

Privacy Policy

At trustingthewhispers.com ("we," or "us"), we value the privacy of individuals who use our websites and related services (collectively, our "Services"). Information Collected Automatically

When you use our Services, we may automatically collect certain information about your device and usage, including your IP address, browser type, operating system, device identifiers, pages viewed, links clicked, dates and times of access, and other browsing information.

Cookies and Tracking Technologies. We may use cookies, pixels, analytics tools, and similar technologies to enhance your experience, understand how our Services are used, personalize content, and improve our Services. You may adjust your browser settings to refuse cookies; however, some features of the Services may not function properly.

Information from Third Parties. We may receive information about you from third-party platforms, partners, social media services, event platforms, marketing providers, or publicly available sources and combine it with information we collect directly from you.

How We Use Your Information

We may use the information we collect to:
