in our sin for His righteousness. That is a very sweet deal for most of us. *I told you God made it easy!*

Outside-Inside & Exit-Enter

Mankind needs to address "entering in" and what it means. It seems too many people are way outside, and "looking in", in complete bewilderment. They seem to be clueless as to what is really going on. Better for people to get inside and see things for themselves.

Exit-Enter

We want to **exit humanity** and **enter Christianity**. By sincerely, respectfully, and transparently acknowledging Jesus we automatically enter into Jesus' sanctuary.



Intentionally exiting humanity and the "sinner status" and entering into Christianity with its "sainthood status", and acknowledging Jesus are imminently important to **reach our full personal potential** and fulfill our personal destiny. It is literally impossible to reach our potential and fulfill our destiny without the indwelling and infilling of Holy Spirit.

Remember that Jesus came to the world and the Jewish nation, but they all rejected Him. But we now know that **whoever does want Him**, He makes them to be their true child-of-God selves, helping them to reach their potential.

Meaning Of Entering In

Entering in means to become a part of something, **to participate or factor into something**, to enlist or enroll. Nobody enters into a restaurant just to read the menu, and watch everyone else eat. If too many did that the restaurant would be bankrupt. We normally enter in, activate an order, eat, digest, and get energized, **experientially**. Likewise, we participate in our relationships, and Christianity is a relationship with God.

Models

When we're physically born, we enter into humanity. When we're born again we enter into Jesus' Christianity, created within Himself, a major

upgrade from humanity, by the indwelling of Holy Spirit cohabiting within each saint. Yes, when you enter into Jesus, God enters into you!

It kinda sounds crazy to think that you can "enter into" someone, but just as **humanity was derived from Adam**, **Christianity is derived from Jesus**. When you were conceived you entered into humanity. When you intentionally select Jesus' new lifestyle model and standards you enter into Christianity. Since Jesus created



Christianity from Himself, as a sanctuary to rescue humanity, when we enter into it, we would be entering into Him as well. **Jesus is the gateway to becoming "at one with God"** (1 Cor 6:17). This is a very significant truth for the personal identity, adoption, and divine nature attributes to grow.

You see, **it is ONLY AFTER we enter in** that God's authentic characteristics can affect us. Inside Christianity is the only place where God's characteristics preside and His paradigm operates, so that is where we absorb His attributes.

Expectations & Effects

When we eagerly work at anything, there is an **expectation for a breakthrough**, and then hopefully a reward. When we join into a group, we do it with beneficial expectations. When we enter into **Jesus' experiential model**, it is to activate an experiential lifestyle, **breaking through to a better life**, eternal and abundant. It isn't to just get in to activate a "spiritual fire insurance policy", although God does recognize every heartfelt prayer.



We address our expectations because **we become aware of new facts**. What our former results were when we were less informed and unable usually left us with low expectations. If we take time to let the benefit of **new revelation raise our awareness**, then it may open our eyes to increase our personal expectations.

Effectively, in entering into Jesus' sanctuary lifestyle we're going to experience His peace, His presence, and His power. These **effect** our body, soul, and spirit **from the inside out**, internally driven. Holy Spirit brings new life to our mortal flesh. Because we are entering into a brand new life, the sanctuary lifestyle benefits begin to ensue. Eternal life is an immediate gratification, along with perfection, cleansing, healing, peace, comfort, personal scholarship tutorials, adoption, and more. Environmentally, it is just superior!

Adoption

"Entering in" is a biblical term used to signify a **personal adoption process** God for each Saint, at their discretion. Since saints have already shifted from death to life it is critical to grow in our new identity, from a saint to a believer, then to a disciple, and then to an Ambassador. Initiating teachings and practices impacts us and transforms a regenerated more Godly version of our self. Once truth is activated and abided in, the absolute effect ensues. Anyone can grow and succeed in Christ personally, upon their own initiative. Nobody is restricted!

Growth Cycles

Each church has its own style and life cycles; practices, schedules, principles, and impact upon its members and their spheres of influence. These cycles are to be left to Jesus and Holy Spirit to

guide them. Jesus is still the head of the church, so we need to honor Him in how He leads each one of us. With that understood, each church member can select and intentionally modify their own relationship with God, as they become aware of the possibilities of what their own potential is, and get a vision of how to fulfill their own personal destiny.

Entering into Jesus' experiential Christianity model we participate in His sanctuary lifestyle. We enter into eternity here, but also begin anew, as a brand new person, operating within heavenly standards and kingdom dynamics. Our spirit is brand new and perfected, but our mind, emotions, and lifestyle usually take a while to catch up. That is why we take



time to regenerate our mind and allow for the incremental experience of new information to change our lifestyle. So we start observing, thinking and shifting.

Then we'll begin awareness of new information we hadn't known, start acknowledging it and even begin activating some of it. As these emerge our old carnal sinner nature diminishes and our divine nature is edified, effecting ourselves and others in our sphere of influence.

Our reflective light glows, but Jesus' divine illumination (within us) **reveals and imparts life**, bestowing grace and extending kingdom dynamics to anyone we can relay it to. As those dynamics effect others, **they also will begin shifting our public identity as well**, and we will see God shifting things to effect better outcomes.

Causality: Sowing & Reaping

Everyone does reap what they sow, which is just standard cause and effect. Haven't you ever noticed how Lady Justice is blindfolded? Remember that all the abuse we dish out is sooner or later finding it's way back to us, and all the abuse we suffered under does find it's way back to whoever exerted it as well. Reciprocation does occur.

Nobody ever gets away with anything because everything is recorded. This is why 1 John 1:9 is so important, to establish repentance, absolution, and restoration.

When we "enter in" and spend the time with God, there is a also a reciprocating response within us individually that builds us up to be more like God. Cause and effect isn't a secret in the world, so we shouldn't be surprised that the same principle works in God's kingdom too! Whatever we plant and fertilize with God, He is sure to make it grow!



Distinction

One big **distinction** between Jesus' experiential model and many church revisionist models is that the revisionist churches keep seeking revival, the manifest presence of God, but many saints who actually practice Jesus' model have **broken through to bestow God's manifest presence**, like Jesus did. You could say the distinction is **activity vs. passivity.** The experiential model objective is to get more of God into each of us so we can extend and bestow Gods grace, mercy, and authority upon others, representing Jesus, as He did God. This isn't in conflict with church doctrine, it is to enhance it. Experiential vs. Spectator models are clear choices the informed can make. This requires a regeneration of our identity, from within, in understanding who we really are in Christ. It is an internally driven agenda for each to initiate. As we grow individually then the church can grow corporately.


Entering In Fundamentals

Entering Into Jesus' authentic gospel model initiates unity with God, and cleanses each of us from conflicting characteristics that heretofore had severed us from God. Individually and corporately <u>unity</u> overcomes conflict and builds a comm<u>unity</u>, by each exercising an opport<u>unity</u>

to develop and deploy their own destiny. Christian unity is the state of being at one with God, joining together by mutual agreement, and in an adopted harmony.

By entering into authentic Christianity, with the indwelling of Holy Spirit's divine nature, we exit humanity and its carnal nature. Here is where we bypass death by engaging the gospel model eternal life. Yes, we begin our eternal life on earth, as we shift from sinner to saint.

By exiting humanity, we're disengaging from the open conflicts with God that usually lean



toward severance from Him and His heavenly standards. Conflict is a state of open, often prolonged fighting, disagreement, disharmony, dissension between persons, ideology, interests, and principles.

Authentic Christian community identifies itself by participating amongst each other, communicating with one another, and helping each other. As we participate, synergy opens and opportunity arises.

Opportunity is a chance for corporate progress to be made or personal breakthrough for individual advancement in discipleship development.



Entering In; Qualified, Unqualified & Disqualified

Jesus said that **Unless** you turn from your sins and become like little children, you will never get into the Kingdom of Heaven. So anyone who does bend their knee to Jesus, repent and become humble (as this little child) is already the greatest in the Kingdom of Heaven. Since we have humbled ourselves why does the average Christian feel disconnected and unqualified?

