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

Severed Introduction

Indubitably, there will be those who will have conflict with these, due to these truths conflicting with the "politically correct" comfort zones of their belief system. The objective is to identify and inform what the effects of breaking (not bending) Gods explicit standards. There is no implication of condemnation for anyone here, just information to help us assess our own status.

Caveat Emptor: A Latin phrase meaning let the buyer beware, used here as a alert to make sure your source and standards are in alignment for a narrow road current and eternal life blessings instead of a wide road current and eternal suffering of futile practices.

The other implication here is to not assume that the quality of the source of your "personal standards" information ensures your success. Sabotage is the deliberate attempt to damage, destroy, or hinder, to cause destruction of property or to obstruct success. Since many of these values addressed in "Severed" are in conflict with many worldly accepted standards, one of the sources is false, these or those. Is the false standard a product of sabotage? Deception is the only pertinent value Satan has to use on humanity.

Because it has been reported that the denigration of the Bible must be undertaken to support vulgar and vile lifestyles, biblical values have been redefined as hateful, (if you can even believe this, bizarre). In a 1958 TV interview, Aldus Huxley admits that the Bible gets in the way of their sexual perverse lifestyle, so it had to be discredited. This is a deliberate attempt to damage the Bible and its moral value, hence sabotage. There is more evidence if you care to check the facts. Your free to accept this or reject this, but the truth itself, will never be revised. The purpose of exposing this to inform humanity of alternative agendas that will sabotage our lives, and those around us. Caveat Emptor!

Nothing Can Separate Us From God's Love

All saints have a special relationship with God, and the more we know about that the better off we are.

- 'So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. And because you belong to him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death.' (Romans 8:1-2)
- "What shall we say about such wonderful things as these? If God is for us, who can ever be against us? Since he did not spare even his own Son but gave him up for us all, won't he also give us everything else? Who dares accuse us whom God has chosen for his own? No one—for God himself has given us right standing with himself. Who then will condemn us? No one—for Christ Jesus died for us and was raised to life for us, and he is sitting in the place of honor at God's right hand, pleading for us. Can anything ever separate us from Christ's love? Does it mean he no longer loves us if we have trouble or calamity, or are persecuted, or hungry, or destitute, or in danger, or threatened with death? (As the Scriptures say, "For your sake we are killed every day; we are being slaughtered like sheep.") No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us. And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love. No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Romans 8:31-39 NLT)

So we see that to remain in Christ there is no separation from God. That would infer people must enter into Christ first, and continue to abide in Christ. Now what constitutes "abiding in Christ"?

SEVERED TRUTHS

Why are these truths so important?

Ultimately we're all going to know the truth and we'll all be set free when that happens. What concerns me is which side I will be on regarding each of the categories below. I'd like to prepare myself for the best potential result



Severed Categories

- 1. <u>Severed from God</u>, in eternal darkness and suffering, because my own doing, due to corruption and deception, turning renegade and desertion. (Card # 1-12, 15-20, 23-24)
- 2. <u>Severed from my reward</u>, because it was burned up, due to distractions and interferences. (Card # 21-22)
- 3. <u>Severed from demonic toxicity</u> that could poison me, and restrict my kingdom benefits. How I sever these toxic contaminates is important. (Card # 13-14)

God is absolute, and Jesus brought an absolute Gospel authenticating a heavenly narrow road set of values and standards. These three categories describe essential important values to become aware of and activate strategies to influence enforcement to defeat the first two and engage #3.

There is a difference between Jesus' authentic gospel and mankind's theologically revised versions that are parading around today as authentic. The big differences is between how these Gospel models are practiced, what our belief system is regarding an earthly mediator, and how we deny or embrace delegated or transmitted authority (the Person Holy Spirit).

Placing God in a restricted place where He can't hear any of my prayers, due to my own severance causing activity, wasn't something any of us was setting out to do. But if my prayers aren't answered shouldn't I find out why, and try to fix it? Maybe these truths can provide some values for me to address this issue and others. These truths are important to help me redeem so many significant values God has for those who know about them, pay attention to them, and build their lives on Jesus truths

Narrow Road Standards

The world offers many standards for each of us to accept and even be enticed by. Traditional church isn't far behind, unfortunately. There are some very defined standards, by God, for His family. Jesus taught on these, as well as His Apostles. The difference is that God's standards get very good results, today, tomorrow and forever, while the others are futile and powerless. Certain practices may be expedient, but long term have an expelling consequence.

After studying these and seeing how effective they are, I decided to share them. These can help enable others to become enlightened on narrow road standards. It is smart to leverage off of somebody else's effort and success, and if I can avoid the potholes ahead it is worth the hour or two to bypass failure and futility.

The standards of life need to be exposed and encouraged to help all humanity. If we are truly good citizens and patriots, we will

If any of our current "truths" are obstructing God's values and these practices sanction a sinful lifestyle, they can cause us uncertainty about this subject matter. If we feel conflicted it just might be God nudging us toward some level of enlightenment.

If failure, barriers, and hinderances meet us unprepared, maybe we should spend some time in preparation, in order to overcome these obstacles. My motivation here is to insure awareness and acknowledge answers, solutions and better chance at succeeding. Like Jesus, we are not supposed to lose anybody. Since the way is for truth to set us free, lets embrace it and help others do the same


Pre-Section Questions Answered

The pre-section question asked *Does sin sever man from God*. It has been reported that Satan and a third of the angels were evicted from heaven because Satan found sin and practiced it. Satan was able to get one third of the angels to practice it too, so they were evicted too! In addition, Adam and Eve were expelled from the garden after disobedience to God, a sinful practice. Sin was the reason Jesus volunteered to come to earth. To deal with it, forever. The answer overwhelmingly is yes, sin still can separate anyone from God. Jesus' brother James

breaks down the cycle and reports that each person is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed. Then, after desire has conceived (the sin), it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death. Severance from God is very real and God has described it simply and clearly. Resistance to God's rules are futile.

Personal Commentary

It became apparent to me that death is associated with being out of favor with God, with curses, and under the wrath of God. <u>So becoming aware of anything that could block my potential Godly benefits, here on earth, and eternally, I became interested in knowing about them.</u> If God can't hear me, because of something I initiated, that needs fixing. Also by becoming aware of and identifying a temptation at conception, it's much easier to nip it in the bud. Awareness and acknowledgement do carry significant discernment attributes, and impact our success. It just doesn't seem smart to me to be in a place where God cannot hear me. So I need to know which practices place me in the wrong place, where there are no benefits and consequences. I need to evaluate my practices earnestly.

