

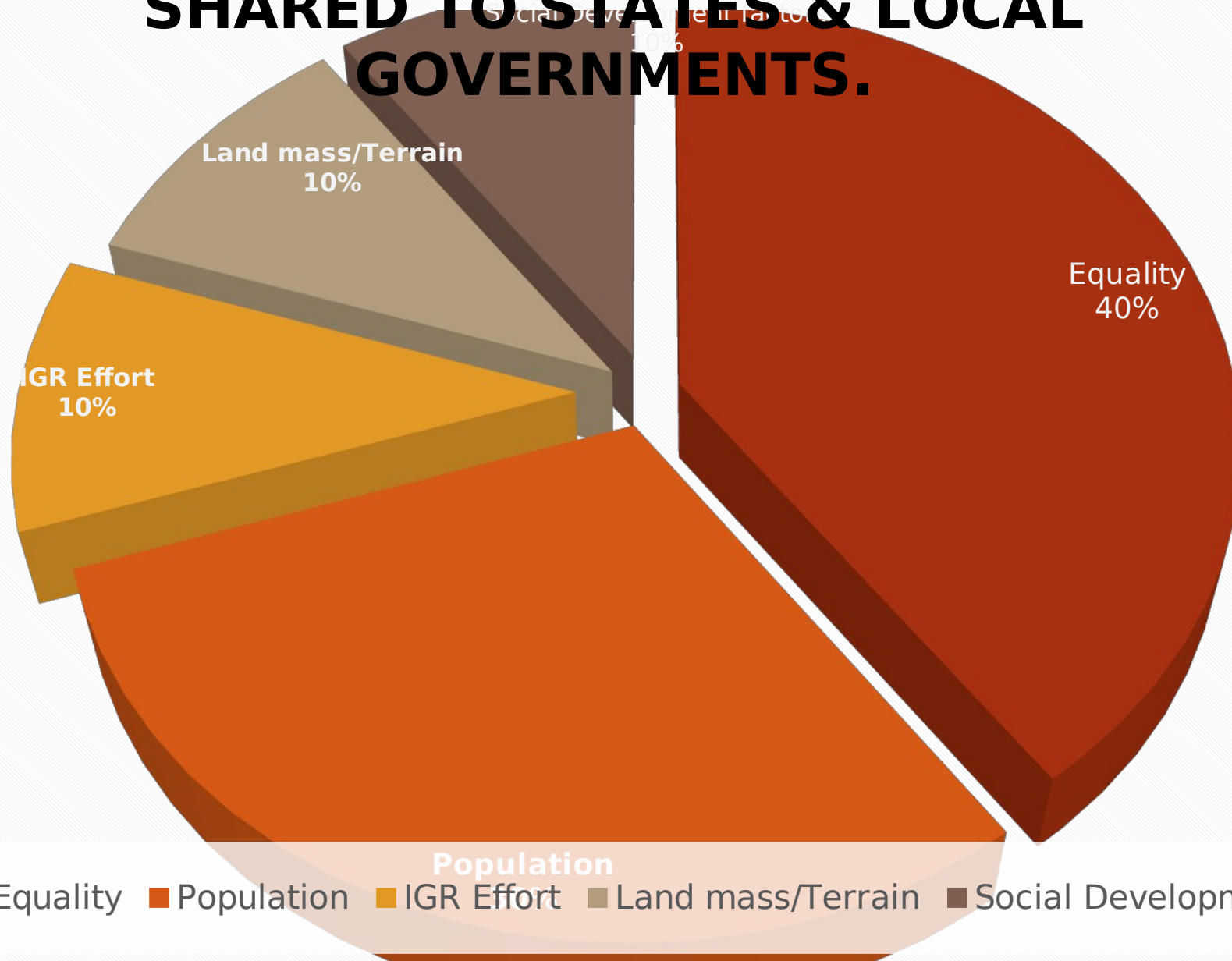
The fourth most deadliest terrorist group in the world (Fulani Herdsmen)