AUTHORITY

Delegated Authority: Hirelings lead underlings Transmitted Authority: Saints transmit Gifts

Many of us have felt unqualified to extend and bestow the gospel because of the revised clergy systems overreach of recasting saints as sinners, usurping an evil

control. This does indicate abusive use of powers granted to them under a delegated authority that churches generate (*vs. transmitted authority Holy Spirit generates*). They haven't understood the new DNA dynamics in Christ. When anyone castes any believer as a sinner and it makes them feel unqualified, it really disqualifies the caster (*the one who recasts a saint back to a sinner*) from leadership and indicates that they have selected another Jesus, another spirit, and another gospel. Paul warned the church about these pretenders.

Even though God made it easy for us, there is always someone who wants to deter us from our benefits. Free will is important and initiating perseverance is important too. As a personal temple of God, saints need to work at keeping their identity.

- 3. In John 15:7 Jesus refers to abiding in Him (where His sanctuary is activated, and abundant life is generated). So abide and ask and it WILL be done for you!
- 4. His superiority protects from oppression and delivers immunity from evil to anyone who selects Him and His gospel. Just believe it and receive it don't try to figure it out!

Transitioning our lives by entering into God's sanctuary lifestyle is **THE PINNACLE OF IMPORTANCE** and necessary for the great benefits to begin.

Immortality

"If thou wouldest win Immortality of Name, either do things worth the writing, or write things worth the reading." A 1727 quote from Thomas Fuller

Some variation of this has been used by many people, and it basically it is saying that if anyone wants their name to be immortalized, they need to do something worth reporting (getting documented), or they need to write something worth reading (getting published). This is all, so the world can have a permanent notation, immortalizing what someone did or what they wrote, with their name attached. Although these accomplishments can be notable, by worldly standards, they don't qualify for eternal immortalization until one's name is in alignment with heavenly standards, and written in the lambs book of life. Real immortalization is building ones treasure in heaven, through staying on the narrow road, complying with Matthew 6, and by doing the 6 things that Jesus reported to qualify a person as a sheep, vs. a goat, for kingdom entrance.

We're all going to be immortal, because all life continues after our earthly life terminates. Where does that occur you ask? That destination of heaven or hell is based on our own acceptance or rejection of Jesus' gospel. Heavenly mortality is solely through the doorway Jesus has provided, because of His creation of a new form of life, Christianity. Saints have already bypassed death, by passing out of death and into eternal life.

Public-Private

In Matthew 6:1-20 Jesus teaches on prayer, fasting, giving, works, and practical investing principles. When we understand these, we'll be at ease in endearment, able to volunteer unnoticed, and doing things in secret (keeping them private). As Jesus warns, those who publicize and promote their prayers, gifts and works already have their reward. When we keep these things secret, we're investing in our treasure in heaven. God does see everything, and He does bestow benefits where due, both here on earth and when we're in heaven.

Earthly Immortalization Vs. Eternal Life

• "For what does it profit a man to gain the whole world, and forfeit his life [in the eternal kingdom of God]?" (Mark 8:36 AMPC)

For All Have Sinned Vs. All Are Redeemed

- "for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus; whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through faith. This was to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed;" (Romans 3:23-25 NASB)
- "Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned—for until the Law sin was in the world, <u>but sin is not imputed when there is no law.</u>" (Romans 5:12-13 NASB)
- Do you not know that when you offer yourselves as obedient slaves, <u>you are slaves to the one you obey</u>, whether you are slaves to sin leading to death, or to obedience leading to righteousness? (Romans 6:16)
- For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 6:23)

These values offer the truth that believers are not sinners and are redeemed from sin and Satanic.

Reconciliation Observations and Commentary

As Christians go forward and replicate Jesus natural and supernatural works, they too are demonstrating that God did send Jesus.

Commenting on the reinstatement of man over the physical earth might bring ideas of stoping wind storms, blocking rain, pacifying dangerous animals with God's presence where the lion lays down peacefully, or even restocking waterways with fish after they have been plundered. I have personally seen wind storms stopped, rain blocked, and skies opened to bright sunshine, and have heard of other testimonials where an **outdoor event** was protected and kept dry from massive rain storm, **on top of it and around it**, yet not a drop got on anyone while the event was active! These keys really do work, but only for those who truly believe.

