



**The Omnipresence
&
The Manifest Presence
of God**

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Introduction

Since I first read “The Manifest Presence of God”, I’ve seen other books that have relayed other peoples versions of this exciting dynamic. How Holy Spirit manifests His presence, in so many cases, are the best kept secrets, and the best testimonial stories ever. In “The Manifest Presence”, Walter Buettler reports that after many years of knowing about God, he realized He didn’t really know God. His story is very interesting, open and transparent. Walter went beyond seeking God for God’s blessings and sought God for Himself (to know God personally). He had a face-to-face personal relationship where he could have a two way conversation with God, was tutored with interesting teachings and was personally directed and empowered. This testimonial is how God engages us personally when we WAIT ON GOD.

I’ve always been very intrigued with those who actually connect with the manifest presence of God. In a day when there is too much pontification and not enough real experiential, it is refreshing to see how others have succeeded. How real is the omnipresence of God and how real is the manifest presence of God? We’re going to identify some basic definitions to help our understanding of these two items. Since I’ve studied this and other works Holy Spirit has prompted me to abide and witness this for myself, upon which He began to unpack some of my own blockages, and build me up to where I see and hear things differently. So I know if God can do this for me, He’ll do it for you as well!

WAITING ON GOD

WHAT IS OBSERVED FROM WAITING ON GOD?

1. The seeking of God involves waiting FOR God.
2. God has waited for men to wait for Him.
3. For those who wait for God there is a promised blessedness, without exception.

WHY DOES GOD KEEP MAN WAITING?

1. To silence man's natural spirit of restlessness and agitation.
2. To teach man of his unworthiness and a reverence for a holy God.
3. To increase man's desire for God so that God might have a greater opportunity for a better response.
4. To condition man's human faculties for better reception and submission for a fuller benefit of that which follows

THE PROPER CHARACTERISTICS OF OUR WAITING

1. Early in your day without procrastination and before other interests
2. Daily waiting should be systematic and not spasmodic
3. Watchfully, be alert to His response but without strain
4. Continually; it should be a mode of life and not merely a temporary expediency in time of need
5. Objectively; this waiting should have a definite purpose with Him being the principle objective
6. Expectantly; with confident and active expectation and not in a state of mere pious wishing
7. Patiently; calmly enduring the seemingly fruitless expenditure of time and effort in the realization that to hurry God is to find fault with Him. View it as an opportunity to grant God the extravagance of your best time!
8. Hopefully; with quiet, unwavering confidence in an ultimate response to God
9. Lovingly; this waiting should not be the waiting of a selfish beggar, but the waiting of a yearning lover
10. Preferentially; desiring Him in preference to anything else

Omnipresence

The omnipresence of God is important to understand so we know the difference of these two items.

Omnipresent Defined

Omnipresence is the state of being everywhere at once (or seeming to be everywhere at once), to be present everywhere simultaneously.

Omnipresent usually refers to Deity, and is defined as ***present in all places at the same time***. The Greek word Zōe life (2222) reports that all universal life (or life in the universe) ***is derived and sustained by God's self-existing life***. We see that if God is deriving and sustaining universal life in Himself this infers a coordination between Zōe Life and omnipresence. So we are all being sustained by God Himself, in His omnipresent Zōe Life! When we know we are already in His omnipresence, it should inspire us to reach for His manifest presence, especially with all its benefits.

Omnipresence Of God

Here are some factors to consider:

- Creator God has His presence in all nature, in the whole universe
- All human spirits are derived from God. That is how human lives are sustained. We operate out of His self-existent life, until we either select or reject His gospel.
- God has a conscience presence in each human being. Each person has a free will to embrace or reject God's love, mercy, warnings, and conviction of sin,. Everyone also has a free will to embrace Holy Spirit, where we find illumination, revelation, and inspiration.

Now that we're aware of the fact that we are already in the omnipresence of God, it might begin to change our references of how we relate to God. I was surprised to realize how it is God Who continues to sustain my own life, even in all the rebelliousness I put Him through. Since He was sustaining me, He saw it all. Humbly, I marvel at His ability to see past it all and still want to know me. But, since I found out God is absolute, and inviolable (unaffected by sin), the sin only effected me, not God. So that left the onus on me to realize I had to deal with my own choices.

