TIE & CUT QUILT SQUARES



The HTLC Quilters meet on the first and third Tuesdays of the month at 9:00 in the LFC to organize, cut, assemble, sew, and tie quilts. This year they will make 145 for Lutheran World Relief!

Often, when natural disasters strike or war drives families from their homes, our hearts ache with compassion but we don't know how to help. Making Lutheran World Relief Mission Quilts is a tangible way to express love to our neighbors in need. Quilts can be used as warm bedding, simple tents or floor coverings. Each one reflects God's loving presence in a world rife with suffering.

The knitter begins each shawl with prayers for the recipient. Intentions are continued throughout the creation of the shawl.

The HTLC Prayer Shawl Team meets every Tuesday in the LFC at 9:00 to craft these beautiful demonstrations of care for those facing hard times, hospitalizations, grief, or loss in their lives.

PACK LWR SCHOOL KITS

Education is one of the strongest tools a community has for breaking the cycle of poverty. Ensuring that girls attend school, especially in places where their access is deprioritized, has even stronger results. Lutheran World Relief School Kits contain essential supplies to help children — and in some cases, adults — continue learning in the face of serious obstacles. That learning leads to a better life for them, their families and their communities.

Each year in the fall Barb Rank organizes efforts at HTLC to create school kits to be distributed by Lutheran World Relief. Members donate supplies, Barb and her family organize supplies, and our youth often help assemble the kits during their weekly classes.

GO SERVE!


We are called to serve the community around us!
