

SACRED HEART OF JESUS

Today is the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus as we venerate Jesus's Sacred Heart, we should be aware that what we venerate is not just a biological organ, like a relic of a saint. What we see when we gaze into the Sacred Heart of Jesus is a heart burning with love for us. We see a heart that loves us so much it was willing to be pierced for us, to die

for us, and shed its last drop of blood. But as we contemplate Christ's Sacred Heart further still, we discover there an even greater love. Behind his love for us is another more foundational love; Christ's first and greatest love; it is the love of the Son for the Father. When we adore the Sacred Heart, we adore the human will of Jesus Christ united perfectly with the will of God the Father. It is this complete love for God that is the source of Christ's love for us; because Christ's heart wants only what God wills, and God's will for us is salvation.



This is what we see when we look at Christ's Sacred Heart. But what does Christ see when he looks into our hearts? Does he see poor sinners in need of a savior? Certainly. But that alone would only cause Christ to pity us, not to love us. No, Christ sees something more in us. He sees something lovable. Christ's heart is perfectly in love with God, which enables Jesus to recognize and love the image of God within each of us. This is why St. Paul says it is difficult for us to give our lives for another, even for a just person. Because sin inverts our love and turns it inward, toward ourselves. It turns us into navel-gazers, unaware of all the images of God walking around about us, and ultimately, because sin separates us from God, it makes us unaware of the image of God within ourselves.

But Jesus gives his life for us even while we are sinners. Because his heart is perfectly united with God, and the only thing Jesus wants, the only object of his desire, is to do the will of God. And the will of God is creative, life-giving and merciful. God made us for himself, and draws us to himself. The will of God is that not one of his sheep be lost. The Sacred Heart of Jesus is a human heart filled with divine love. Now this same love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit. It is — or ought to be — the driving force of all who call themselves Christian. As we raise our minds and hearts to God in prayer on this feast of the Most Sacred Heart, let us order our own hearts to be like Jesus', loving God above all else, and loving one another and ourselves as God loves us, with humility, mercy, and compassion. Let us unite our hearts with his, so that the deepest longings of Christ's Sacred Heart may become the deepest longings of our own.

O most holy heart of Jesus, fountain of every blessing,

> I adore you, I love you,

and with lively sorrow for my sins,

I offer you this poor heart of mine.

Make me humble, patient, pure and wholly obedient

Comfort me in my afflictions. Give me health of body, assistance in my temporal needs, Your blessing on all that I do, and the grace of a holy death.
