
Personal Observation and Commentary — Why is this so important?

Parents do like to know their children and God isn't any different. God was blocked from knowing, and relating to humanity and blocked from making them like Himself, sharing with them, empowering them, etc. God tried hard by rescuing mankind, gave them the Ten Commandments, and hoped for a breakthrough to share the Narrow Road of heavenly standards. After centuries He realized sin had to be removed, not just cleansed. So He needed better access to humanity. The only way was to absorb the sin, so Jesus volunteered to go to earth and fulfill God's wish. What is so important is that Jesus' blood was from God, not Adam, so it was perfect, without sin, spotless, and qualified for a perfect sacrifice under the law.

Jesus actually left heaven and changed into a little baby, became flesh, and He lived among humanity. His glory, at His birth, at His baptism, at His death, at His resurrection, and the many miracles He bestowed among humanity were witnessed and recorded by so many people. Jesus' bloodline relationship qualified Him to reconcile God to mankind. Saints are counseled to have a similar attitude of humility like Jesus had. We, who are abiding in Jesus, have also witnessed so many of these same miracles. These miracles implying Jesus is alive in us, and so continuing.

Having the ability to pay is an important qualification. Up until the Nativity, nobody was qualified. Humanity required intervention for its relationship with God to be reinstated. Now that Jesus came to earth there was hope for a reconciliation. I don't think very many knew what the strategy was to accomplish Gods plan. Who would have thought that anyone was going to send their own son to die for all humanity? That may be a clue to how completely frustrated God was with the failure of all the patient effort He exerted, up to that point.

Darkness had too big a foothold on humanity, and a better solution was required. God didn't wipe out humanity like He did before, He just sent His son to bypass it, by establishing another form of life out of Himself. God made it easy for mankind and upon their entering in each would be indwelled with Holy Spirit. It all started with Jesus ability to pay.



- 4. Spat; expressing animosity by ejecting an expectorant
- 5. Mocked; treat with ridicule or contempt; to deride
- 6. Nailed; extremely torturous execution on a cross
- 7. Stabbed; a thrusting motion to plunge a spear into a body part






Personal Observation and Commentary

Preexistence is preceding something or existing in a former state previous to what you are now. Jesus explains how He preceded His son of man existence and how He did it.





All believers were purchased with the precious blood of Christ, like that of a sacrificial lamb. Jesus knew He was the only one who qualified to get mankind out of the sinner category, and He persevered accordingly and accomplished His mission.

3. Willingness To Redeem; Just as the Son of Man came not to be waited on but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many [the price paid to set them free]. Matt 20:28