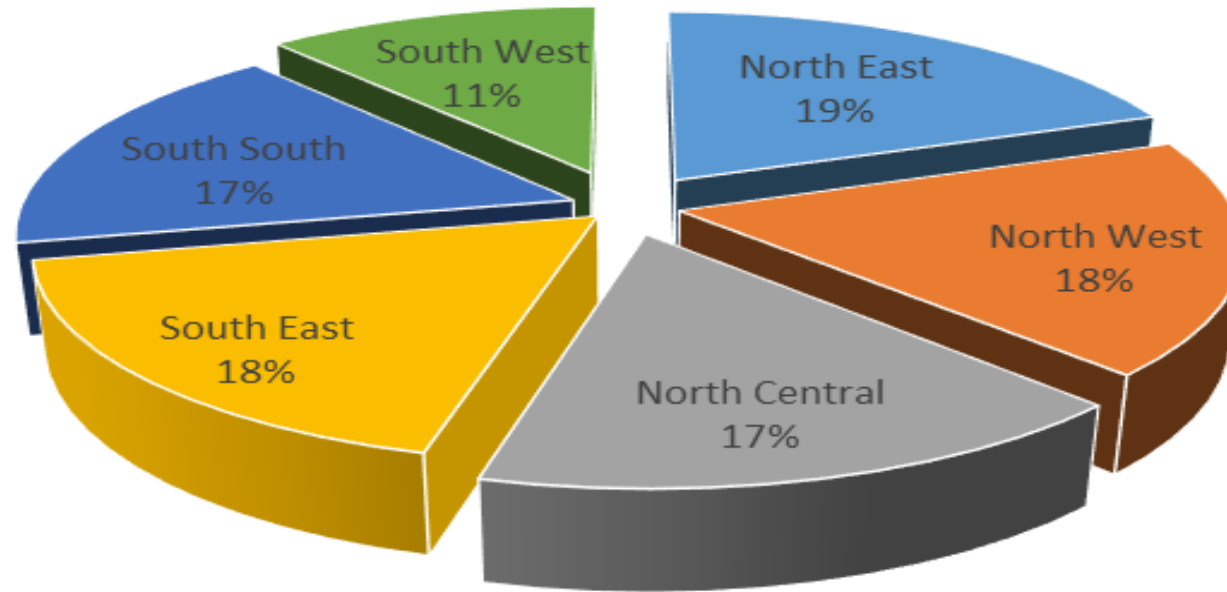

Most FAAC Dependent Zone – FAAC as % Share of Revenue, 2020

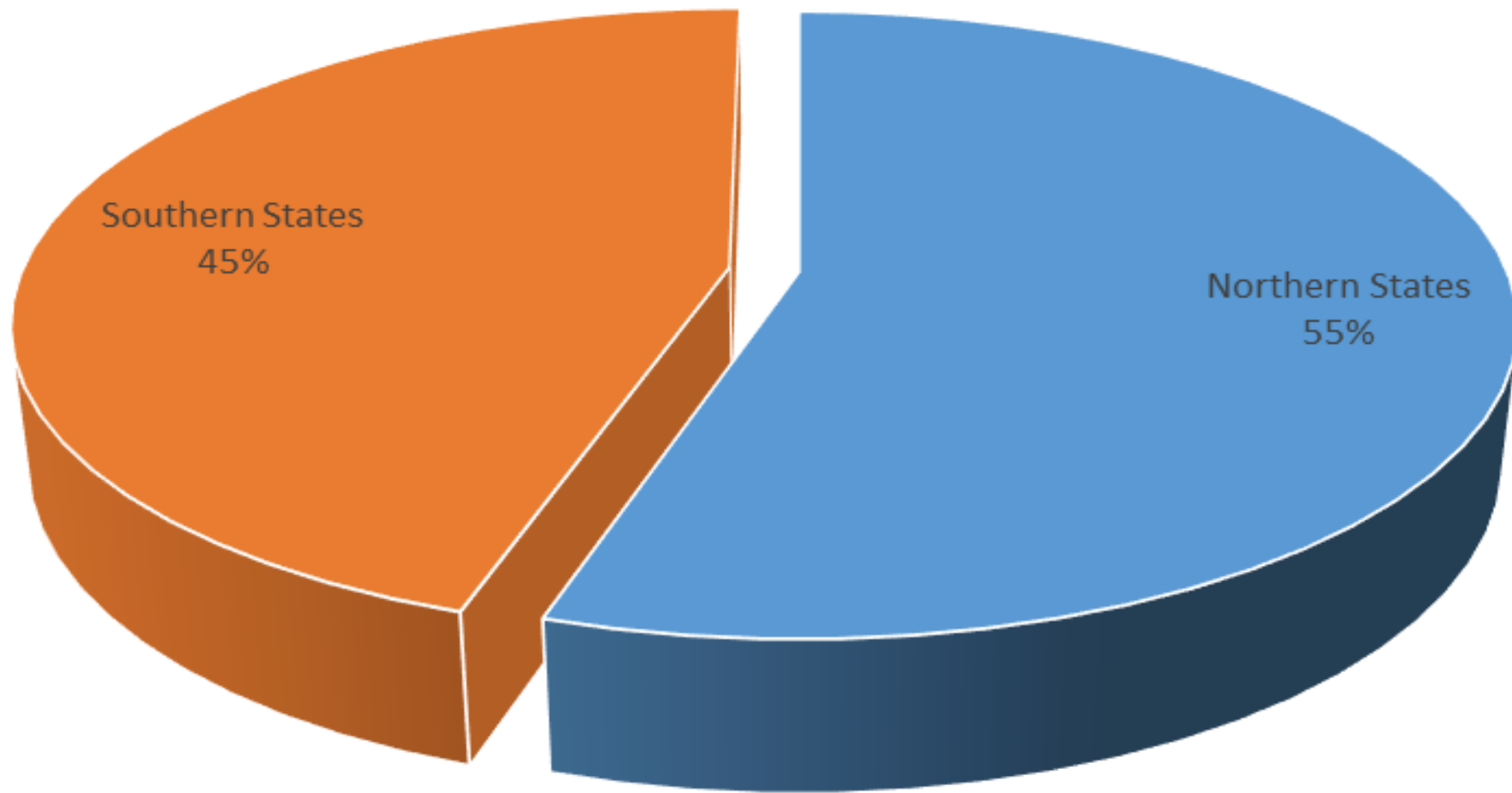