Once I did, I was able to see the availability of the manifest presence of God, on earth, and in me, as it is in heaven. At this level of life, people see things differently because of the true illumination God delivers. Illumination removes the darkness so we see and hear more clearly. Revelation teaches us at much more advanced level, and allows people to absorb values heretofore impossible.

Manifest Presence

Manifest Defined

Manifest means to prove beyond a doubt, make obvious, demonstrate, or to reveal something. Indubitable means something is too obvious to doubt. Indubitable synonyms are veritable, undeniable, indisputable, irrefutable, unquestionable, incontrovertible, unarguable and incontestable.

God's Manifest Presence Defined

The manifest presence of God, Who is absolute, is indubitable, too obvious to doubt, in that its effects do enlighten, convict, heal, reveal, and create. This is sometimes referred as His glory. God's glory, on earth, will often mimic His heavenly environment, which doesn't allow for any sin, sickness or Satanic, which then, by itself, produces deliverance, healing and repentance. The testimonies on these are indisputable.

The Origination of The Manifest Presence On Earth

Jesus, as the Son of Man, was baptized by John the Baptist, where Jesus was indwelt by Holy Spirit and then proceeded to spend 40 days, 960 hours, alone with Holy Spirit. Jesus prayed, fasted and fellowshiped with Him. John the Baptist states that Jesus had Holy Spirit without measure, meaning being filled with God. Maybe that is why Jesus states infers, on earth, as it is in heaven, as a precedent to target for our own experiences. Jesus then spent much time retreating alone to spend more time with Holy Spirit, as a primary practice, to model for His followers.

Saints Replicating Jesus' Example

Duplicating this environment is possible through Holy Spirits infilling, waiting on God, and praying in tongues, and is a kingdom standard. This was initiated and practiced by Jesus (on earth, as it is in heaven), Who implies to His followers to do likewise, and carry on with His keys. Jesus did send all His followers to the upper room where they all became baptized by Holy Spirit.

Because God is absolute He can and does bring in His heavenly presence on earth *where He is asked to come*. When God does manifest His presence there are effects. Some of these effects are significant illumination, removing darkness that convicts us of our sinful ways. Revelation can teach us new factors we weren't able to interpret or understand before.

Human keys to effect God's manifest presence: Divine presence, actual personal relationship with Holy Spirit (the Person of God on earth), for counsel, direction, empowerment:

1. Salvation; believing and verbally acknowledging Holy Spirit
2. Intentionally and quietly waiting on God - Solitary Confirmation (see chart on page 3)
3. Talk to Holy Spirit, discuss your life and all parts of it
4. Practice of tongues to build inner man and arrest flesh, temptations, and symptoms
5. Listen to worship music, hear the message and enter in, and meditate on Jesus' teachings

Manifest Presence Biblically Observed

Manifest is easily noticed or perceived; obvious; plain. Manifest is to show plainly; reveal or display: to prove beyond doubt.

- *“But God raised Him to life on the third day and caused Him to be **manifest** (to be plainly seen),” (Acts 10:40)*
- *“This was now the third time that Jesus **revealed Himself** (appeared, was manifest) to the disciples after He had risen from the dead.” (John 21:14)*
- *“[But] he who commits sin [who practices evildoing] is of the devil [takes his character from the evil one], for the devil has sinned (violated the divine law) from the beginning. The reason the Son of God was made **manifest (visible) was to undo (destroy, loosen, and dissolve) the works the devil [has done].**” (1 John 3:8)*

More Manifest Presence Observations

Manifest is defined as easily noticed or perceived; obvious; plain. Manifest is to show plainly; reveal or display: to prove beyond doubt. So when Jesus appeared after His resurrection, He manifested himself so the disciples could believe, beyond a doubt (Acts 10:40, John 21:14). There is an omnipresence and a manifest presence of God. Omnipresence is life itself, that God has derived and is sustaining but manifest presence established heavenly standards in plain sight, like a miracle healing, enlightenment, inspiration, etc.. *So why is this important? Why would I be interested if I can never access these features? What's the point?*

We can access these features and much more, if we're interested in pursuing Jesus' authentic model where Holy Spirit baptizes saints with tongues of fire. Three questions to ponder:

1. Do saints have the capability to access Holy Spirit's manifest presence to exert heavenly standards, and to change the atmosphere?
2. Does praying in tongues induce Holy Spirit's manifest presence?
3. Will persevering in praying in tongues exert the enforcement of enlightenment and empowerment?

