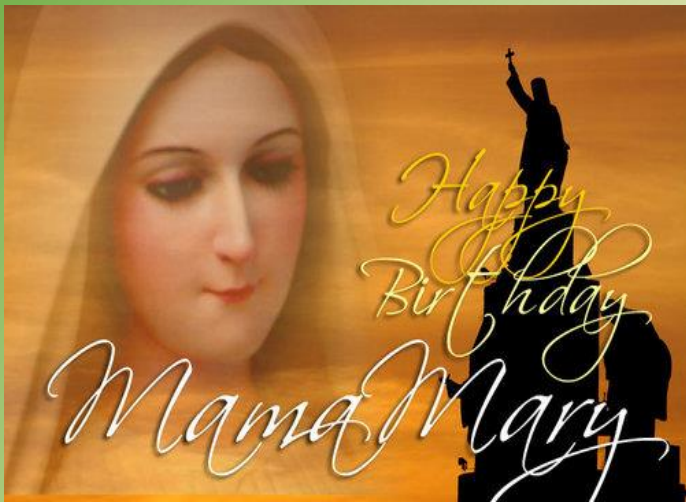

## THE NATIVITY OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

The birth and early life of the Virgin Mary is not recorded in the Gospel or other books of the New Testament; however, this information can be found in a work dating from the second century known as the Book of James or Protevangelion.

According to the story found in this book, Mary's parents, Joachim and Anna, were childless for many years. They remained faithful to God, but their prayers for a child were unanswered.

One day, when Joachim came to the temple to make an offering, he was turned away by the high priest who chastised him for his lack of children. To hide his shame, Joachim retreated to hill country to live among the shepherds and their flocks.

As Joachim was praying, his wife Anna was praying at the same time; at their house in Jerusalem, an angel appeared to both of them and announced that Anna would have a child whose name would be known throughout the world. Anna promised to offer her child as a gift to the Lord. Joachim returned home, and in due time Anna bore a daughter, Mary.

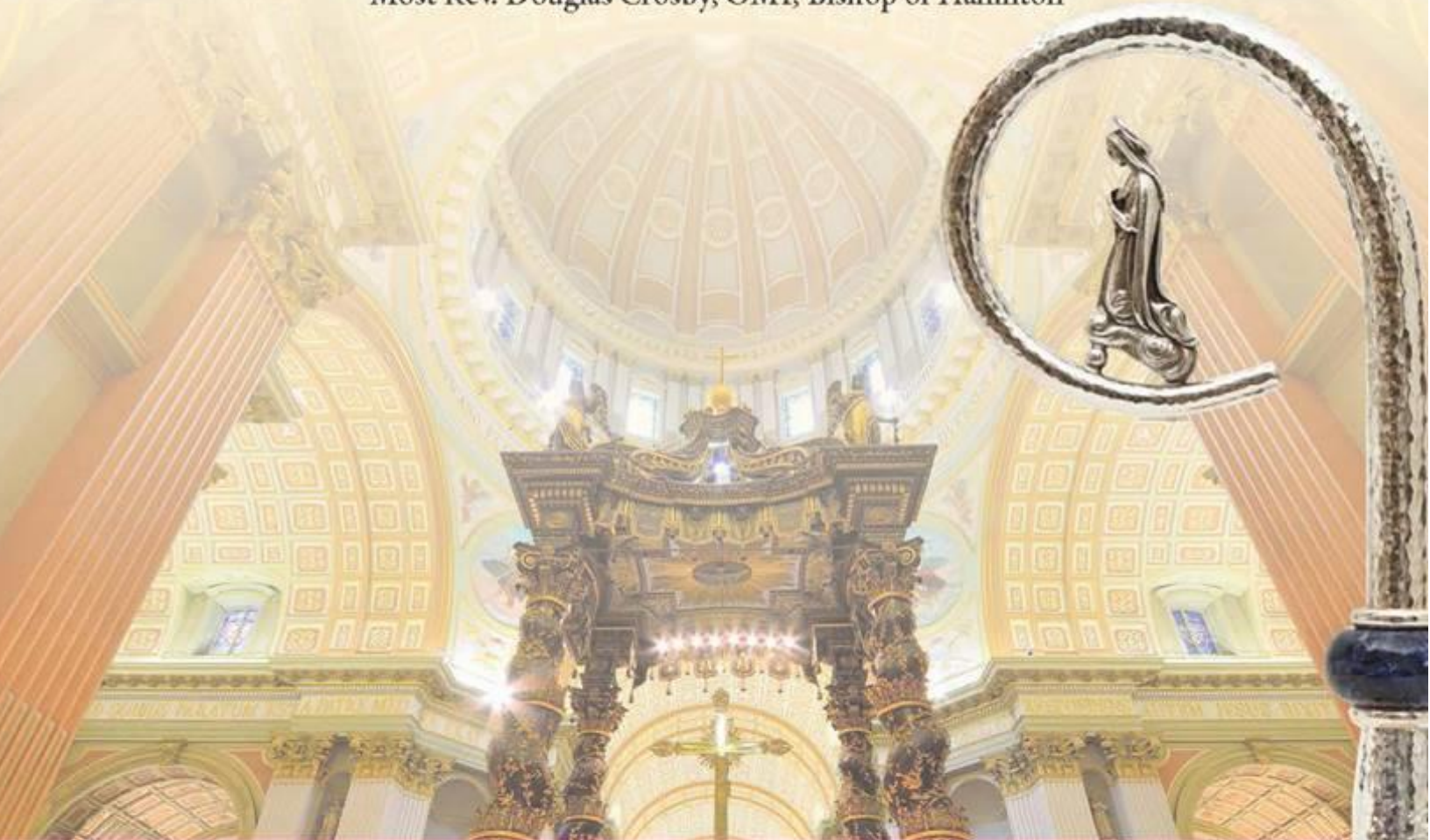