- "When I wrote to you before, I told you not to associate with people who indulge in sexual sin. But I wasn't talking about unbelievers who indulge in sexual sin, or are greedy, or cheat people, or worship idols. You would have to leave this world to avoid people like that. I meant that you are not to associate with **anyone** who claims to be a believer yet **indulges in sexual sin**, or is **greedy**, or worships idols, or is **abusive**, or is a **drunkard**, or **cheats** people. Don't even eat with such people." (1 Corinthians 5:9-11 NLT) For a more complete list see Appendix A.
- "Don't you realize that those who do wrong will not inherit the Kingdom of God? Don't fool yourselves. Those who indulge in sexual sin, or who worship idols, or commit adultery, or are male prostitutes, or practice homosexuality, or are thieves, or greedy people, or drunkards, or are abusive, or cheat people—none of these will inherit the Kingdom of God." (1 Corinthians 6:9-10 NLT)
- "Run from sexual sin! No other sin so clearly affects the body as this one does. For sexual immorality is a sin against your own body. Don't you realize that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who lives in you and was given to you by God? You do not belong to yourself, for God bought you with a high price. So you must honor God with your body." (1 Corinthians 6:18-20 NLT)



The pre-section question asked about the source of being severed from God. We'd all like to think that any severance from God is always the doing of another. But SURPRISE, not so! Seriously, being SEVERED from God can only be from my own effort as a result of my own doing. God gave everyone free will, to exercise, at their own discretion. This means we are in charge of accepting Jesus or rejecting Jesus. If we accept Jesus it impacts our life, to seek to know more about Him, and to get to know Holy Spirit. If we resist any interest in getting to know either Jesus or Holy Spirit, it is a red flag the seed didn't take. See analogy in Matthew 13.

Pre-Section Questions Answered with Commentary

The pre-section question asked if stubbornness is destined to ultimately sever one from God. Since God judges everyone according to what they have done, if they have rejected Jesus, they've already judged themselves accordingly. Most of us are humbled and grateful of Jesus' accomplishments. Those who resist and make it a policy to defiantly resist God's grace could be categorized as stubborn. We will see what Jesus says about them in the next card.

Pre-Section Questions Answered with Commentary

The pre-section question asked about the status of anyone who denies Jesus, rejects the gospel, or as we will see resists Holy Spirit too, is denied access to Heaven by both Jesus and God. Also if someone claims to be a prophet (or a pastor, or a teacher) and denies the truth of Jesus' gospel (primarily by revising it), that person is not from God. This is why knowing the truth is so important, and why the truth has so many vantage points. Those in the truth travel on the narrow road, in the divine nature, from having entered into Jesus and fully embracing Holy Spirit. All gospels that preach Jesus are effective, however, after that, only a few find the narrow road.

Pre-Section Questions Answered

The pre-section question asked about the issue of rejecting Holy Spirit. So why is this important? I thought Jesus was the savior and the main event here. What am I missing? This is very important. Every person who becomes a Christian, by shifting from a sinner to a saint, is indwelled by Holy Spirit, completing the conversion dynamic, and beginning the adoption process. Yes, Christians are adopted into God's family, become citizens of heaven, bypass death, and are in alignment for direct benefits and teachings from the Bible and Holy Spirit. Holy Spirit is the Spirit of Father God, Who was prevented from indwelling humanity due to Adams sin. When Jesus absorbed that sin, all humanity has immediate access directly to God, and Holy Spirit had the availability to impact humanity more personally. So if someone rejects Holy Spirit, they're really rejecting God, and Jesus' finished work on Calvary, that Jesus sacrificed His life to absorb all of mankind's sin.

Personal Commentary

The Apostle Paul makes it abundantly clear that all who reject Jesus, reject Jesus' teachings, and those who reject Holy Spirit, are severed from God and from heaven. That's why this is important.

Pre-Section Questions Answered

The pre-section question asked about how grace can be nullified, and what it means. Grace is God's new way to deal with a humanity because it needed extra care to qualify for both a direct relationship with God and eternal life. The law was great at letting people know what disqualified them from God's eternal life, but nobody could live that perfectly. When Jesus came from heaven, and did live perfectly, He qualified to act as our pascal lamb and actually absorb sin, instead of just being a temporary cleanse, like the Jewish system provided. God permanently removed the sin and now has all humanity potentially connected to God, individually, by His grace. Nullifying grace to return to a mediated system, to earn your way to God, or by being an underling under a hireling or covering, is what Paul is referring to here. By returning to a legalistic system, Paul says that you are severed from God.

Personal Commentary

Paul did make clear how God views people who return to the law (any legalistic revision misleading saints to sinners, etc.). In view of the fact that Jesus paid dearly to discard that system, so all humanity may have a direct access to God, reinstating any mediated system that requires a "covering", mediator, or person in between God and each person is nullifying the work of Jesus. To identify one as a sinner means they have been severed from God. Sinners are defined as heathens, under wrath, in the original Greek language. Revising the temple to the building housing church events from the individual saint is another form of heresy. See 5 Elementals

The theme about an outward profession of faith without an inward sincerity has been reported since the Didache, early churches teachings (<u>Link: scroll to bottom</u>). These reports are unanimous in their review that salvation is inward, it affects people in their heart, and produces Godly behavior, because the saved are grafted into Jesus. Instead of being severed from God they are now unified with God. We become like Him, not vice versa. So if there isn't any growth in that direction one might want to visit their own sincerity for confirmation.

Pre-Section Questions Answered With Commentary

The pre-section question asked by Paul is dealing with a wide plethora of items that are liberally accepted and practiced today. Paul wasn't trying to ruin anyone's party here. He was informing us that carnality carried too far has consequences. Sexual sin, even with consenting adults, is still sin, and carries with it a death sentence (death meaning separated from God, not physically dying). See The 5 Elementals for more on this. Divinity does have standards, and apparently God hasn't changed His. To see a fuller list of eternal life deal killers see Appendix A.

