REFLECTION FOR THE FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

1. The first reading reminds us that we will no longer need the life that the Eucharist gives us once we enter heaven, just as the Israelites no longer had the manna when they entered the promised land for their first passover and ate the produce of the land.

2. The second reading refers to us as ambassadors for Christ, "as if God were appealing through us." We are all ambassadors of Christ and are called to take Jesus to everyone we encounter. During this Lenten season, we should be asking ourselves how we would answer the question if our Lord asked us "What are those things you have done is my ambassador to lead others to me?"

3. In the Gospel, Jesus talked about the parable of the prodigal son. This is one of the most beautiful parables in the entire Gospel, because it is a beautiful expression of God's immense and fathomless mercy toward us, his children. As long as we ask for forgiveness and repent, our father is willing to forgive us. But in order to receive forgiveness, we are called to forgive those who have hurt us. Forgiveness of others opens a channel that allows God to forgive US.

4. At the end of the parable, we find out that the older son is angry at his younger brother for all the wrong he has done. But what is the real reason here? Clearly, the older son has not forgiven his younger brother as the father has. The older son is outside of the father's house, and the father is pleading with him to go inside and join the celebration. In order to enter into the father's house, we know that the older son will have to forgive his brother, as we are called to do.