The answer to all three are yes. Whenever we exert the gift of tongues, temptations must flee, and the spiritual atmosphere shifts to peace, comfort, and generally an illuminating model. Salvation induces the indwelling of Holy Spirit where the saint and God are completed, made whole, and made like God.

Once we recognize that all saints do have the capability to access Holy Spirit's manifest presence, establishing heavenly standards, then things begin to change. But if we're unaware or resistant to this truth, — then these promises will not apply (and unfortunately won't come to pass). — Whatever we believe and place our faith does actually carry an overriding impact.

Praying in a prayer language, will exert significant influence, and persevering in prayer, even in quiet meditation or our native language, can exert a maximum penetration, and a breakthrough. *Why?* - Because God is absolute, and the closer we get to Him, the more effective He is. Jesus told us that we can have what we say. Peter reports that, as we practice the 7 pillars of the divine

nature, our capacity increases. Now, just imagine how we can exert the enforcement of heavenly standards, (*on earth as it is in heaven*), and the effects this could have on our self, and wherever we direct it.

So, if the manifest presence of God is available to anyone who will activate it, with all its benefits, why don't more take advantage of it?

Reason #1 is their unaware of the manifest presence potential.

Reason #2 is their too inundated with other agendas and peer pressure that restricts Godliness.

When we freely choose to practice, *like Jesus did*, in getting away alone with God, *privately*, Holy Spirit can then *impact* us with specific teachings and understandings that *God has for us!*

Manifest Presence Effects

Listing Of Manifest Presence Demonstrations

These standards do expose darkness, then bestow a beneficial experiences of deliverance, healing and repentance. Dissolving the effects of sin and sickness are two of the main pillars Jesus initiated and implied that His followers were to follow. These are genuine effects for anyone and everyone that are present during a manifestation of God's presence. All humanity is qualified to enter in and receive, upon their own free will acceptance.

In the manifest presence of God, His Divine nature heavenly standards are deployed and are demonstrated by Holy Spirit on earth, by overriding all conflicting values:

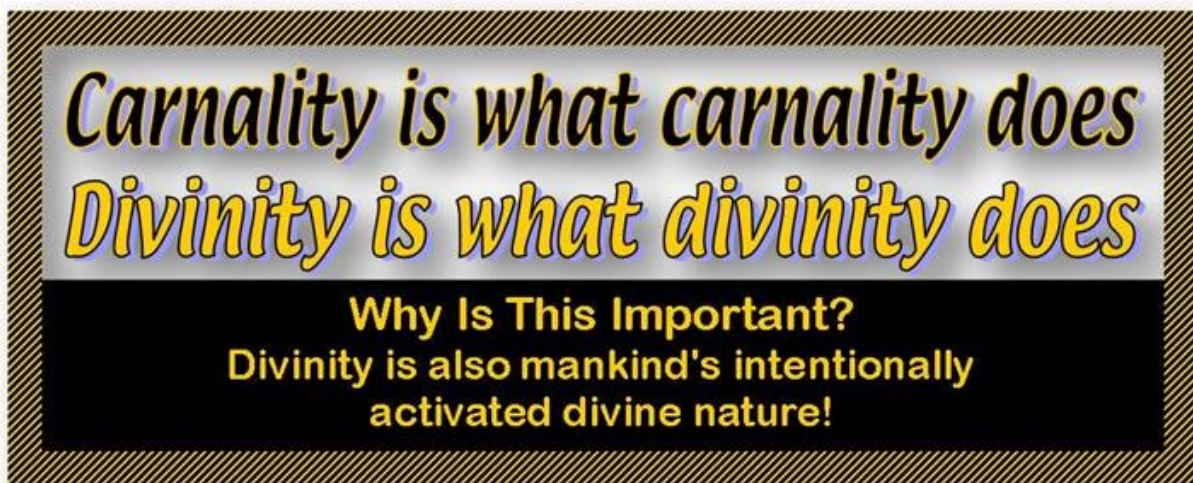
1. all sin is convicted, which drives a sozo agenda: healed, saved, delivered, and prospered
2. true peace calms fear and often deploys tranquility (as if in heaven), from fear to peace, or from victim to victor
3. expectations of miracles increase with many people and then they are more open to receive
4. direction; like
 - 4.1.a word of knowledge or direction, like a confirmation of an inner thought
 - 4.2.an unknown truth,
 - 4.3.answer, or a solution
5. destroy; to demonstrate a change in the physical makeup from sickness to health, activating the gifts by faith,
 - 5.1.to remove or dissolve something that does exist (temptation, symptom, bad menacing thoughts, etc.)
 - 5.2.symptoms diminish
 - 5.3.temptations become ineffective, rendered powerless, and must vacate immediately
6. create; to bring something into being that did not exist,
 - 6.1.either physically, intellectually, or emotionally,
 - 6.2.healthy tissue is transmitted
7. shift; to demonstrate a change in the spiritual makeup from
 - 7.1.sinner to saint,
 - 7.2.knowing we have eternal life now and