It is because saints are established by God and Jesus, from His throne in heaven, that we can use the keys of authority given to us to supercede evil, illness, darkness, and many other things. The reason the keys work here on earth is because they are the same keys of authority God used to evict all the demonic from heaven. The demons recognize Jesus, His keys, and believing believers. I assure you there is nothing more rewarding than seeing the impossible accomplished by God when He sends you out to an impossible situation and you see the sick healed, or someone delivered from demonic oppression, or when we forgive sins and see the glory of God clear out the darkness and reinstate peace. Because we are at one, as He is, so are we in this world (1 John 4:17). We all choose if we want to acknowledge and use any of the keys at our own free will.

Peer Pressure & Bad Teaching Corrupts Kingdom Benefits

"But my church friends have never heard of this and think that this is crazy. They've never seen a healing or a miracle and don't believe in them. So because they don't believe I can't either because I rely on my church friends! Oh my!"

There is always those who go to church, get spoon fed, and never become self-feeders. They are part of the synthetic revised church groups that continue to operate in their own traditions. Of course they don't know, they've yet to enter into Jesus' authentic Christianity. They've only entered into a revised denominational version that is approved by their overseers and their own comfort levels. They're healthy, and have no need of the gifts or many of the other factors Jesus has supplied. Believe me, when something happens, like a serious health issue where their doctor diagnoses something serious, they'll be shifting how they think.

The point is that if there is a shifting from sinner to saint, from carnal to divine, from earthly to heaven-centered standards, and when we know about these and choose to deploy them, then effectiveness has a chance to manifest. So **stop sweeping** the benefits of God's abundant life under the rug of humanitarian and church ignorance!

DON'T LET OTHERS DEFINE YOU!

Many postpone prayer because they have no expectations due to previous failure. They or someone they knew tried prayer unsuccessfully, so therefore it doesn't work. I understand hesitancy under these circumstances. However we need to remember that sin separated people from God and blocked results, but now we're overcoming sin through Jesus, and now we've an open doorway to succeed. Let's not let others define our belief or what level of faith to practice.

So for us who are dealing with symptoms, if death no longer applies, then does sickness? The answer is no! We believe this, therefore we speak it (2 Cor 4:13)! Jesus is the one to instruct us to exert enforcement and the Apostles demonstrated miracles too! Jesus is still doing them today through His disciples.

INTERVENTION IS A GOOD THING

Life can throw us many obstacles, but they don't have to be insurmountable. Being aware and developing tools to circumvent hardships, hazards and hindrances are keys to avoiding and overcoming conflict, and being favored. To intervene is to involve oneself in a situation so as to alter or hinder an action or development, or to interfere, sometimes even through force in the affairs of another. Darkness withholds people from receiving truthful enlightenment and symptoms cause disease, pain, and suffering. *Both darkness and symptoms are spiritually based and can be overcome by intervention*. Superior Christian prayer can exert enforcement of intervention and enlightenment dynamics, dimming darkness and dissolving symptoms, and restoring physical, emotional, and financial health. Anyone can enter in, intervene, and bind and loose for them self or anyone else. Because God is absolute, our intervention effectiveness gets better results based on our proximity to God, and our distancing our self from sin. Causality does play a part, and our intentionality will affect us.

Rules Of The Road!

Gospel Judgment Factors-Have you ever wondered if there is a defined set of factors for eternal life judgment? If there was, who could be so daring as to set the tone, and say what these terms and conditions are? In the Bible, in the Book of John chapter 3, Jesus addressed this issue definitively. Let's see what Jesus states here.

• "The [basis of the] judgment (indictment, the test by which men are judged, the ground for the sentence) lies in this: the Light has come into the world, and people have loved the darkness rather than and more than the Light, for their works (deeds) were evil. For every wrongdoer hates (loathes, detests) the Light, and will not come out into the Light but shrinks from it, lest his works (his deeds, his activities, his conduct) be exposed and reproved. But he who practices truth [who does what is right] comes out into the Light; so that his works may be plainly shown to be what they are—wrought with God [divinely prompted, done with God's help, in dependence upon Him]."(John 3:19-21 AMPC)

It didn't take Jesus long to identify to Nicodemus that the basis for judgment (the test by which men are judged, the ground for the sentence) lies in the fact that He (Jesus) came from heaven, as the light of the world. The test by which men are judged, or the grounds for either the benefits or consequences are applied are up to each individual. Everyone winds up judging themselves, in the end, by their choices.