Ultimate Hypocritical Subterfuge

Why should I be so concerned about the appearance of offending someone who is using "being offended" or "hate speech" as a pretext to silence others, and bring legitimacy to a known perverted behavior. The facts are that all of the sinner that I ministered to in hospice have "jumped ship" upon mortality imminence, and latched onto Jesus. Elitist advocates of sexually


perverted behavior have voiced opinions to silence the Bible and its values for centuries. They've tried to cripple free speech and have villainized many who stand for Jesus. They're protecting their "Turf" and fabricating their freedom from God's moral law. The fact that they reach for Jesus, once in hospice, proves the hypocrisy of this culture. Their screams for politically correct victimization of offensive speech is completely hypocritical. After almost 30 years of ministry, including ICU, hospice, and Nursing Home visitations, I have always witnessed these social liberals drop their beliefs and make a beeline to Jesus, repent and enter into Christianity. Subterfuge is an expedient trick used to evade a rule, a truth, or to escape the consequence of something. It is pure deception.

So again, why should I be so concerned about offending someone who is using "being offended" or "hate speech" as a pretext to silence my right to acknowledge God's standards? I'm always concerned for them, and their success, and I'm not abandoning God's standards, if they are addressed. Since I've already witnessed their end of life behavior I just let them talk.

The pre-section question asked if backsliders are severed from God. Technically grace covers a lot of failure and a period of time for the indwelling of God to take effect on each saints behavior. Jesus gave three years for the tree to produce or tear it down. See this in the Parable of the Barren Fig Tree (Luke 13:6-9). This timeframe could be analogous to God's expectations for growth in believers. Jesus did warn His followers about upcoming false prophets, that were

dressed nicely and charismatic, but inside were wolves. I believe saints are supposed to know the authentic gospel so the synthetic counterfeits can be detected and avoided.

Personal Commentary

We know that Christians can't return to sin because they've shifted from sinner to saint, wide road to narrow road, carnality to divinity, and are indwelled by Holy Spirit, God, Who doesn't coexist with sin. Remember God had all sin expelled from Heaven, and Jesus absorbed it on earth, so we could enter into His new form of life, Christianity. So we are thankful to Jesus for reconciling us directly to God. But we must be careful to not backslide our self, even though few of us actually mature without falling occasionally. Let's face it, we all fall somewhere along the line. Lastly be aware of those who would revise the Gospel to include these unacceptable practices.

Pre-Section Questions Answered

The pre-section question asked if dishonoring God severs us from God. God's first three of the ten Commandments dealt with Him and His rules, especially how He expects to be treated by us. If anything comes before God, dishonoring Him, it carries consequences. Those consequences are explained by Paul in Romans 1 & 2. These people are completely severed from God, and in verse 27 Paul is stating that the inevitable consequences and penalty of their wrong doing was their fitting retribution. Now if that punishment is due this form of rebellion, the other forms of rebellion are in alignment to suffer as well. Their only hope is a heartfelt sincere repentance, or they are seriously doomed.

Personal Commentary

It appears that Paul cleared up any conflict about these practices and where they'll wind up. Since God gave up on them, their only hope is to repent. My ministerial "visiting the sick" experience has witnessed that they all "jump ship" at the end and grab onto Jesus. It's amazing to witness this! So why don't they just do that now? Ego, peer pressure, lots of carnal reasons prevent them from seeing truth. It is God, Holy Spirit, who exerts some level of compassion, just before sinners are going to fall into the abyss. When I witness this, first hand, and saw with my own eyes how God exercises His own faithfulness, I was able to see how He does intervene for so many. God's dedication is real! It could be God is answering the prayers of a faithful brother, sister, mother, father, or an associate who is dedicated to standing in the gap for someone else. Since God doesn't hear them, because they are severed, God had to have heard someone!

Pre-Section Questions Answered

The pre-section question asked how many of the ten virgins were severed, and implying why. The answer is half of them were severed because they were foolish. Warnings against foolishness is a prevalent theme with this series. The differentiation between the foolish and wise was getting ready and staying ready for Jesus, staying in His purity and sinlessness. This parable should draw the line of demarcation of what Jesus' standard is and that it does not have room for any spiritual degeneration.

Personal Commentary

In the nature of Christianity, a new form of life in Christ, Christians profess to honor Jesus and His standards. Since Christians are the wise virgins and hypocrites the foolish ones, the lamps are to signify commitment to purity, and are supposed to be operating consistently, not intermittently. Remember we "virgin" Christians, are waiting for Jesus' return. God uses marriage as a graphic to describe becoming one permanently with Him. Jesus did signify that a wise Christian will stay pure while waiting for Jesus or they will end the race by not maintaining purity with the indwelling of Holy Spirit.

The pre-section question asked about becoming a doer, and what that exactly mean. We see that it is not what we think. James positions this as a form of self examination, using the Bible values and verses as the standards to reflect our status. James reports that merely listening to the word doesn't evoke salvation or eternal life. If I don't do what it says, I've missed the mark. Missing the mark is described as being a sign of sin or being a sinner, and that, as we have seen, will separate us from God. Merely listening is important as well because it is seed planting. Jesus teachings and the Apostles amplification of those teachings will expose my own sin to me if and when I'm ready and willing to discover them and then overcome them.

Personal Commentary

Biblical standards reflect who we really are, by comparison, just like a mirror reflects our image. The Bible exposes our personal corruption, pet sins, blockages, and reveals to us why we fail. When the light hits the darkness within us, we need to overcome those deficiencies and vanquished them. Doing represents allowing for the word of truth to expose sin and then we intentionally "do" shift our life into becoming an overcomer on each issue. This is intentional and it takes sincerity and effort. It seems that only in overcoming do we become a doer, building on the rock, not just hearing.

If merely listening to the gospel message was sufficient to save every sinner, then why would Jesus specify that acknowledging Him before others, publicly was a qualification for Him to acknowledge each of us before His Father, for eternal kingdom entrance? I see the mirror as a critical factor for each of us to ensure our compliance.

If we do good works that benefit others, but bypass the important issue of acknowledging Jesus (not necessarily denying God), what is the effect? Not including cultural isolation from the gospel message (those out of tough with the rest of humanity, aborigine), the rest of us have a decision to make regarding Jesus message, on denying or accepting Jesus, or on becoming unified with God or becoming severed from God. Becoming a doer, looking into the mirror and allowing for the Word to examine our thought, word, and deed behavior will initiate an agenda to mortify those things in conflict with God, and open the door to build up our inner man.