7.3.dare to expect God's blessings upon our lives, as evidence of adoption

One More Thing

Jesus manifested the presence of God, making God known, by demonstrating Godly attributes. Divinity and divine nature are both the demonstration of Godly attributes. Because Jesus was "at one with God", He was able to both distribute God's wisdom in teaching, and demonstrate His intervention with miracles. This is the example all saints are to follow, to emulate Jesus, having ears to hear Holy Spirit, eyes to see needs around us, and to distribute and demonstrate the gospel. As we extend the same values Jesus did, we are often making Him known (like He did His Father), and we are manifesting Holy Spirit's presence, peace, and power, for God to revive, heal, and prosper all who come to Him. As people encounter and experience, forgiveness, mercy, acceptance (saved), and healing interactions it becomes unmistakable that this form of "presence" is a manifested form. These are divine nature encounters, the same Jesus demonstrated.

God manifested His very own presence in His Son, Jesus, Who made Him known. Today, saints, who are at one with God through Jesus, operate in the divine nature (divinity), endowed with transmitted authority directly from Holy Spirit (within them), to manifest more of God's presence, peace, and power, emulating Jesus!



A Few Interesting Q&A Factors

- ❑ If the manifest presence implies a heavenly standard of sinlessness (perfection), health and prosperity, then would the lack thereof indicate we missed the mark? **The lack of the heavenly standards Jesus delivered to each of us is an indicator that we missed some of the target and may imply a need for a greater infilling. Since Jesus declared “on earth, as it is in heaven”, and there is no sin or sickness there, technically we shouldn’t have any either.**
- ❑ As joint heirs of Kingdom dynamics with Jesus, and recipients of our own copy of Jesus' own heavenly keys, can saints call in the manifest presence of Holy Spirit and exert enforcement to override and dissolve Satan's symptoms and works? **As joint heirs of Kingdom dynamics with Jesus, and recipients of our own copy of Jesus' own heavenly keys, saints can call in the manifest presence of Holy Spirit and exert enforcement to override and dissolve Satan's symptoms and works.**
- ❑ Sōzo is being saved, healed, or prospered, and is what Jesus delivered to mankind. Are these attributes all conditional and sporadic? If so, what are the conditions and the intervals (lead times)? **If we are in Jesus, we should be getting similar results ((John 14:12, 15:7-8, 8:31-2, & 2 John 1:9) Sōzo is our heavenly standard, so being saved, healed, or prospered, are all attributes that should be received by all saints directly from God.**
- ❑ Does any chronic presence of symptoms indicate or infer a higher degree of interventional requirements (from what is being practiced now)? **When chronic symptoms continue it is an indication of a higher degree of interventional requirements, medically, dietary, and spiritually. Persistent symptoms often required perseverant overriding prayer.**
- ❑ What are the two most prevalent restrictions to our personal breakthroughs?
 - **According to Jesus, Who said to let things happen according to our own belief. This would indicate our own belief system.**
 - **What I’ve witnessed is the two most prevalent restrictions to our personal breakthroughs are our own flesh (excuse obstacle), and our own will (resistance).**
 - **You can't do what you won't do. Everybody gets the benefits and consequences of the their own intentional choices, practices, and interventional prayer, to the degree that they exert awareness or denial, and effort, according to Jesus.**

Employ your own knees because activated tongues deploy the power of His keys! You can really manifest God’s presence, and get equipped to do miracles (which are easier to do than generally perceived). Then the true fruitfulness of the Christianity will blossom, multiply, and glorify God!



Proximity

Proximity is the property of being close together or the fact of being near.