All who abide in Jesus' teachings and examples will practice truth and align with His Narrow Road agenda. All who detest the light of Jesus' standards align them self with the wide road agenda. Jesus discusses wide and narrow road in Matthew chapter 7, along with other pertinent factors. The other major judgement factors are from Jesus too. Jesus is specific on 6 factors that do separate the sheep from the goats in Matthew 25:31-46. They aren't pliable.

- 1. Give water to the thirsty
- 2. Give food to the hungry
- 3. Give clothing to the needy

- 4. Give housing to the traveler or homeless
- 5. Visit the sick, hospitalized, aged, widows
- 6. Visit the imprisoned, encourage, enlighten
- Once again, Jesus spoke to the people and said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows Me will never walk in the darkness, but will have the light of life." (John 8:12)
- While I am in the world, I am the light of the world." (John 9:5)
- Then Jesus declared, "For judgment I have come into this world, so that the blind may see and those who see may become blind." (John 9:39)
- Now judgment is upon this world; now the prince of this world will be cast out. (John 12:31)
- "Jesus shouted to the crowds, "If you trust me, you are trusting not only me, but also God who sent me. For when you see me, you are seeing the one who sent me. I have come as a light to shine in this dark world, so that all who put their trust in me will no longer remain in the dark. I will not judge those who hear me but don't obey me, for I have come to save the world and not to judge it. But all who reject me and my message will be judged on the day of judgment by the truth I have spoken. I don't speak on my own authority. The Father who sent me has commanded me what to say and how to say it. And I know his commands lead to eternal life; so I say whatever the Father tells me to say."" (John 12:44-50 NLT)
- 1. Jesus makes it very clear that it is He Who is the light of the world. Whoever follows Jesus won't be in darkness, or evil practices, but will experience His light.

- 2. Jesus makes it clear He came to finish the process of expelling of Satan, but this time on earth. By enforcing His heavenly standards on earth, and overcoming Satan, and empowering all Saints with His keys, Jesus sets in motion a continuation of "due process" on all demonic, by His followers.
- 3. These standards that Jesus is reporting are from His Father, God. It is God's intent to enlighten all humanity. By sending Jesus to deal with sin, the law, and darkness, and make it easy for anyone to enter in, all humanity has been accommodated. Free will choice is what is exercised in the acceptance or the rejection of Jesus' gospel model. Everybody determines their own pathway. So it turns out all gospel judgment determinations are self directed. As Jesus has said, let it happen, according to your own faith, or your own personal will.

A Very Important Review Of Each Saints New Identity

Saints are no longer who they were in their old life before Christ. Saints have died to their carnal nature, to themselves and are now alive now in Christ's divine nature, so their DNA has changed from sinner to saint. When we're in heaven nobody cares how we got there, which denomination or practice was deployed to alert us to God's gospel or saving grace and eternal life. We're just going to be grateful to Jesus for His sincere accomplishments that we have benefited from! Our fruitfulness is a validation that we've already begun our eternal life in Christ on earth.

Saints are not a modification of the old self (without Christ), but a brand new creation (in Christ). If we don't recognize this we'll be:

- 1. **Reluctant** to identify with this new form of righteousness, at one with God, reconciled
- 2. **Resistant** to move forward as the new person God has granted us to be in this new life form
- 3. Confused about true salvation and its intended effects of mercy, grace, and many dynamics
- 4. **Double-minded**, which causes a person to get nothing, so this should be cleared up ASAP

It is God's divine nature heavenly standards that penetrate each new life, and although spiritually the first transition is completed, there is a second transition for our mind to catch up with the renewing process.

WONDER WHY? WE SEE THINGS DIFFERENTLY? WE FEEL DIFFERENTLY?

If we're wondering why we see things differently, feel differently (about different issues), or confusion is reigning in our head and heart it is because of the exchange that took place in our spirit when we entered into authentic Christianity. Read why these dynamics are so real, need to be understood, in order to reevaluate our own thinking.