Pre-Section Questions Answered

The pre-section question asked what doing means, as opposed to being a doer in number 13. In these verses doing reflects the acts of replicating Jesus' works, whether that be just listening to someone, giving out a glass of water, or exerting the power gifts to reverse out terminal illnesses. They are all important to God, yes, each one! Jesus did imply to His followers to hear and act on His teachings, to build on Him, the rock, and to pick up the cross and follow Him. In doing so, because we're in Him, His light bestow grace through our personalities and we become effective!

Personal Commentary

In Matt 25:31-46 parable about the Final Judgment, Jesus explains what separates and severs the sheep from the goats. There are 6 specific items. In James 2:14-26, Jesus brother explains how faith without works is dead. So both Jesus and James do imply that doing is very essential, as if doing is a verification of salvation. Jesus implies that saints will produce a harvest of good works, like the examples He showed us, or whatever we are confident in pursuing.

Pre-Section Ouestions Answered

The pre-section questions asked what "I Never Knew You" meant, and who does it apply to? The Apostle John answers this clearly in 1 John 2:4-6.

'Whoever says, I know Him [I perceive, recognize, understand, and am acquainted with Him] but fails to keep and obey His commandments (teachings) is a liar, and the Truth [of the Gospel] is not in him. But he who keeps (treasures) His Word [who bears in mind His precepts, who observes His message in its entirety], truly in him has the love of and for God been perfected (completed, reached maturity). By this we may perceive (know, recognize, and be sure) that we are in Him: Whoever says he abides in Him ought [as a personal debt] to walk and conduct himself in the same way in which He walked and conducted Himself.' 1 John 2:4-6

Verse Recap

- 1. Posers fail to keep and obey Jesus' teachings, and don't build on Jesus
- 2. Successful saints observe Jesus' teachings, in their entirety, no cherry picking

3. Successful saints must walk and conduct them self in the same way Jesus conducted Himself.

This does differentiate who are the posers and who are those who build on the rock, and who will enter the kingdom of heaven. The requirements to enter heaven has to do with observing Jesus' teachings, in their entirety, and no cherry picking. So, 'I never knew you', has more to do with those false teachers who God identifies as posers, and who are not entering in. Turning a deaf ear to doing the will of God is bad judgement. It may be expedient, but long term a real bad idea. Building on Jesus (as the rock), and engaging in Divine Nature are essential.

Personal Commentary

I've wondered if "I Never Knew You" was a literal issue with Jesus because a church member never entered into Jesus, but only entered into a church membership venue, that had revised out the experiential and authentic gospel attributes of knowing Jesus and knowing Holy Spirit? In studying the subject severed I found this to be the most complexing because if we are doing miracles, especially in Jesus' name, where God is getting the glory, why the severance? Jesus is addressing true and false teachers here, specifically sincere Christians verses posers (counterfeits). John explains it well in 1 John 2:4-6 (above). On another perspective, miracles are never dependent on the inner life of any Christian, but are all permitted by the Divine power of Holy Spirit. Miracles glorify God, not us. If we are glorified, then we're in trouble (deceived).

In Matthew 7:21-23 parable Jesus teaches saints to hear and do, not just to hear only. Traditional version of the gospel have revised Jesus' authentic experiential version to a synthetic, to be a hearer only, which Jesus refers to as sand. To hear and do is the inward foundation that Christ laid (and referred to to build on rock). Foundation of sand don't offer any real protection during storms. That is why so many religions have such a high failure rate. Only building on Jesus Himself qualifies for kingdom benefits. When saints do hear and do build their ministry on the foundation of Jesus, bestowing grace, endearment, and miracles become normal and prevalent, because of who we are grafted into.

Pre-Section Questions Answered

The pre-section question asked about the imminence of forgiveness or consequences. Since Jesus had reconciled God to mankind and man to man, unforgiveness is considered rebellion from God's perspective. The 5 Levels of Reconciliation cover the fundamental and technical details. It also seems that we are binding God to our free will, by not forgiving others, we're restricting Him from forgiving us. In that unforgiveness God can hand you over to jailers to be tortured.

Personal Commentary

If I forgive, then Father will also forgive me. I must forgive, to be forgiven. Simply put, anyone desiring mercy from God, must show mercy to others. No mercy shown, the God mercy bank window is closed, it is cause and effect, and people initiate.

Slothfulness, laziness and those who are no way serviceable, or beneficial to humanity to the glory of God and the good of others, will be reckoned with as unprofitable servants. Merely avoiding sin seems insufficient. Doing God's will is Jesus' inferred model so our implied agenda.

The pre-section question asked about the practices of justice, false propriety, and warned them of God's perception of them as being tombs (or dead to God). This exchange offers a glimpse of the disappointment God had from the Pharisees and set up the purpose for Jesus discarding the entire mediated clergy laity system.

Personal Commentary

The Pharisees, under the Law, were under a compulsion by the Law to pay 10% on all goods to support the Levites, who operated the clergy system, and the temple services. Jesus is telling them that they're exacting down to a mint leaf (and no more, what they are going to pay), while disregarding justice and discarding bestowing God's will, placed them in a position of separation with God.

The pre-section question asked about blocking people from finding and entering into the kingdom of God, better known as sabotage. God knew what was going on there. Jesus did warn the Pharisees with condemnation due to how they treated widows. Jesus warned the Pharisee that their discipleship methods are a failure and evil. Pre-Section Questions Answered

The pre-section question have addressed some very important issues. Paul did identify Jesus as the only true Gospel foundation, which means that building our life on "another Jesus foundation", one that has been revised to accommodate traditional values, would be an invalid option, for the purpose of passing the fire test. Paul does report that each persons works are evaluated, and are either burned up or will reward them.

Personal Commentary

Paul did identify Jesus as the only true Gospel foundation, which implies His gospel as the only valid one to use. Every saint expresses the gospel in their own personality, and develops their own style and ways. Paul says we have the leverage to do that, and encourages everyone to be all they can be, in their new identity. Personal ways of expressing the gospel are always extraordinary to witness. As long as the witness is pure and doesn't morph into an interpretation that will disqualify a "good works reward", we should keep bestowing those graceful works. But what disqualifies rewards? What makes our works ineligible for treasures in heaven?