The ***closer we get to God***, the closer we are to His manifest presence, or His empowerment. ***Why is is this important?*** Because God's presence delivers heavenly standards that impact temptations, symptoms, and circumstances, by dismissing and dissolving them. Jesus came to destroy the works of the devil, and He left us His keys empowered by Holy Spirit, the same One that empowered His earthly ministry. In addition to clearing bad things from our life, God wants to impact us with more illumination (enlightenment), revelation (answers and solutions), and inspiration (encouragement to deploy), to fulfill our individual destiny. God wants to favor His children, so of course those who make it there business, to humble them self to be closer to God their spiritual proximity is going to be impacted more by God's beneficial favor.

Since mankind cannot house or hold the omnipotent power of God, each believer's proximity to God, appears more important. Now we know why Jesus spent so many hours, alone with Holy Spirit. ***He knew His proximity to God was essential*** to His ministerial success (having Holy Spirit without measure). Since the disciple is not above the master, the onus is on each disciple to initiate Jesus' model. Jesus' professed model keys, *by His example*, start on our knees. In humility we plant ourself before God. That is where and how ***God makes all things grow!***

The opposite of light is darkness and the opposite of proximity is being far away, remote, distant. Today most people are inundated with so much to do, that their ability to break away to a closer proximity to God is never an option. Busyness, coupled with peoples ***unawareness of their ability to overcome***, and their ***schedule seems to delay*** them from entering into Jesus kingdom, leaves them perennially weakened. It often takes an event, like a catastrophe for so many, to ever even consider giving God a second look. We've all been there! ***But it doesn't take long to reconcile with God***, adjust our priorities, and ***initiate action***. It's all a matter of our own free will!

- *'But whenever someone turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. For the Lord is the Spirit, and wherever the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. So all of us who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord. And the Lord—who is the Spirit—makes us more and more like him as we are changed into his glorious image.'* (2 Corinthians 3:16-18)

1. Whoever turns to God the veil is taken away
2. All who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord
3. God makes us more and more like Him as we are changed into his glorious image

For the manifest presence to become a habitual environment, or close to that, the onus is on each of us, to personally generate an agenda, like Jesus did, to accommodate that. God has already generated His personal empowerment in Holy Spirit, and the favor of heavenly standard results. Those perfect results are already waiting for you. God has delivered abundant life on earth, for anyone who will persevere to abide in Jesus, by breaking through to divine nature benefits.

Mainstream Vs. Unconventional

Wouldn't you think that if everyone's life was known to be sustained by God's self-existent life, God's very own omnipresence, that His manifest presence would be even more valuable to them? Manifest presence **overshadows all carnality, sin, and depravity** with divinity, purity, and many other heavenly attributes realigning substances with a heavenly standard. Maybe the reason why His manifest presence isn't prevalent in society is because people are unaware of both the omnipresence and manifest presence of God.

ARE YOU AWARE THAT HIS MANIFEST PRESENCE HAS ALREADY GONE MAINSTREAM?

Jesus was able to introduce the anointing of the manifest presence and the gifts of the Spirit through the demonstration of miracles and healing. The Apostles and the early church in demonstrating the keys to activate the heavenly standards, followed Jesus' example, and tried bringing Christianity mainstream. Although miracles were very unconventional, and definitely not conforming to the accepted rules or standards of the Pharisees or Sadducees, their popularity made significant inroads into society. History reports of the resistance by the religious elite who openly opposed any aspect of Christianity, even though they were warned by their own Chief Justice to back off. Since then, the acceptance and rejection of the knowledge of both omnipresence and manifest presence, with the gifts, has waxed and waned continuously. Between the practice of open depravity in society and the political correctness of many of the traditionalized churches, taking miracles mainstream hasn't become prevalent, until recently.

Did Jesus Set A Precedent?

Up until recently much of the demonstration of Christian miracles has been sensationalized by a few superstars and basically held there. There are books outlining how they got there, by following Jesus' model of prayer and fasting. Today many have dedicated themselves to this and are seeing similar results to what Jesus did. **Jesus set the precedent** for all of His followers to receive these heavenly keys, and for all of them to experience Holy Spirit, and without measure! As more of humanity is seeking more of God, they are aligning with Holy Spirit, and with His manifest presence anointing, and quietly deploying His gifts.

MIRACLES ARE EXERTED FROM GOD'S PRESENCE AND TODAY, PEOPLE DO BELIEVE IN MIRACLES!