Transformation Guideposts & Validations

Real transformation is getting God into us, filling us with His light, so no matter where we go, His light dissolves any darkness.

Ways to accomplish that is to go to heaven and while in His presence, get filled up. Those who have died and returned have seen significant residual benefits of their spirit transferring Heavens "presence" to others, where major healings have occurred. Another way is to pray for Holy Spirit to come in and fill us up here on earth and equip us to bestow the same benefit to others as Jesus did

In order to be filled, replenished, or revived, Jesus went alone to meet with Holy Spirit. These meetings refreshed him. Notice He didn't go to the temple, but went to Holy Spirit. Why? Because the indwelling and the infilling are functional realities for all who initiate these activities

Cars don't run on empty. Neither do smart phones, computers, or appliances. They all need fuel or a source of energy. All humanity is sustained by God's omnipresence, but not until we select Jesus, can we be in-dwelt with His manifest presence.

Jesus knew humanity needed Holy Spirit so He created a new form of life, to replace humanity, that would include Holy Spirit. He created Christianity, out of Himself to replace humanity. As we enter into Christianity, God enters into us.

When Holy Spirit enters into us, He brings a whole slate of interesting attributes and factors. He brings:

- 1. **A New Identity**, saint, no longer a sinner, cleansed of all sin, and adopted
- 2. **Heavenly Standards** in the form of a new divine nature that replaces our old carnal nature
- 3. **An Illumination** that lifts the veil of darkness so we can see more clearly, and it exposes conflicting agendas
- 4. **Revelation** in the form of understanding better older information and a whole host of new information we couldn't handle as a sinner
- 5. **Inspiration** is a form of integrating God's standards into our own personality to allow them to shine, be seen, and embraced by others.

I remind everyone that God has given everyone a free will to identify and embrace none, some or all of these. It's our own choice.

How do you know if we're in the kingdom of God, saved, and have eternal life?

- 1. We know it when we select Jesus, as our savior, and follow Romans 10:9, where we **believe** and confess.
- 2. Then we also know by the absolute effects of Holy Spirits indwelling, and His many attributes.
- 3. Then we really know when we begin to bestow God's grace, mercy, and His gifts upon those needing them.

If someone needs validation of Christianity transformation Jesus gives us a listing of what classifies a **sheep and a goat in Matthew 25:31-46**. Since He is the judge, I'd see these as an important component to incorporate into our framework going forward. These simple acts, as we do them, are recorded, and do act as validation for all of us who are "cramming for finals". Salvation isn't earned from doing these. It remains a free gift from God. Getting a validation of something can do a number of things. It can give us peace. It can give us confidence. Any parent would want any of their children to have both and God isn't any different, as a parent.

Resistance Only Effects The Sinner, Not God!

As Jesus says, the refusal to do the Matthew 25:31-46 works are also recorded, along with accompanying consequences. The Bible also states that sin will separate anyone from God. So the identification of these should be something to know. Remember sin doesn't effect God, just us. All sin warnings are to protect people. I'm paying attention to this, for my own future!

Checking The Boxes

We all want to "check the boxes", and assure our self that we're on the right road, the Narrow Road. But I've personally witnessed another "validation", that is the differences of how we see, hear, and how we react to so many of life's variables. It takes a period of adjustment to absorb the beneficial aspects of perfection, sanctification, and to bestow the love of God. Practicing Jesus' Matthew 25:31 gospel activities can offer a form of verification that we've embraced Jesus' salvation, so therefore have eternal life. So we should have confidence Holy Spirit is indwelling us too. Technically we've already crossed over from death to life. This is to help us confirm to our self the peace of our salvation, and that's good news!

God Knows Who Are & Arn't His

• "The Lord is good, a Strength and Stronghold in the day of trouble; He knows (recognizes, has knowledge of, and understands) those who take refuge and trust in Him." Nahum 1:7 AMPC

God already knows who have entered into His gospel and who trust Him. Remember it is God who derived all humanity's life, and it is God who continues to sustain our lives. So if He is doing that he knows the rest too.