Paul infers that the issue of the new temple of God, each individual believer them self, hosting Holy Spirit, is a primary value for hearing, obeying abiding in Christ, and doing God's will. Paul warns that any devaluing of this principle is corruption and grounds for destruction. Since it has to do with Holy Spirit, and since Jesus warned about disrespecting Holy Spirit would be an unforgivable sin, it makes sense. Holy Spirit is primary in the new covenant relationship with God, and Jesus paid the price for this level of integration. God made man to be like Him, and now has supplied His own Spirit to each saint transparently, to unify us with God. This is highly personal, experiential, authentic, and empirically provable. Pentecost was just a beginning.

By revising the gospel to reverting the temple to a building like the Jewish temple system, and re-identifying saints as sinners who require an earthly religious mediator (implying Jesus as mediator isn't enough), Paul is implying that these are disqualifying theological strategies that will burn up the good works of believers. So if these bring ineligibility to rewards by resisting Jesus' authentic experiential gospel and restricting Holy Spirit, it also explains the lack of enlightenment and empowerment as well. Because the church has replaced Holy Spirit with the Bible, they've entered a wide road theology, not a Narrow Road experience, and since have become weak. Jesus warned about traditionalizing His gospel, and we've seen the effect. Paul is referring to acts that will burn up our good works reward. It doesn't devalue the gospel message getting someone saved though. God, in His mercy, is allowing the revisionist perpetrators to maintain salvation.

To recap, if practicing the gospel in a way that is degrading Jesus' authentic model, by redefining saints as sinners, and replacing Holy Spirit with the Bible, and shifting the temple identification to a building from the rightful individual heirs it belongs to (and others issues), these practices may disqualify our treasure in heaven rewards. See next card for further details. I don't think I want to position myself to barely escape through a wall of flames, so I'm reviewing these with much more intensity.

Pre-Section Questions Answered

The pre-section question asked about a very important issue, counterfeits. The Apostle Paul publicly reports that Jesus is the only authentic model approved of, as a Gospel model. Saints should be building upon Jesus' foundation. Both Jesus' teachings and His examples are the only valid ones verified from God. The fact that he specifies this foundation should make us aware of other foundations (potentially). These works that we do become known by God and are tested by fire for potential rewards. This helps us to avoid the counterfeits, and keep our rewards.

Personal Commentary

This passage gives wide leverage as to how we are presenting the gospel. This is necessary due to the fact that every saint must bestow the gospel grace within the framework of their own personality. It also reigns in any activities not in compliance with Jesus teachings. Even though the foundation of the rock (Jesus) is perfect, it doesn't ensure each building that is built on the rock (personal or corporate doctrine) is in alignment with Jesus' Narrow Road standards. In order to pass the test, it would seem we'd need to be aware of and compliant with Jesus' teachings (as the Rock). If not how would we know our witness is alignment with His foundation?

One More Thing On Our Works Passing Through The Fire

- "For I have come down from heaven to do the will of God who sent me, not to do my own will. And **this is the will of God, that I should not lose even one of all those he has given me**, but that I should raise them up at the last day. For it is my Father's will that all who see his Son and believe in him should have eternal life. I will raise them up at the last day."" (John 6:38-40 NLT)

Personal Observation

Our ability to unify and intervene for each other would seem essential, when recognizing what Jesus did for His disciples in the garden.

Personal Commentary

The Apostle Paul warned saints of corrupt deceptions, which places onus on us to know truth, in order to discern any counterfeits. After reading Jesus' teachings and sitting through other peoples interpretations of the Gospel, I now know why Paul exposed this. We should become aware of this if we are going to acknowledge and overcome issues like this.

Pre-Section Questions Answered

The pre-section question asked the question of a different Gospel than the one presented by Jesus and Paul. He identifies some factors saint should become aware of to succeed in retrieving the benefits of Jesus authentic Gospel.

Personal Commentary

The Apostle Paul didn't leave anything to be interpreted liberally or in any false matter. He even condemned anyone who would revise the Gospel from the authentic Jesus had established. He clearly defined how deception had entered into the church and how deception had revised "another gospel". Today ritualism and revised theological interpretations have developed over 50,000 denominations. "Theological philosophy" parading around as the gospel has been supported by liberal, weak minded hirelings to mislead humanity, and has been operating since the early church. Paul made it very clear that forms without Holy Spirit and without authentic attributes are unacceptable and not God's standard.

If this is the case how do we differentiate between Jesus' gospel and the "other gospel" Paul indicates? Here are a few observations:

- 1. TRUE CHRISTIAN IDENTIFICATION: Believers are saints, (not sinners), citizens of heaven, grafted into Jesus (not Israel), have bypassed death and begin their eternal life on earth at salvation, and directly connected to Holy Spirit personally (no mediator or covering required). When each believer is identified as a sinner it is a clear indication the identifying source is "another gospel".
- 2. DIRECTLY CONNECTING: Relationship with God is direct, non-mediated, no covering required, and with complete access to God 24/7/365. Having a conversation with another person is beneficial and can be very enlightening and encouraging. But it shouldn't replace the direct relationship saints have with God. When believers are relegated to underlings subject to hirelings it is a clear indication the delegators are practicing "another gospel".
- 3. TRUE TEMPLE: A major factor is identification of the current Temple, which is each saint (them-self), not the building church services are held in, not the 501C3, and certainly not any compulsory church agenda (like mandating attendance and financial obligatory contributions). When a church pulpit messages members are getting fed there and are under their covering it is a clear indication they are practicing "another gospel".
- 4. ABIDING PRINCIPLE: If a person is a saint, Holy Spirit's indwelling begins to deliver and discern Heavenly Standards, what is acceptable and what is unacceptable to God. God does have an absolute affect on saints: darkness is diminished and offensive sin is brought to light. Seeds that take root sprout, grow, and have some type of fruitful breakthrough. Either a seed takes root and begins growing or it gets choked out. Just like a seed in the ground produces growth, those Holy Spirit driven heavenly standards (which are expected to be embraced and assimilated) also render fruit. If no fruitfulness ensues the seed didn't take root, and salvation should be re-visited.
- 5. INTELLECTUAL RECALIBRATION: Renewing our mind with Logos and Rhema (Holy Spirit teaching) will recalibrate our identity to add Godly characteristics to each personality:

- a) Spiritual Narrow Road Standards to become aware of, emulate, and operate from
- b) Mortifying the flesh, identifying gratification causing blockages that prevent growth
- c) Edifying the spirit, identifying practices to build our inner man to overcome and overrule

These attributes and more have been revised by too many church leaders, debasing Jesus' model, and misleading too many believers.