As a result, the subject of regular normal people replicating Jesus' natural and supernatural works, in anonymity and obscurity, even while living quiet lives, is very prevalent. It can be reported today that replicating Jesus' works has gone mainstream by the success of the millions of testimonials. **People today do believe in miracles**, so it's gone mainstream in the hearts and minds of humanity at large. So we should have more confidence in God and in His omniscience (*sustaining humanities lives*). The next item is to offer people the information to become equipped to do miracles (*which are easier to do than corporately perceived*). Then the true fruitfulness of real Christianity will blossom, multiply, and glorify God!

Purifying Humanity And Restoring Innocence

If purifying humanity and restoring innocence was the intended goal for Jesus to complete at the cross on Calvary, then what was the reason?

Jesus needed to create a brand new form of humanity that had no sin and that shifted each person as qualified to host and house Holy Spirit. In order to replicate Jesus' works, humanity had to be infilled with Holy Spirit, as Jesus was, so the gifts could be distributed and demonstrated. So the more we are filled with Godly divinity (divine nature), the less we are affected by carnality (carnal nature, sensuality, self-centeredness, etc.). Along with this divinity benefit, those who reach certain spiritual benchmarks have testified of seeing significant miracles, seeing and hearing Angels (and sensing demonic). Having Holy Spirit without measure is very eventful! It's different, but only for those who dare to quietly schedule and activate. The return to Godliness impacts our functional purity and drives the many benefits derived from Godly innocence. Remember innocence, not depravity, is how God created Adam.

IN ORDER TO REPLICATE JESUS' WORKS, HUMANITY HAD TO BE INFILLED WITH HOLY SPIRIT, AS JESUS WAS, SO THE GIFTS COULD BE DISTRIBUTED AND DEMONSTRATED.

Breaking Through Practices

Breaking through to new benchmarks are **private intentionally driven agendas**, planned and activated over time, to continually cultivate and edify our divine nature (being at one with Jesus and God). **Making it our own personal business** to plan, prepare and activate your Godliness practices of dialoguing with Holy Spirit, pressing into the act of speaking or singing in tongues, reviewing scripture references with new interpretation are all aspects of this activity. With new eyes to see and new ears to hear we become equipped to deploy the tactics Holy Spirit relates to us while we are in every ministry opportunity situation and assignment.

Having Holy Spirit manifest His presence wherever you're called, to change every environment toward health, purity, salvation, miracles, and peace, really does facilitate an impressive scorecard. Didn't you ever notice that, in the manifest presence He doesn't lose, and neither did Jesus! Did you know this performance level is supposed to extend to believing disciples?

“Therefore, brothers, be all the more diligent to confirm your calling and election, for if you practice these qualities you will never fall.” (2 Peter 1:10 ESV). Peter is discussing the practicing of the 7 pillars of the divine nature. This is a biblical standard.

Because all flesh and material is subject to the spiritual, and God is absolute, the demons must leave and then the flesh reacts accordingly, just like when Jesus exerted His authority keys. The real obstacle is us; to intentionally get into the practice of working with Holy Spirit directly, and then persevering to breakthrough our resistance.

Targeting Temptations & Symptoms

Saints standard of health and lifestyle is aligned with the heavenly standards Jesus delivered. When we crossover from sinner to saint our standards crossover as well, if we know about this Sözo factor. The Sozo factor is that all saints are saved, healed, and prospered, and are now under God alone (with Jesus as mediator) and seated with Jesus on His throne.

When carnal "hitch-hiker" temptations and symptoms attempt to lure us back into sinful practices and pain producing affliction setbacks, this indicates a need for deeper intervention, by and for the victim, and by the body of Christ. Holy Spirit exposes these culprits and empowers us to expel them, just like God did from heaven, because they are trespassing. Saints should stay with each person until a breakthrough emerges, and maybe schedule prayer teams to continue as needed. Everybody is important and if they are in the family of God, they should be treated as a family member. After all, each healing glorifies God, and the testimonial emanates broadly.

The practice of "tongues" amplifies Holy Spirit's presence that aggressively routes and dissolves both embedded temptations and symptoms, and helps our lives realign with the divine nature standards vs. the carnality sinner standards of the world. The keys of Jesus empower saints to bind and destroy any works of Satan. Since Satan and demonic were already expelled from heaven, and saints are now citizens of heaven, saints are empowered to expel all demonic symptoms and temptations from our own temple, which is aligned with Jesus, on His throne in heaven. Exerting enforcement is approved!