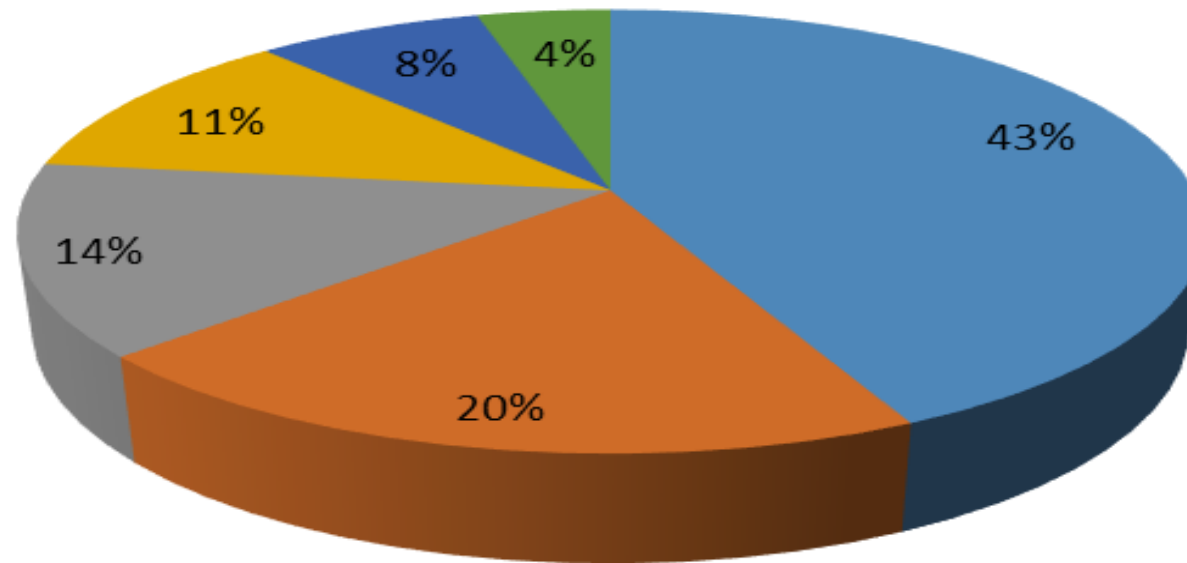
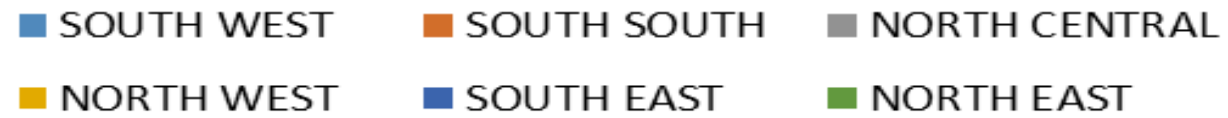
- THE YORUBA HAS THE HIGHEST INTERNALLY GENERATED REVENUE IN NIGERIA IN 2020.