Synthetic Debases Authentic

Anytime an original model is reduced it does carry an effect.

The further each revision is distanced from the original the less effective it usually is. This is due to the replacement of original standards, truths, and practices.

Hence, the better we find and stay on Jesus' narrow road model, the more effective and the more favored we should be!

Conclusion Commentary

Conclusions are always self deduced, based on the revelation and integration of information. I came away from this study with a new revelation of the effect of how God's standards really does have on each individual, beneficially as well as consequentially. I'm in awe, and humbled by how much transmitted authority God has empowered each individual with. He is generous. We should recognize, that by our own doing, we can be severed from God, we can be severed from our potential reward in heaven, or we can sever ourselves from demonic influence, either temptations or symptoms. Once we recognize these three important truths their principles will be more assimilable into our lives and the more successful we'll become. Breakthroughs are a result of an initiated effort. In the right direction we can be benefited significantly. Resistance to truth and enlightenment only block breakthroughs.

Practices That Optimize


I've heard "car guys" discuss the right fuel mixtures that promote optimum performance, as well as substandard fuels that will choke performance and shorten engine life. We know how to calibrate and recalibrate to get the best efficiency and performance on mechanics, biology, and engineering, but seem lax in the spiritual area. We tend to fizzle in this area, or just deflect and side-step the subject as unimportant. The sinners don't want to deal with something that they can't control, so they dismiss it anyway. Unbelieving believers often engage in legalistic practices whereby they have replaced the individual Saint as being the temple of God with their 501c3 Church Bldg. model, and replaced Holy Spirit's indwelling with tradition. They're still gathering, preaching, studying, and doing great works, but resist using Jesus keys that He authenticated His original version with. They've had to vote to shift their practices to sustain these practices. Then they hire a hireling to administer back to them within the framework they've allowed (cherry picked). This make

members feel good about themselves.

There are spiritual foods that optimize and others that will choke off performance and shorten our life in the spiritual area too. I've found these truths candid and sincerely honest. Here are some highlight recaps of the report.

Severed Categories

- 1. <u>Severed from God</u> (Card # 1-12, 15-20, 23-24)
- 2. Severed from my reward (Card # 21-22)
- 3. <u>Severed from demonic toxicity (Card # 13-14)</u>



Yes, we're all going to know the truth. Nobody is immune. We see that exercising our rights to sin is futile and has consequences. I'd just like to leverage the beneficial facts in my favor (*for once*). So I'm preparing myself for the best potential result, here on earth and for my own future in heaven. I always thought that dealing with severed had to do with pruning away my own sinful thoughts, words, and deeds. But now I see that for those who actually enter into Jesus' authentic Christianity we can do the severing of evil, darkness, temptations, and symptoms. We can reap the benefits of abiding in Christ and we can help others do the same!

Sin Cycle Factors

- 1. **Temptation** is the act of tempting; enticement or allurement
- 2. **Desire** is a personal longing or craving, as for something that satisfies
- 3. Conceive is to experience or form; to consider, accept, and activate
 - a) Conception gives birth to or initiates sin (beginning the separation process)
 - b) Sin gives birth to or initiates death (completing the separation process)

Regarding the definition of death having to do with being separated from God versus our physical bodily expiration please review details in The 5 Elementals. The greek word *thánatos* (2288) defines death as a separation from life forever by dying without first experiencing God's gift of salvation. Everybody should know this. This cycle is better down as THE DEATH SPIRAL. James breaks it down very simply for each to know how it works. It's not complicated.

What Is The Source of Defilement?

Jesus reports that all defilement is sourced from our own heart; our own thoughts, words and deeds. This places the onus on each person to make sure their own soil is clean and able to grow the seeds of truth that Jesus is generating. We, individually will either accept Jesus' truth or we will reject it. We, individually are the source of defilement or of veneration. Only our own free will can generate our future. We have to own this to benefit from it!

Jesus Is The Only Foundation

Paul did identify Jesus as:

- 1. the **only** true Gospel foundation that saints should be building upon
- 2. the **only** authentic model approved as a Gospel model
- 3. the **only** teachings and examples that are valid and verified from God

The fact that Paul specifies this foundation should make us aware of other foundation potentials, which could mean building our life on "another Jesus foundation". Another one that has been revised to accommodate traditional values, would be an invalid option, for the purpose of passing the fire test, or something worse.

Why Is The Truth Of Christianity So Important?

Every person who becomes a Christian, by shifting from a sinner to a saint, is indwelled by Holy Spirit, completing the conversion dynamic, and beginning the adoption process. Yes, Christians are adopted into God's family, become citizens of heaven, bypass death, and are in alignment for

direct benefits and teachings from the Bible and Holy Spirit. Now if someone claims to be a prophet, pastor, or teacher, and denies these truths of Jesus' gospel, by revising it, that person is not from God. This is why knowing the truth is so important, and why the truth has so many vantage points. Successful saints observe Jesus' teachings, in their entirety, no cherry picking. Successful saints must walk and conduct them self in the same way Jesus conducted Himself.

Grace

Grace is God's new way to deal with a humanity, that needed extra care to qualify for eternal life. The law was great at letting people know what disqualified them from God's eternal life, but nobody could live that perfectly. When Jesus came from heaven, and did live perfectly, He qualified to act as our pascal lamb and actually absorb all of our sin. Instead of just being temporarily cleansed, like the Jewish system provided, God permanently removed the sin (purifying saints) and had all humanity potentially connected to God directly, and individually. Nullifying grace to return to a mediated system, to earn your way to God, or by being an underling under a hireling or covering is what Paul is referring to here. By returning to or directing others to practice a legalistic system, Paul says that you are severed from God. By testifying that Christ will be of no value to you by returning to the law looks like very clear validation that grace is the only way forward.

The pre-section question asked if backsliders are severed from God. Technically grace covers a lot of failure and for a period of time, for the indwelling of God to take effect on each saints behavior. Jesus gave three years for the tree to produce or tear it down. See this in the Parable of the Barren Fig Tree (Luke 13:6-9). This timeframe could be analogous to God's expectations for growth in believers.