It is our right to target and liquidate any and all demonic temptations and symptoms that try to activate and affect us, or anyone else who asks for intervention. Heavenly standards must be maintained. Target all symptoms and all temptations and pray in tongues to amplify God's own manifest presence and to expel them. Make a list of items to target:

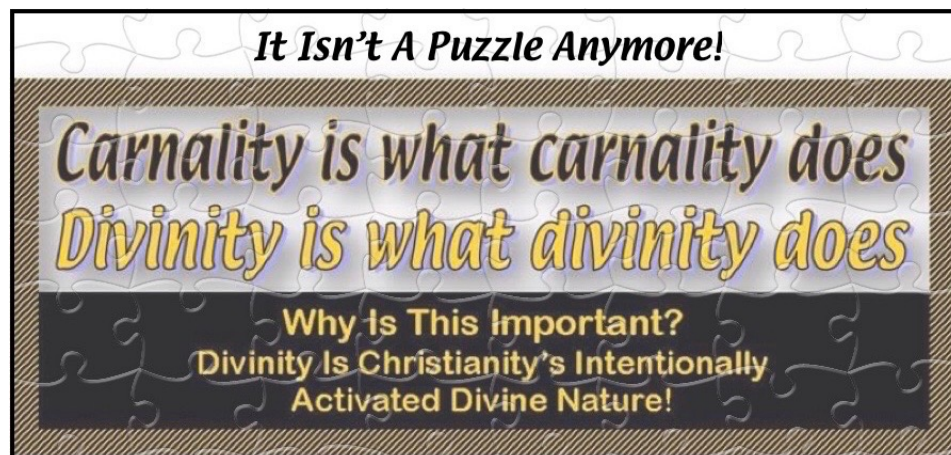
As A Result Of Intervention

As a result of any level of Godly intervention, you may find yourself thinking differently, feeling better, and reacting to things more reserved with less emotional fire (volatile reactions) and more compassion. These deliverance tactics that God allows us to practice do have a sincere effect, and make the right changes that are needed, to move ahead with His plans for the personal destiny Holy Spirit has for us.

How Renewal Works

- *I baptize you with water for repentance, but after me will come One more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. **He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire.** (Matthew 3:11)*
- *Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is **born of water and the Spirit.** (John 3:5)*
- *"Do not be conformed to this world (this age), [fashioned after and adapted to its external, superficial customs], **but be transformed* (changed) by the [entire] renewal of your mind** [by its new ideals and its new attitude], so that you may prove [for yourselves] what is the **good and acceptable and perfect** will of God, even the thing which is good and acceptable and perfect [in His sight for you]." (Romans 12:2 AMPC) *(3339. metamorphoó; to transform, transfigure.*
- *"He saved us, not because of any works of righteousness that we had done, but because of His own pity and mercy, by [the] cleansing [bath] of the new birth (regeneration) and **renewing of the Holy Spirit,**" (Titus 3:5 AMPC)*

Renewal works because of the overriding divine nature factors manifesting within us, as we embrace Holy Spirit. Jesus baptizes all saints with the Holy Spirit and with fire. Before Jesus humanity was blocked from renewal, holiness, or Godliness. He rewrote the standard, opened the door, and invites everyone to participate. Jesus knows that conformity to this world will prevent divine nature progress so He discourages it, and encourages entering in, so true transformation can begin. Once transformation begins renewal can follow from an initiated agenda.



Appendix A: Free Will

Free will is the most **powerful characteristic in all of creation**. Ask any parent about dealing with each child's free will selections, and the struggles from them.

We notice psychological strategies toward modifying other people's behavior from religion, to advertising, and military and corporate mindsets. **But true free will is in the heart of each of us**, where our deep beliefs are held. This free will can only be effected by our willingness to focus on what these beliefs are, and then openly evaluate them, one at a time.

Nobody has control over this, **but the person them-self**, unless they trade it for something else. But as the most powerful characteristic in all of creation, established by God for each individual, free will can flip "on a dime" as soon as it engages with enlightenment. So the **appetite for enlightenment** becomes a critical factor. I've witnessed this numerous times in ICU and hospice environments, where death is imminent. What is interesting is that every person, regardless of their lifestyle, all unprompted, reached out for Jesus. It appears that necessity is the mother of invention. I guess they finally got an appetite and, "became ready". You see, nobody rejects Jesus while dying. In 30 years of ministry, many of which was spent in intervening for the infirmed, I've witnessed many free will flips "on a dime"!