Jesus Knows His and Recognizes Those Who Selected Him

• I am the Good Shepherd; and I know and recognize My own, and My own know and recognize Me—Even as [truly as] the Father knows Me and I also know the Father—and I am giving My [very own] life and laying it down on behalf of the sheep. And I have other sheep [beside these] that are not of this fold. I must bring and impel those also; and they will listen to My voice and heed My call, and so there will be [they will become] one flock under one Shepherd. John 10:14-16 AMPC

Jesus knows who are His sheep, and His sheep know Him and value each other. Authentic Christianity does carry heavenly standards of being at one with God and valuing each other.

Jesus' Works Are His Credentials

• Jesus answered them, I have told you so, yet you do not believe Me [you do not trust Me and rely on Me]. The very works that I do by the power of My Father and in My Father's name bear witness concerning Me [they are My credentials and evidence in support of Me]. But you do not believe and trust and rely on Me because you do not belong to My fold [you are no sheep of Mine]. The sheep that are My own hear and are listening to My voice; and I know them, and they follow Me. And I give them eternal life, and they shall never lose it or perish throughout the ages. [To all eternity they shall never by any means be destroyed.] And no one is able to snatch them out of My hand. My Father, Who has given them to Me, is greater and mightier than all [else]; and no one is able to snatch [them] out of the Father's hand." John 10:25-29 AMPC

Why is this important?

James reports that Jesus' followers have works that validate them as well.

• 'But he who looks carefully into the faultless law, the [law] of liberty, and is faithful to it and perseveres in looking into it, being not a heedless listener who forgets but an active doer [who obeys], he shall be blessed in his doing (his life of obedience).' (James 1:25)



Each Saints Works Are His Credentials Too

• But the firm foundation of (laid by) God stands, sure and unshaken, bearing this seal (inscription): **The Lord knows those who are His**, and, Let everyone who names [himself by] the name of the Lord **give up all iniquity and stand aloof from it**. 2 Timothy 2:19 AMPC

Declaring Jesus as savior, and avoiding and overcoming temptations are clear signals that we give to God that we're His, and we're operating under the new "Rules Of The Road, on the Narrow Road Jesus discussed.



Are You Ready? So Is God!

This is the Narrow Road lifestyle Jesus has reported on, so be sure about it by being able to evaluate the factors He describes. Jesus reports true discipleship testing here.

'A large crowd was following Jesus. He turned around and said to them, "If you want to be my disciple, you must, by comparison, hate everyone else—your father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters—yes, even your own life. Otherwise, you cannot be my disciple. And if you do not carry your own cross and follow me, you cannot be my disciple. "But don't begin until you count the cost. For who would begin construction of a building without first calculating the cost to see if there is enough money to finish it? Otherwise, you might complete only the foundation before running out of money, and then everyone would laugh at you. They would say, 'There's the person who started that building and couldn't afford to finish it!" "Or what king would go to war against another king without first sitting down with his counselors to discuss whether his army of 10,000 could defeat the 20,000 soldiers marching against him? And if he can't, he will send a delegation to discuss terms of peace while the

enemy is still far away. So you cannot become my disciple without giving up everything you own.' (Luke 14:25-33 NLT)

Then he called the crowd to him along with his disciples and said: "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me. For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me and for the gospel will save it. What good is it for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul? If anyone is ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will be ashamed of them when he comes in his Father's glory with the holy angels." (Mark 8:34-36,38 NIV)

Every time we decide to move closer to one segment of society, work, sport, or belief system somebody else is disappointed and maybe offended too. Any championship level guidance, development, and deployment has standards, and **Jesus certainly didn't sugar coat His standards**. We see that we need to know there are consequences to making a stand for Jesus. Witnesses report that many who follow and practice Jesus' teachings have lost relationships and suffered discrimination. Remember darkness cannot and will not tolerate light. So be aware that when you begin repeating His teachings you're going to emanate light, and that light will irritate people who don't want their bad works, lifestyle, or beliefs exposed.

Cramming For Finals?

If we enter into Jesus for salvation, then we no longer have to cram for finals, because we've crossed over from death to life!