Doer Dynamics (mortification)

James positions this as a form of self examination, using the Bible values and verses as the standards to reflect our current spiritual status. James reports that merely listening to the word doesn't validate salvation or eternal life (*this is reporting that obedience to Jesus teachings, morals, and standards are internal gospel validations*). If I don't do what it says, I've missed the mark. Missing the mark is described as being a sign of sin or being a sinner, and that, as we have seen, will separate us from God. James isn't advocating a works program, but to examine my behavior in compliance with God's kingdom standards. *See card #13 to revisit this subject*.

Doing Dynamics (edification & inspiration)

In these verses doing reflects the acts of replicating Jesus' works, whether that be just listening to someone, giving out a glass of water, or exerting the power gifts to reverse out terminal illnesses. They are all important to God, yes, each one! What matters here is that we hear, and do, bestowing God's grace to someone, thereby potentially helping Jesus reconcile them to God. Jesus did imply to His followers to hear and act on His teachings, to build on Him, the rock, and to pick up the cross and follow Him. Jesus really is our model. In doing so, because we're in Him, it's His light that bestow grace through our personalities and we become effective!


Invalidating Jesus Gospel

Jesus even addressed the issue of:

- 1. Invalidating the gospel by revising it with a traditional view, and exposed the hypocrisy of the hireling leadership.
- 2. Jesus told the Pharisees that they're exacting (minimizing what they are going to pay), while disregarding justice.
- 3. Jesus rebuked the Pharisee for weighing down others with burdens without EVER lifting a finger to help them.
- 4. Jesus rebuked the Pharisee for blocking people from finding and entering into the kingdom of God, better known as sabotage.
- 5. God knew what was going on then, and today.

Another Jesus - Another Gospel - Another Spirit

Every saint is entitled to practice the gospel within their own personality, but not to their own revised interpretation of "cherry picked" gospel factors. The Apostle Paul warned saints of corrupt deception in the church, at the time. Again, this places onus on saints to know truth, in order to discern counterfeits. The Apostle Paul didn't leave anything to be interpreted liberally or in any false matter. He even condemned anyone who would revise the Gospel from the authentic Jesus had established. He clearly defined how deception had entered into the church and how deception had revised "another gospel". Today ritualism and revised theological interpretations have developed over 50,000 denominations. Theological philosophy parading as the gospel, being supported by liberal interpretations to weak minded hirelings and misleading humanity, has been operating since the early church. Paul made it very clear that forms without Holy Spirit and without authentic attributes are unacceptable and not God's standard.



Severed From God

Being SEVERED from God can only be from our own effort as a result of our own doing. God isn't putting up any barriers. That is Satan's job. God sent Jesus to break down the barriers and He has. God gave everyone free will, to exercise, at their own discretion the means to accept Jesus or reject Jesus. Since God judges everyone according to what they have selected, if they have rejected Jesus, they've already judged and doomed themselves. If someone rejects Holy Spirit, they're really rejecting Jesus' finished work on Calvary. Jesus warned everyone about blaspheming

Holy Spirit, and also indicated that it carries an irreversible death sentence.

We've covered many subjective positions of severed in this series to alert and inform anyone interested in this level of intelligence. Here are some highlights to some of the big ones:

- 1. **Posers**: Posers failed to keep and obey Jesus' teachings, #15
- 2. **Rebellious**: Paul informed the church and humanity that carnality carried too far has horrible consequences. Consensual sexual sin, is still sin, and carries with it retribution. #9-11
- 3. **Foolish Behavior**: There are so many warning on foolish behavior. Half the virgins were severed because they were foolish. Warnings against foolishness is a prevalent Bible theme. # 3, #12
- 4. **Unforgiveness**: This is known to be so stupid because it is like drinking poison yourself and waiting for the one you refuse to forgive to become effected. How does that work? In reality unforgiveness is considered rebellion from God's perspective because Jesus has already paid the price for our forgiveness, so if we're not forwarding that, something is missing here. #16

As simple as the gospel is, there seem to be many potholes and a few black holes to become aware of and to avoid. Scriptural clarification on these issues hopefully has helped. It has been cathartic to research this and very humbling to prepare it to share with you. *Caveat Emptor!*

HOW GOD REPAYS

Have you ever thought of how God actually deals with everyone after their life is over on earth? How does He reward, benefit or penalize? Here are some scriptures that were scattered between the old and new testaments that deliver a consistent message and that answers this question.

- "But when you give to someone in need, don't let your left hand know what your right hand is doing. Give your gifts in private, and your Father, who sees everything, will reward you." Matthew 6:3-4 NLT
- "Also to You, O Lord, belong mercy and loving-kindness, for You render to every man **according to his work**. Psalm 62:12 AMPC
- ""I, the LORD, search the heart, I test the mind, Even to give to each man according to his ways, **According to the results of his deeds**." Jeremiah 17:10 NASB

Commentary

In the nature of Christianity, saints profess to honor Jesus and His standards. Since Christians are the wise virgins and hypocrites the foolish ones, the lamps (signifying commitment and purity) are supposed to be operating consistently, not erratically. Remember these virgins are waiting for their husband, to get married, so signifying a wise Christian status of staying pure while waiting for Jesus' to return.

Doer - The Acts Of Overcoming Sin

Do not merely **listen** to the word, and so **deceive** yourselves. **Do what it says.**Anyone who listens to the word but does **not** do what it

Anyone who listens to the word but does **not** do what it **says** is like someone who looks at his face in a **mirror** and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately **forgets** what he looks like.

But whoever looks **intently** into the perfect law that gives freedom, and **continues** in it—not **forgetting** what they have heard, but **doing** it—they will be blessed in what they do. (James 1: 22-25).

Biblical standards reflect who we really are, by comparison, just like a mirror reflects our image. The Bible exposes our personal corruption, pet sins, blockages, and reveal to us why we fail. When the light hits the darkness within us, we need to overcome those deficiencies and vanquished them. Doing represents allowing for the word of truth to expose sin and then we intentionally shift our life into becoming an over comer on each issue. It seems that only in overcoming are we doer's, building on the rock, not just hearing.

