REFLECTION FOR THE SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

1. In the first reading, God makes a covenant with Abram.

2. As part of the covenant, God gives Abram and his descendants their own land to dwell in.

3. The land that Abram's descendants dwelt in was the land of freedom for them, and a fertile land.

Our Lord has given us a "land flowing with milk and honey" – Heaven. We have access to that land if we follow God's word.

4. In the second reading, Saint Paul cautions us to keep our eyes on the things of heaven, because our citizenship is in heaven. In these troubled times, when our minds are constantly directed to the worldly, we must never forget that we are citizens of heaven, and it is those things that matter to us.

5. The Gospel shows Jesus' transfiguration, and the new land, heaven, that we will dwell in and be led into by Jesus, the new Moses and the new Elijah.

6. We know that God's promise of heaven is because we have a new covenant. In the sacrifice of the mass. Thus, our participation in that sacrifice, our worthy participation in that sacrifice, will lead us to the new promised land.