As we submit to true enlightenment, darkness is exposed, truth is revealed, and freedom is released. Although we can't do this for others, we can intervene in prayer, offer endearment, and be a light ourself. The onus of all free will enlightenment is within each individual. **Everybody responds when they're ready.**

Sometimes **we may want more for someone than they want for them-self**. Accordingly, as we're helping them, and they're not trying, it's apparent your both not working toward the same goal. Even two oxen are yoked to keep them both going in the same direction. Best thing to do is cut them loose. Our time can be more productive elsewhere. Bearing one another's burden **was never meant** to tie up the innocent with the responsibility for other people's slacker ways.

Note to those seeking prosperity: "this is very important". If people wait until the smell of death, to engage God's gospel offer of eternal life, then **they've willfully missed the other benefits**, like deliverance, healing, prosperity, true peace, the bonus of all those gifts, and the opportunity to invest treasure in heaven! In reality, since God knows who has resisted His gospel, and rejected His values, if they do make heaven on such a slacker status, **where does that leave them** throughout eternity? They could have been storing up treasures in heaven most of their lives! Smart people on earth work hard, save and store up, for either emergency, hobby, retirement, etc. **If you knew** you could be storing up treasures in heaven, wouldn't you be doing that too? Free will can also open our eyes, to how we'd like to plan and spend eternity. **Better think about this one, before it's too late!**

Prayer Request Results (Video Snapshot text)

First off, we know it's God's will for all to be saved, healed, and prospered. By this fact, we know that God has already released these attributes to each of us, through Jesus. When our results are partial, or lacking results, then blockages are occurring. Blockages are on our side, not God's side, placing the onus on us to initiate an effort to remove them. Here are a few verses that can help us recalibrate our thinking and move ahead on this strategy.

- “If you live in Me [abide vitally united to Me] and My words remain in you and continue to live in your hearts, **ask** whatever you will, and it shall be done for you.” (John 15:7)
- “But seek (aim at and strive after) first of all His kingdom and His righteousness (His way of doing and being right), and **then** all these things taken together will be given you besides.” (Matthew 6:33)
- ' We know that God does not listen to sinners; but if anyone is God-fearing and a worshiper of Him and does His will, He listens to him.' (John 9:31)

Observations

1. **IF** anyone chooses to abide in Jesus' teachings **then** they can ask for what they want, and it shall be done.
2. **IF** we seek first God's kingdom and His way of doing, and **then** all these things will be given you.
3. God doesn't listen to sinners (those not doing His will), but does listen to all God-fearing saints, doing His will.

If results are diminished, then vitally abiding in Jesus' teachings and seeking God's way first, not last, may need some recalibration, or initiation. Check your agenda. By the fact we're in prayer is good, and we're partially there, so now we're looking for potential solutions for better effectiveness. Crossing over to more of God, and more of His manifest presence, to garner a better effect is our beneficial goal.

Remember God has already set up an avenue for us to cross over, and as we exercise that option, better results will ensue. As in salvation, people need to accept God, His terms, and cross over to Him for eternal life benefits. Since the word *sozo* includes saved as well as prosperity and healing, these categories are activated to better results, as we vitally abide, and as we prioritize Him first and shift over to doing things His way.

In healing, using natural and medicine are a good thing. However, God has provided a mechanism for healing, within the gifts of the Spirit, which we've been allocated access to (the anointing). If we reject this, we suffer the consequences. If we keep this as a last resort, and if we only come to God when we need His intervention, and keep all other modalities ahead of Him, what are we setting in motion? We're setting in motion our own blockages to where God cannot hear us. So any lack of great results, for any God-fearing saint, should be a wake up call, to

contend with reprioritizing, doing God's will, placing God first, and abiding in Jesus' teachings. As we pray, fast, and give, in secret, breakthrough usually manifests, and if we add tongues, it can be much quicker.

It's all free will choices!

If God has already provided the solutions, but people aren't willing to acknowledge, activate or abide, then whose fault is that? Heavenly standards are available within divine nature, the Narrow Road, and in the abundant life, not in the worldly system. Anyone can enter in at the their own free will, and get yoked up to Godly benefits. Slacker ways get slacker results. Cause and effect are simple and we all suffer or benefit, depending on our awareness.