Doing: The Acts Of Replicating Jesus' Works

- 1 Saints who **hear** and **act** on Jesus' words are wise and **build** their homes upon rock, not sand. (Matthew 7:24)
- 2 the seeds that fell on the good **soil** produced a huge harvest." (Luke 8:15 NLT)
- 3 anyone that **professes** to have **faith** in Jesus should have good **works** to show for it. (James 2:14 AMP)

These are the four words that we definitely want to avoid hearing!

"Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,'
will **enter** the kingdom of heaven,

but only the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.

Many will say to me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not **prophesy** in your name and in your name **drive** out demons and in your name perform many **miracles**?' Then I will tell them plainly,

'I never knew you.

Away from me, you evildoers!' (Matt 7:21-23)

"Then the King will turn to those on the **left** and say, 'Away with you, you **cursed** ones, into the eternal **fire** prepared for the **devil** and his demons. (Matt 25:41)

Turning a deaf ear to doing the will of God earns this response from Jesus, "Depart from me".

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16 WHAT DOES IF YOU DON'T FORGIVE MEAN?

Jesus has reconciled man to man, signifying an implication that forgiveness is in order

But if you do not **forgive** others, then your Father will **not** forgive your transgressions. (Matt 6:15)

If you forgive, your heavenly Father will also forgive. We must forgive, as we hope to be forgiven. Those who desire to find mercy with God, must show mercy to their brethren. Christ came into the world as the great Peacemaker, not only to reconcile us to God, but one to another. Matthew Henry Commentary

In anger his master **handed** him over to the **jailers** to be **tortured**, until he should pay back all he owed. "This is how my heavenly Father will treat each of **you** unless you **forgive** your brother or sister from your **heart**." (Matt 18:34-35)

Unprofitable Servants Reward

And throw that worthless servant **outside**, into the **darkness**, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. (Matt 25:30)

Slothfulness, laziness and those who are no way serviceable to the glory of God, or the good of others, will be reckoned with as unprofitable servants. Merely avoiding sin seems insufficient, per this parable. **Doing God's will is Jesus' model.**

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17 DID JESUS WARN OF FALSE DOCTRINE?

Jesus did warn saints of both false doctrines and hirelings

"He was also saying to them,

"You are experts at setting aside the commandment of God in order to keep your tradition.

For Moses said, 'HONOR YOUR FATHER AND YOUR MOTHER '; and, 'HE WHO SPEAKS **EVIL** OF FATHER OR MOTHER, IS TO BE PUT TO **DEATH** '; but you say, 'If a man says to his father or his mother, whatever I have that would help you is **Corban** (that is to say, given to God),' you no longer **permit** him to do anything for his father or his mother; **thus invalidating the word of God by your tradition** which **you** have handed down; and you do **many** things such as that."" (Mark 7:9-13 NASB)

Denominational doctrine, in conflict with God's Word and Jesus teachings, become a "WIDE ROAD" diversion, interfering with God's real agenda for His saints. Only Jesus teachings, God's Word, are acceptable for true practices.

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18 DID JESUS BRING SCATHING REBUKES?

Jesus Rebuked Pharisee Leaders 1/3

But woe to you Pharisees! For you pay tithe of mint and rue and every kind of garden herb, and yet disregard justice and the love of God; but these are the things you should have done without neglecting the others.

Woe to you Pharisees! For you love the chief seats in the synagogues and the respectful greetings in the market places.

Woe to you! For you are like concealed **tombs**, and the people who walk over them are unaware of it. Luke 11:42-44

Jesus addresses the issues of true justice, false propriety, deception and corruptness that makes leaders appear to God as graves (so they're DOA: dead on arrival!)

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19 DID JESUS REBUKE LEGALISM?

Jesus Rebuked Pharisee Leaders 2/3

But He said, "Woe to you lawyers as well! For you weigh men down with burdens hard to bear, while you yourselves will not even touch the burdens with one of your fingers.

Woe to you! For you build the tombs of the prophets, and it was your fathers who killed them. So you are witnesses and approve the deeds of your fathers; because it was they who killed them, and you build their tombs. For this reason also the wisdom of God said, 'I will send to them prophets and apostles, and some of them they will kill and some they will persecute, so that the blood of all the prophets, shed since the foundation of the world, may be charged against this generation, from the blood of Abel to the blood of Zechariah, who was killed between the altar and the house of God; yes, I tell you, it shall be charged against this generation. 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21 DID PAUL IDENTIFY 1 TRUE FOUNDATION?

Paul Identifies Jesus As The Only True Foundation

'For no one can **lay** any foundation other than the one we already **have**—Jesus Christ.

Anyone who **builds** on that foundation may use a variety of **materials**—gold, silver, jewels, wood, hay, or straw.

But on the judgment day, fire will **reveal** what kind of work each builder has done. The fire will **show** if a person's work has any **value**. If the work survives, that builder will receive a **reward**.

But if the work is **burned** up, the builder will suffer great **loss**. The builder will be **saved**, but like someone barely escaping through a wall of **flames**.

Don't you realize that **all** of you **together** are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God **lives** in you? God will destroy anyone who **destroys** this **temple**. For God's temple is holy, and **you** are that temple.'

1 Corinthians 3:11-17 NLT

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22 DID PAUL WARN OF COUNTERFEITS?

Recap Of Jesus As Only True Foundation

- 1. Only Jesus' **authentic** model is approved as a Gospel.
- 2. When we build upon this foundation, as saints in our **own** personality, our works will become known and **tested** by fire.
- 3. The **fire** will critically evaluate the character and **worth** of the work each person has done.
- 4. If the work **survives** this test, the saint will get their reward.
- 5. If the work is **burned** up under this test, that saint will suffer the **loss** of the potential reward, but they'll maintain salvation!
- 6. All saints should know that we are God's **temple**, His sanctuary, and that God's Spirit has His permanent dwelling in **us**.
- 7. If anyone hurts, corrupts with false teaching, or destroys any **temple**, God will **destroy** them.

This passage gives wide leverage as to how we are presenting the gospel. This is necessary due to the fact that every saint must bestow the gospel grace within the framework of their own personality. It also reigns in any activities not in compliance with Jesus teachings.

If anyone is preaching to you a gospel **different** from or contrary to that which you received [from us], let him be **accursed** (anathema, devoted to destruction, **doomed** to eternal punishment)!