CONCLUSION COMMENTARY

Three Truths We Can Bank On

In reference to this report there are a number of truths that can be safely recapitulated:

- 1. **Jesus was sent by God** to absorb everybody's sin so each has ample opportunity to choose God's best for them-self, build a relationship, flourish, and fulfill their own destiny on earth.
- 2. **Jesus' finished** work on Calvary **restored God to mankind**, mankind to God, and man to man through discarding the old legal system and reversing out satanic and sinful influence.
- 3. **Jesus created** a new form of life, replacing humanity, called Christianity, were saints become one with God, grafted into Jesus, and adopted by Holy Spirit. In this model saints are:
 - a) tasked with focusing on Jesus and believing, not double-minded, and not doubting
 - b) tasked with bestowing grace on sinners (without condemnation), by being light and salt, to flavor the gospel in their own personality, to extend the gospel to their own environmental spheres of influence who will accept it and want it.
 - c) tasked with overseeing the earth's integrity to manage the nations by establishing righteous (moral) lifestyles glorifying God.
 - d) tasked with utilizing the keys to bind and loose, heal, deliver, and bestow the prophetic, intervening as needed to destroy works of evil and manifest the natural and supernatural works of Jesus. As we lighten others load, and enlighten with the gospel, God is happy!

Heavenly Standards Purpose

Purpose for Jesus' heavenly standards are for each person to enter into Christianity, mature, become fruitful, and fulfill their earthly destiny before graduating to heaven!

My sincerest wish for you is that your journey is peaceful, potent, and powerful. Let these happen according to your own desire to choose, pursue and persevere. We all reap or harvest what we sow, so as we invest in God His attributes will ensue.

I hope you have the time of your life!

When you are ready, join Jesus in reconciling all humanity to God, in your own style. But first take time to get to know Holy Spirit. There will always be time to be a light, but it is important to be at peace with your own new life.



APPENDIX A: Proximity

Proximity is the the property of being close together or the fact of being near.

The *closer we get to God*, the closer we are to His manifest presence, or His empowerment. *Why is is this important?* Because God's presence delivers heavenly standards that impact temptations, symptoms, and circumstances, by dismissing and dissolving them. Jesus came to destroy the works of the devil, and He left us His keys empowered by Holy Spirit, the same One that empowered His earthly ministry. In addition to clearing bad things from our life, God wants to impact us with more illumination (enlightenment), revelation (answers and solutions), and inspiration (encouragement to deploy), to fulfill our individual destiny. God wants to favor His children, so of course those who make it there business, to humble them self to be closer to God their spiritual proximity is going to be impacted more by God's beneficial favor.

Since mankind cannot house or hold the omnipotent power of God, each believer's proximity to God, appears more important. Now we know why Jesus spent so many hours, alone with Holy Spirit. *He knew His proximity to God was essential* to His ministerial success (<u>having Holy Spirit without measure</u>). Since the disciple is not above the master, the onus is on each disciple to initiate Jesus' model. Jesus' professed model keys, *by His example*, start on our knees. In humility we plant ourself before God. That is where and how *God makes all things grow!*



The opposite of light is darkness and the opposite of proximity is being far away, remote, distant. Today most people are inundated with so much to do, that their ability to break away to a closer proximity to God is never an option. Busyness, coupled with peoples *unawareness of their ability to overcome*, and their *schedule seems to delay* them from entering into Jesus kingdom, leaves them perennially weakened. It often takes an event, like a catastrophe for so many, to ever even consider giving God a second look. We've all been there! *But it doesn't take long to reconcile with God*, adjust our priorities, and *initiate action*. It's all a matter of our own free will!

This is a very unique and interesting verse that exposes significant revelation to benefit us:

• 'But whenever someone turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. For the Lord is the Spirit, and wherever the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. So all of us who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord. And the Lord—who is the Spirit—makes us more and more like him as we are changed into his glorious image.' (2 Corinthians 3:16-18)

Let's recap these:

- 1. Whoever turns to God the veil is taken away
- 2. All who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord
- 3. God makes us more and more like Him as we are changed into his glorious image

For the manifest presence to become a habitual environment, or close to that, the onus is on each of us, to personally generate an agenda, like Jesus did, to accommodate that. God has already generated His personal empowerment in Holy Spirit, and the favor of heavenly standard results. Those perfect results are already waiting for all of us. God has delivered abundant life on earth, for anyone who will persevere to abide in Jesus, by breaking through to divine nature benefits.
