



Today, the church invites us to pray for the souls of the faithful departed and to prepare for our own death. It is important that we maintain a relationship of love and faith with the deceased and that we view death and the afterlife in the light of the Scriptures. By remembering those who have gone before us, we are connected with the history of human existence.

At the end of life, death can deprive us of what is mortal, but it can never deprive us of what is divine. Having been stripped of mortality we will be clothed in a robe of immortality. Today allows us to be grateful for the life we have been given, for the people who have shared our lives and who have loved and supported us throughout our lives.

In the fourth chapter of his Rule, St. Benedict wrote: "Day by day remind yourself that you are going to die. These are words said at every funeral Mass, part of the preface leading into the Eucharistic Prayer for this Sunday also. "Indeed, for your faithful, Lord, life is changed not ended... Saint Ambrose wrote: "We loved them in life, let us not forget them in death." Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them.

May the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.
